

Functions of Committees

<u>Planning Committee:</u> The Planning Committee consists of the Moderator, Executive Secretary / Treasurer, and Chairman of each Board and reports to the Executive Committee. The responsibilities of the Planning Committee are to make intermediate and long-ranged plans for State Ministries; coordinate the efforts of the Mission Board and Christian Ministries Board; to plan the State Association theme and speakers; and to handle any items of review by the Executive Committee or the State Body.

Steering Committee: The Steering Committee consists of the Moderator, Clerk, Executive Secretary / Treasurer, the Chairman of the Christian Ministries Board and the President of the Florida Women Active For Christ. Others may be appointed by the Moderator on a special need basis. It exists for the purpose of coordinating our annual State Meeting. The responsibilities for this committee shall be: to negotiate with the various locations concerning rates and arrangements and to recommend locations to the State Body; to work with the various Convention Bureaus to secure sites; to make site inspections when necessary; to set and approve the catering contracts for meeting rooms and meal functions with the host hotel; to coordinate the meeting times and room specifications for each session; to set the schedule for the State Meeting; to coordinate the registration process for the State Meeting; and to be the on-site liaison for hotel staff.

Budget Committee: The Budget Committee consists of three members of the Executive Committee appointed by the Moderator one year in advance. The Executive Secretary / Treasurer serves as an ex-officio member. The responsibility of this committee is to analyze and compile the State's General Fund Budget. Budget requests will be submitted in writing. A representative will be available from Florida standing boards and commissions to provide information to the committee. The Executive Secretary will present his operating

expenses and the Coordinator expense. Direction from the State Moderator concerning administrative items will be provided. The Budget Committee has the authority to request additional information in compiling the budget. This budget will be presented to the Executive Committee for approval and recommendation to the State Body for final approval.

<u>Auditing Committee:</u> The Auditing Committee is composed of three members which shall be elected for three year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee. They are to review financial documents to determine that the Treasurer's report of each board and the State Association clearly reflects the financial activity for the year.

Promotional Team Concept:

The Executive Secretary – He is tasked with being the point man, representing the state ministries, not necessarily the office, to our associations and churches. This is a part-time position requiring two dates a month to be traveling.

The Editor of the Coordinator – He is tasked with delegating articles to be written and compiling the content of the state newsletter in whatever time period and manner published. He may or may not be tasked with actual layout and printing. This could lead to a fourth area that would become the Media Coordinator for all three of these positions (to handle their perspective promotions and graphic design and printing) or he may consider delegating this to the Media Commission.



Minutes of the Sixty-First Annual Session of the

Florida State Association of Free Will Baptist

The Sixty-First annual session of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at the Jacksonville Marriott in Jacksonville, Florida on May 11-13, 2005. This was a combined meeting with the Florida Women Active for Christ and the Florida Youth Conference. The theme for the meeting was "The Anchor Holds."

Wednesday, May 11, 2005 ~ Evening Worship Service

The time of worship began with Steve Berry leading the congregation in singing "Higher Ground" and "A Shelter In The Time Of Storm."

Paul Smith welcomed everyone to the Worship Service and introduced T. J. Jackson of the Jacksonville Convention and Visitors Bureau. She welcomed the meeting to the city of Jacksonville.

Clerk, David Baker, welcomed everyone to the Sixty-First Annual Meeting of Florida Free Will Baptists and called the session to order. He introduced the Executive Secretary of the National Association of Free Will Baptists, Keith Burden. Bro. Burden brought greetings from the Executive Office and opened the service in prayer.

The congregation then joined in singing a medley of songs that included: "Till The Storm Passes Over," "For Whatever It Takes," "Peace In The Midst" and "Jesus We Just Want To Thank You." Executive Secretary's Report

"Great Is Thy Faithfulness" should be the refrain that rings throughout our State after a year like 2004. Florida witnessed the faithfulness of our God and came through 2004 as a testimony of His goodness to us.

The Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists faced many Challenges throughout the year. Many of these challenges came as a result of the storms that blew through our State. For the first time in history, our State was hit with four major hurricanes. These storms brought considerable damage to many of our churches and the homes of our people. We faced the challenge of rebuilding our churches and our homes. We faced the challenge of offering assistance to those in need. We were able to rise to these challenges by several churches assisting other congregations with supplies, labor, and financial support after the storms hit, and through instituting a Hurricane Relief Fund to assist those in need. We had the challenge of keeping our gifts to Co-op and to Mission Shares at a necessary level to be able to carry out our ministries. Thankfully, we were able to meet our Shares and Co-operative budgets in spite of all the devastation around us. Our State Association faced the challenge of moving ahead with our Christian Workers' Conferences. One had to be rescheduled and the other was on the verge of being canceled. In spite of this, the participation was good. Another challenge for our State was to get our Seniors' Summit off the ground. Even though there were conflicts in scheduling and complications from the storms, we had a very successful initial Seniors' Summit. Certainly, "challenges" became a by-word for 2004 and will continue to be in the years ahead. Rising to the challenges serves as a testimony of the faithfulness of the people in our churches and to the faithfulness of our God.

Accomplishments for 2004 include:

Our Mission Shares giving of \$191,219.49. This total is up more than \$12,000 from the previous year and only \$2300 short of our budget.

Our Co-operative giving reached \$109,103.52. That was an increase of over \$5800 from the previous year.
 The inaugural Seniors' Summit was held in November. St. Augustine served as the chilly background for the more than 40 seniors who attended the Summit. Rev. Bill Evans from the Free Will Baptist Foundation did a superb job in preaching and in educating those in attendance concerning their personal finances.

Our Christian Ministries Board and Mission Board continued to function well. The Christian Ministries Board conducted a successful State Youth Conference; beneficial Christian Workers' Conferences, and relaxing Ministers' Retreat. The Mission Board continues to provide administrative oversight to the Shares Plan and to the mission works in Gainesville and West Palm Beach.

The Coordinator" continues to keep our people informed about the happenings of our State Association. The editorial and layout team continues to do a superb job in publishing a paper that sets the standard for State Association Publications. A great deal of thanks goes to Danny Conn for his editorial work and to Ron Hunter for his expertise in layout and design. Jose Rodriquez and Daniel Perez are to be commended for their work with the Hispanic Edition of "The Coordinator". Due to the hurricanes and other factors we were only able to publish 5 issues in 2004. Our plans are to publish six issues again in 2005.

- Christian Workers' Conferences for the northern and southern parts of our State. The subject of this year's conferences will center on Creationism.
- The Second Annual Seniors' Summit will be held on November 14-16 at the Radisson Barcelo Hotel in Orlando. Dr. Ken Riggs will be the speaker for this year's Summit. Tuesday of the Summit has been set aside to visit The Holy Land Experience for those who wish to participate.

The 61st Annual Session of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists will again be held with the Florida Women Active for Christ and with the Florida Youth Conference.

Plans are also under way to put together a Disaster Relief Team. The hopes are to have people in place with commitments to respond to the needs of our people in the event that we face more disasters in the future. Dr. Danny Conn has volunteered to help coordinate this ministry.

We have a Charge that calls for us to move forward collectively and cooperatively. As a State Association, we have accepted a Mission Statement that defines who we are, what our purpose is, and the mission we are to carry out. We must remain true to our mission of obeying His Great Commandment and of fulfilling His Great Commission. This is done through the "Exaltation of Jesus Christ," the "Evangelization of the Lost," the "Establishment of Biblical Churches," and the "Equipping of the Saints." Regardless of the challenges we face, the charge we have has not and cannot change in the days ahead. As we move forward in the years ahead we must also **Chase** some dreams. What is it that we want to accomplish as a State Association in the years ahead? What kind of vision do we have? These include the vision of a full-time State Executive Secretary, a vision of greater cooperation among our churches, a vision of the State having a retirement complex for our people and even a conference/retreat center. Those are huge dreams, but are they possible? Are they possible in our lifetime? They could be! To accomplish any of these we would have to have some major gifts given to our State for these purposes. This could be done through individual wills and trusts. The key is to educate our people regarding these opportunities and challenge them to help us chase these dreams. I want to close by letting you know how much I cherish the privilege of serving the churches and people of Florida. I have been truly blessed to be able to serve in the capacity and to witness firsthand what the Lord is doing across our state. I

have had the privilege of traveling almost 30,000 miles over the past year in an effort to represent this phase of our Lord's work. I was able to attend twenty-one different District Association meetings (attending each District meeting at least once), both Christian Workers' Conferences, a Planned Giving Seminar, a Conference for those ministering to people Over 50, the Bible Conference at FWBBC, the National Association meeting, and the RCMA Conference. I have cherished the opportunity to work with the Executive Committee, the Planning Committee, the Steering Committee, and each of our Boards. It has also been my pleasure to be able to work with the various hotel properties that hosted our State Meeting and our Christian Workers' Conferences.

I want to extend my appreciation to my wife for her love and selfless support as I continue this ministry. I am so thankful for her encouragement and understanding during the times I am away. Also, I want to extend my thanks to the people of the Ryanwood Fellowship Free Will Baptist Church for their graciousness in allowing me to serve in this capacity

while allowing me to continue to serve as their pastor. Their support reveals vision and concern beyond their church and into the greater work of God.

Hurricane Relief Fund

Following the hurricanes of 2004, our State launched a Hurricane Relief Fund to assist churches and families in our churches who had suffered loss due to the storms. There were very few parts of our State that escaped damage due to the four hurricanes that came to call. A committee was formed to administer the Relief Funds that were received. The Committee was made up of the moderator and State Executive Committee member from the districts in which received the most substantial damage from the storms. The Committee members were: Phil Dillon, James Aldridge, Jim Christian, Sam Lucky, David Baker, and R.C. Wiggins.

Our Relief Fund received a total of \$35,593.87 and distributed a total of \$34,874.00 to churches and individuals. Expenses for the administration of the Relief Fund have been kept to the bare minimum by conducting business through conference calls. Total expenses for the committee totaled \$138.40. Funds were received from individuals, churches,

Women Active for Christ chapters, National Departments and various Associations in 12 states outside of Florida.

The funds were distributed to the churches and individuals based on their requests for assistance. The committee agreed to distribute the funds at 20% of the net loss reported and 50% of the salary loss due to the storms.

Christian Ministries Board Report

The 2004 State Youth Conference registered 123 participants, representing eleven churches in 107 competition events. Fifty-seven events advanced, sending thirty-one participants, from five associations, to the National Youth Conference in Kansas City. Florida students placed in twenty-one events, with eight events receiving first-place awards:

Rachel Williams (Grade 2, Bible Memorization); Alex Andrews (Grade 3, Bible Memorization); Ashlee Christian (Grade 12, Bible Memorization); Beulah (B Quartet); Patch the Pirate (B Chorale); Patch the Pirate (B Choir); Bailey Vaughn (B Keyboard Solo); Shiloh Puppets (B Live Puppetry).

In spite of the hurricanes, 140 Florida Free Will Baptists attended the Christian Workers' Conferences, in Orlando and Destin. TEAM Church, from Randall House Publications,



presented workshops on CLEAR Curriculum and other topics of interest to Sunday School teachers and youth workers.

The 2005 Minister's Retreat at Palm Coast, this past January, welcomed seventeen ministers and fourteen minister's wives (and one rat). It was an encouraging time of fellowship and relaxation. Attendees had the opportunity to play golf on championship courses, go shopping, do some sightseeing, or just relax. Monday night, Bro. Tom Malone shared words of encouragement. Wednesday evening was highlighted with a worship service that included congregational singing, a testimony from Bro. Sam McVay, and more challenging words from Bro. Malone.

The Christian Ministries Board seeks to expand the service and educational ministries of our state by promoting a winter *Youth Rally* and a *Florida Disaster Response Team*. Information on these programs and the other events sponsored by the CM Board is available. We are pleased to serve Florida Free Will Baptists in our service to Christ.

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Constitution and By-Laws of the

Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

<u>Preamble</u>

Article 1 – Name of Assembly

Section 1: This assembly shall be known as "The Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists".

Article II - Representation

<u>Section 1:</u> This Association shall be composed of delegates elected from the local associations belonging to this body and delegates elected from the local churches embraced by the various associations.

<u>Section 2:</u> All deacons and ministers who are members of, and in good standing with, a local church and local association which are members of this body are standing delegates. <u>Section 3:</u> The general officers of this body shall be standing delegates. <u>Section 4:</u> The delegates shall be elected as follows: one (1) delegate for each local church composed of 100 members or fraction thereof; and one (1) delegate for each additional 100 members or fraction thereof; five (5) delegates from each local association composed of fifteen (15) churches or fraction thereof, and one (1) additional delegate for each additional four (4) churches or fraction thereof. These additional delegates cannot be used unless the churches are active and are represented in the session in which they are appointed.

Article III – Officers, Boards and Committees

<u>Section 1:</u> Officers: the officers of this association shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, and Clerk to be elected by this Body while in regular session.

Section 2: The standing boards of this Association shall be the Florida Mission Board and the Christian Ministries Board.

<u>Section 3:</u> When the State Association deems it wise, committees or commissions may be established to perform a



specific service in restricted area on more or less permanent basis. The number of members and their terms of office of any committee or commission shall be decided by vote of the State Association and the members shall be elected by the Association.

Section 4: The Executive Committee shall be composed of the Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, the Chairman of each Standing Board, and one elected member from each affiliated District Association. District Associations shall recommend their representatives on the Executive Board annually. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum.

<u>Section 5:</u> When vacancies occur either by death, removal from office or by resignation, the general officers shall appoint a temporary replacement until the next regular session of this body, at which time the body shall elect a permanent replacement. A proxy may be appointed by the body to fill any absentee's place who does not attend the session.

Section 6: General officers of the Association shall serve for the term of two (2) years.

<u>Section 7:</u> Each standing board and the Historical Commission shall be composed of five members which shall be elected for five year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually.

The auditing committee shall be composed of three members which shall be elected for three year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee.

The Budget committee will be appointed by the Moderator a year in advance. The committee will consist of three members from the Executive Committee and the State Treasurer will serve as an ex-officio member.

<u>Section 8:</u> This body shall have the right to discipline any officer or board member who does not conduct his office in a Christian and business-like manner according to the rules of Christian conduct laid down in the New Testament.

Section 9: The executive Committee is to hire an Executive Secretary and to direct his office. The Executive Secretary is to be a non-voting member of all boards and committees.

<u>Article IV – Meetings</u>

<u>Section 1:</u> Regular: This association shall convene annually in a joint meeting with the Florida Women Active for Christ and the Youth Conference on a Wednesday evening, Thursday, Friday and Saturday as close to the first Sunday in May as possible.

<u>Section 2:</u> Special: The Executive Committee may be called into session by the Moderator, or by a majority of its members. <u>Section 3:</u> Quorum: Fifty (50) percent of the delegates shall constitute a quorum.

Article V – Finances

Section 1: All churches and associations in this body shall pay a representation fee annually. The amount of this for an association is \$200.00 per member church. The fee for local churches is \$10.00 per delegate.

<u>Section 2:</u> All Cooperative Plan funds coming into this body shall be spent under a budget plan. This budget must be approved by the body while in session, and no fund may be used in any way except as budgeted. <u>Section 3:</u> Mileage for the Executive Committee members and standing Board members shall be paid at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. Expenses are to be paid from each Board member's account. If a called meeting requires a member to stay overnight, his room and board will be paid from the General Fund or his Board's account. Mileage and expenses shall be paid for the Moderator to attend the denomination's annual Leadership Conference.

By-Laws

Section 1: It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside over all deliberations of this body while in session. All meetings shall be governed by Roberts Rules of Order.

<u>Section 2:</u> The Assistant Moderator shall assume the duties, rights and privileges of the Moderator or Clerk in the absence of either.

<u>Section 3:</u> It shall be the duty of the Clerk to make and keep records of all the business proceedings and activities of this body.



<u>Section 4:</u> (1) It shall be the duty of the State Executive Office to receive all funds, pay all appropriate bills, disburse cooperative and designated funds in a timely manner according to the State Association's budget; (2) It shall be the duty of each State Board Treasurer to receive all funds for the board he serves, pay all appropriate bills, and disburse appropriate funds in a timely manner. (3) The State Executive Office and all State Board Treasurers shall use the same accounting system. (4) Each treasurer of the State Association shall submit his / her records to the State Association's Audit Committee annually for audit.

Section 5: It shall be the duty of the auditing committee to conduct a financial audit of each treasurer's books annually. The audit shall take place after the fiscal year and before the State Association convenes. The date for the audit will be agreed upon by the audit committee and the various treasurers who shall be present at the time their books are audited. Section 6: It shall be the duty of the Budget Committee to make recommendations to the State Association concerning the total State Association Budget and the allocations of State Cooperative receipts. Section 7: Each officer, board member and standing committee or commission member must be in good standing with a Free Will Baptist Church which is a member of this body. He must be in good standing with his local association and must live within the boundaries of this Association. No person shall serve on more than on board at the same time. Section 8: The Executive Committee shall have full authority to do all acts for and in the name of the Association when the Association is not in session and shall make a general report of all their actions to the body annually. Section 9: Amendments to this Constitution and By-Laws must be put before the body while in session one day before voted on, and must be read at least twice and passed by a two-thirds of the delegates present.

Constitution and By-Laws

Florida State Free Will Baptist Mission Board

of the

<u>Article I – Name</u>

This Board shall be known as the Florida Free Will Baptist Mission Board, Inc.

Article II – Purpose

This purpose of this board shall be that of promoting mission work among Free Will Baptists in the State of Florida, beginning new mission works in the state of Florida, and overseeing the missionary and the mission work until the mission is able to assume full self-supporting status.

<u>Article III – Membership</u>

This board shall be composed of members elected by the State Association and shall serve terms established on a rotational basis. One member's term shall expire annually. The number of members of this board shall be determined by the Constitution and By-Laws of the State Association

Article IV – Officers and Committees

Officers of this board shall be Chairman and Secretary / Treasurer. These officers shall hold office for one (1) year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms. The board members have the option of hiring a treasurer who is not a board member. Members of the board shall elect the officers and/or hire the treasurer of the board. Committees may be appointed by the chairman elected by the board as the need arises.

Article V – Meetings

Meetings shall be held as the need arises. Necessary meetings may be called by the chairman or any three members.



<u> Article VI – Finances</u>

This board shall receive its finances from churches and individuals making special contributions, cooperative program allocations, interest on loans, and special offerings received through promoting missions. Mileage for board member expenses shall be paid from the general fund at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. All other Board travel expenses shall be reimbursed at members cost.

By-Laws

<u>Section 1:</u> Officers of the board shall hold office according to the terms set forth in the Constitution and shall carry out those duties peculiar to the respective offices. The Secretary shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's activities. The Treasurer shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's financial transactions. All records and property mortgages and titles shall be surrendered to the succeeding Secretary. <u>Section 2:</u> A majority membership shall constitute a quorum and be duly authorized to transact business. All items of

business must receive a majority vote of a quorum before it is considered final. All members not present in meetings shall be notified of decisions made by the Board.

<u>Section 3:</u> All members shall endeavor to support mission work through cooperative efforts of the Board. Any member that fails to cooperate with the board for a period of one year may, upon recommendation of the Board, be replaced by the State Association.

<u>Section 4:</u> A complete report of the Board Meetings and activities and a complete financial report must be presented to the annual State Association Meeting.

<u>Section 5:</u> Missions and Churches receiving financial support must be in good standing with an association or quarterly meeting affiliated with the state or national association and must have a pastor in good standing with the Free Will Baptist denomination.

<u>Section 6:</u> The board shall have the right, by majority vote, to purchase property where there is good possibility for organizing a Free Will Baptist Church. Full title must be acquired, and no investment shall exceed the appraised value

of the real property. Missionaries and mission works receiving funding from the Mission Board will be under the direct supervision of the mission board. Missionaries serve mission works at the discretion of the board. Missions and churches with Pastors employed by the board shall be under the authority of this board shall be under the authority of this board for any no routine purchases or financial obligations.

Section 7: The mission board will be responsible for administering the Mission Shares Program un the guidelines set by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Section 8: Any work receiving financial support must agree to support the denominational cooperative program.

<u>Section 9:</u> The Board shall have the right by majority vote to sell any personal or real property it deems is not necessary for continued religious use.

<u>Section 10:</u> Nominal grants by the Board to worthwhile churches or missions may be made when it is in the interest of the denominational cause in which benefits are certain. Grants of this nature shall be subject to money being immediately available and shall not exceed \$1000.00 without joint approval of the Mission Board and the State Executive Committee or Association. <u>Section 11:</u> The Constitution and By-Laws may be amended by a majority vote of the Board members with the approval of the State Body.

Constitution of the Christian Ministries Board

of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

Article I - Name

This board shall be known as the Christian Ministries Board of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Article II - Duties

Section 1. The board shall (1) Promote the educational aims of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists;

(2) Coordinate & direct youth training and competitive activities; (3) Encourage and equip Christian leaders and workers for effective ministry through the local Church. <u>Section 2.</u> The board shall give a report of its activities, financial statement, and property inventory, and present a

budget request to the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists at its annual meeting.

Article III - Membership

<u>Section 1.</u> The board shall be composed of five members who shall be elected for a term of five years, arranged whereby only one member's term expires annually. Unexpired terms will be filled by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

<u>Section 2</u>. Officers of this board shall be (1) Chairman, (2) Secretary, (3) Treasurer. Officers shall be elected by the board for one year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms.

Article IV - Meetings

<u>Section 1.</u> Meetings shall be held annually with additional meetings called by the chairman, or by any three members, as necessary.

Article V - Finances

Section 1. This board shall receive its finances from (1) Cooperative program allocation, (2) Fund raising projects, (3) Registration fees, and (4) Designated giving.

<u>Section 2.</u> Appropriate expenses incurred on official board business shall be paid or reimbursed from the general fund of the Christian Ministries Board. Mileage shall be paid at the current IRS rate.

Article VI - Amendments

This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.
