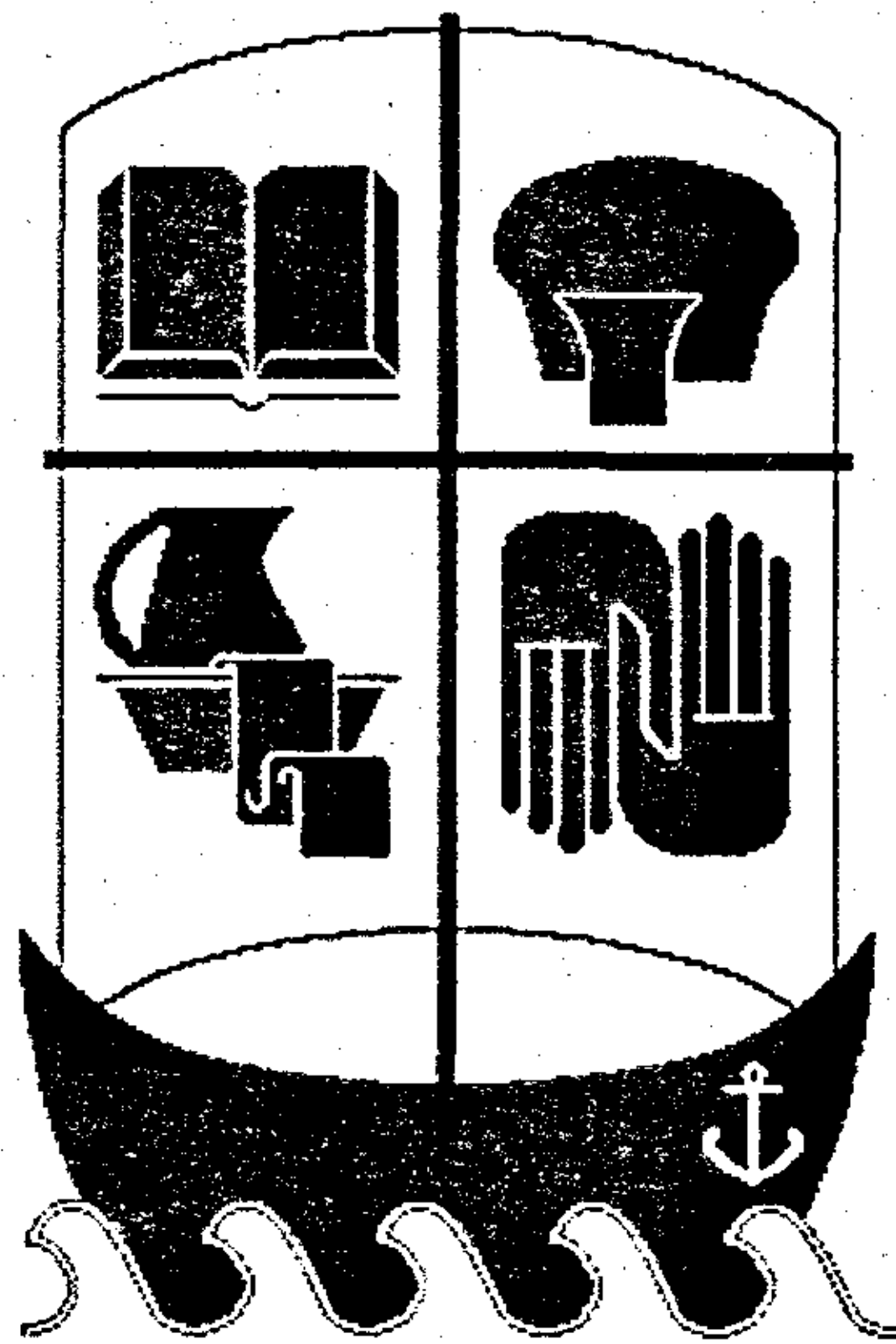

Functions of Committees

Planning Committee: The Planning Committee consists of the Moderator, Executive Director / Treasurer, and Chairman of each Board and reports to the Executive Committee. The responsibilities of the Planning Committee are to make intermediate and long-ranged plans for State Ministries; coordinate the efforts of the Mission Board and Christian Ministries Board; to plan the State Association theme and speakers; and to handle any items of review by the Executive Committee or the State Body.

Steering Committee: The Steering Committee consists of the Moderator, Clerk, Executive Director / Treasurer, the Chairman of the Christian Ministries Board and the President of the Florida Women Active For Christ. Others may be appointed by the Moderator on a special need basis. It exists for the purpose of coordinating our annual State Meeting. The responsibilities for this committee shall be: to negotiate with the various locations concerning rates and arrangements and to recommend locations to the State Body; to work with the various Convention Bureaus to secure sites; to make site inspections when necessary; to set and approve the catering contracts for meeting rooms and meal functions with the host hotel; to coordinate the meeting times and room specifications for each session; to set the schedule for the State Meeting; to coordinate the registration process for the State Meeting; and to be the on-site liaison for hotel staff.

Budget Committee: The Budget Committee consists of three members of the Executive Committee appointed by the Moderator one year in advance. The Executive Director / Treasurer serves as an ex-officio member. The responsibility of this committee is to analyze and compile the State's General Fund Budget. Budget requests will be submitted in writing. A representative will be available from Florida standing boards and commissions to provide information to the committee. The Executive Director will present his operating

expenses and the Coordinator expense. Direction from the State Moderator concerning administrative items will be provided. The Budget Committee has the authority to request additional information in compiling the budget. This budget will be presented to the Executive Committee for approval and recommendation to the State Body for final approval.

Auditing Committee: The Auditing Committee is composed of three members which shall be elected for three year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee. They are to review financial documents to determine that the Treasurer's report of each board and the State Association clearly reflects the financial activity for the year.

Promotional Team Concept:

The Executive Director – He is tasked with being the point man, representing the state ministries, not necessarily the office, to our associations and churches. This is a part-time position requiring two dates a month to be traveling.

The Editor of the Coordinator – He is tasked with delegating articles to be written and compiling the content of the state newsletter in whatever time period and manner published. He may or may not be tasked with actual layout and printing. This could lead to a fourth area that would become the Media Coordinator for all three of these positions (to handle their perspective promotions and graphic design and printing) or he may consider delegating this to the Media Commission.

Minutes of the Sixty-Second Annual Session of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

The Sixty-Second Annual Session of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at the Jacksonville Marriott in Jacksonville, Florida on April 26-28, 2006. This was a combined meeting with the Florida Women Active for Christ and the Florida Youth Conference. The theme for the meeting was "Building Kingdom Stewards."

Wednesday, April 26, 2006 ~ Evening Worship Service

The time of worship began with Danny Conn leading the congregation in: "All Hail The Power Of Jesus Name," "How Firm A Foundation," "Stand Up, Stand Up For Jesus," and "I Love To Tell The Story."

Clerk, David Baker, welcomed everyone to the Sixty-Second Annual Meeting of Florida Free Will Baptists and called the session to order. He introduced the Moderator, Paul Smith, who opened the service in prayer.

Bro. Bill Evans introduced our speaker for the Evening Service, Dr. Stan Toler. Before Dr. Toler spoke, a mixed trio from Free Will Baptist Bible College, New Mercy, shared "No Not One" and "My Jesus I Love Thee" for the special music.

After the special music, Dr. Toler delivered a challenging message entitled "Principles That Always Succeed In Building God's Church." His text was 1st Peter 1:22-25.

The Business Session was recessed for the afternoon with Leroy Cutler leading in prayer.

Thursday, April 27, 2006 ~ Evening Worship Service

The service began with Charlie Elliot leading the congregation in singing "When We All Get To Heaven." Donnie Hussey presided over the service and called upon Curtis Alligood to lead in prayer. Following the time of prayer, the congregation sang "He Hideth My Soul."

Executive Director's Report

“I know of no State Association that does more for its churches than does the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.” Those were the words of an individual within an agency of our National Association of Free Will Baptists. This statement should be a great encouragement to every one in our State because it confirms that we are accomplishing one of the aims of the Executive Office and of our Boards.

2005 became a year of history for the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists. For the first year in our history, we exceeded our budget in both our Cooperative Plan of support and in our Mission Shares giving! (Our Shares giving exceeded our budget by \$10,258.46 and our co-op giving exceeded its budget by \$5,028.51.) It was also an historic year with the formation of our State's Disaster Response Team sponsored by our Christian Ministries Board; with the start up of our Macedonia Fund to assist pastors and churches with various needs; and with the hiring of a missionary to open up a work in southwest Florida.

The Lord has been gracious to our State Association in allowing us to see several things accomplished during 2005. Among those accomplishments are:

- ❖ Total giving to our Mission Shares Plan of support of \$203,818.46. This reflects an increase of \$12,598.91 over the previous year.
- ❖ Total giving to our Co-operative Plan of support of \$113,156.51. This reveals an increase of \$4,052.99 over giving for 2004.
- ❖ The Second Annual Seniors' Summit was held in November in Orlando. There was great fellowship among those who attended. Dr. Ken Riggs did a superb job in preaching for us and everyone enjoyed Cindy Berry and Nicodemus. The Holy Land Experience proved to be both an educational and inspirational excursion for the group.
- ❖ The first annual Mission Shares Golf Tournament was held on August 26-27 in Gainesville. The tournament provided the golfers with an opportunity of fellowship, competition (though not too much), and the privilege of raising a little bit of money for the Shares Plan. Congratulations go to Sam Lucky and Buster Brister from Vero Beach for winning this year's tournament.
- ❖ Our Christian Ministries Board and Mission Board continue to function well. The Christian Ministries Board not only formed the Disaster Response Team but also offered beneficial Christian Workers' Conferences; a Minister's Retreat; college scholarships and oversaw the State Youth Competition. The Mission Board continues to provide oversight for our Shares Plan and the mission works in Gainesville and West Palm. The Mission Board also hired a new missionary to begin a work in the southwestern part of our State.
- ❖ **"The Coordinator"** continues to keep our people informed about happenings of our State Association. The editorial and layout team continues to do a superb job in publishing a newsletter that sets the standard for State Association publications. We want to express our

sincere thanks to Danny Conn for his editorial work and to Ron Hunter for his expertise in layout and design. Jose Rodriquez and Daniel Perez are also to be commended for their work with our Spanish edition.

- ❖ We have also had the privilege to offer assistance to various churches as they searched for pastors or sought direction on various church needs.

It has been my privilege to serve the churches and people of Florida. I have been truly blessed to serve in this ministry and witness what God is doing across our state. I have had the privilege of traveling over 25,000 miles representing the work of Free Will Baptists in Florida. I was able to attend 20 District Association meetings (attending each District at least once during the year), both Christian Workers' Conferences, the Seniors' Summit, the annual Mission Board trip; the National Association, the Leadership Conference and the RCMA Conference. On top of these, it has been my privilege to have services in several of your churches and conferences. I have cherished the opportunity to work with the Executive Committee, Planning Committee, Steering Committee and each of our Boards.

I do want to encourage you to make plans to join us for our third annual Seniors' Summit. It will be held on November 13-15, 2006. Also, plan now to join us for our 2nd Annual Mission Shares Cup Golf Tournament. This will be held on August 25-26 at the Meadowbrook Golf Course in Gainesville.

Allow me to take a few minutes to express my thanks to my wife for her encouragement and support as I continue this ministry. Also, let me thank the people of Ryanwood Fellowship Free Will Baptist Church for their graciousness in allowing me to serve in the capacity while still serving as their pastor. Their support and understanding reveals their great concern for the Lord's work beyond their own church.

Christian Ministries Board Report

The Florida Christian Ministries Board witnessed a very productive year in 2005. The newly commissioned *Disaster Response Team* launched into action following Hurricane Katrina. Over \$10,000 in aid was funneled through this state ministry to assist people in Gulfport, Mississippi and along the Gulf coast. When Hurricane Wilma struck South Florida, the DRT was able to provide much needed gasoline and generators, along with other supplies to churches in Miami and Hollywood. This year the Disaster Response Team has received designated gifts totaling \$12,000, to purchase equipment and supplies so we can be even better prepared to respond to the needs that may occur this year.

Nine students received scholarships to attend Free Will Baptist colleges. Three other scholarships were also awarded to Florida students who participated in the Truth & Peace Leadership Conference or served with E-Team Missions. \$300 in scholarships were also contributed to help individuals attend the 2005 Seniors Summit.

Florida Free Will Baptists gathered in Orlando and Destin to hear Eric Hovind defend Biblical Creationism. Teachers, ministers, parents, and students gained valuable instruction to counter the false theories of evolutionary science.

The 2005 SYC involved 102 youth from six churches. Forty-seven events advanced to the National competition in Louisville, KY. The following seventeen entries placed as finalists:

Constitution and By-Laws of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

Preamble

Article 1 – Name of Assembly

Section 1: This assembly shall be known as “The Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.”

Article II - Representation

Section 1: This Association shall be composed of delegates elected from the local associations belonging to this body and delegates elected from the local churches embraced by the various associations.

Section 2: All deacons and ministers who are members of, and in good standing with, a local church and local association which are members of this body are standing delegates.

Section 3: The general officers of this body shall be standing delegates.

Section 4: The delegates shall be elected as follows: one (1) delegate for each local church composed of 100 members or fraction thereof, and one (1) delegate for each additional 100 members or fraction thereof; five (5) delegates from each local association composed of fifteen (15) churches or fraction thereof, and one (1) additional delegate for each additional four (4) churches or fraction thereof. These additional delegates cannot be used unless the churches are active and are represented in the session in which they are appointed.

Article III – Officers, Boards and Committees

Section 1: Officers: the officers of this association shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, and Clerk to be elected by this Body while in regular session.

Section 2: The standing boards of this Association shall be the Florida Mission Board and the Christian Ministries Board.

Section 3: When the State Association deems it wise, committees or commissions may be established to perform a specific service in restricted area on more or less permanent basis. The number of members and their terms of office of any committee or commission shall be decided by vote of the State Association and the members shall be elected by the Association.

Section 4: The Executive Committee shall be composed of the Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, the Chairman of each Standing Board, and one elected member from each affiliated District Association. District Associations shall recommend their representatives on the Executive Board annually. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum.

Section 5: When vacancies occur either by death, removal from office or by resignation, the general officers shall appoint a temporary replacement until the next regular session of this body, at which time the body shall elect a permanent replacement. A proxy may be appointed by the body to fill any absentee's place who does not attend the session.

Section 6: General officers of the Association shall serve for the term of two (2) years.

Section 7: Each standing board and the Historical Commission shall be composed of five members which shall be elected for five year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually.

The auditing committee shall be composed of three members which shall be elected for three year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee.

The Budget committee will be appointed by the Moderator a year in advance. The committee will consist of three members from the Executive Committee and the State Treasurer will serve as an ex-officio member.

Section 8: This body shall have the right to discipline any officer or board member who does not conduct his office in a Christian and business-like manner according to the rules of Christian conduct laid down in the New Testament.

Section 9: The Executive Committee is to hire an Executive Director and to oversee his office. The Executive Director is to be a non-voting member of all boards and committees.

Article IV – Meetings

Section 1: Regular: This association shall convene annually in a joint meeting with the Florida Women Active for Christ and the Youth Conference on a Wednesday evening, Thursday, Friday and Saturday as close to the first Sunday in May as possible.

Section 2: Special: The Executive Committee may be called into session by the Moderator, or by a majority of its members.

Section 3: Quorum: Fifty (50) percent of the delegates shall constitute a quorum.

Article V – Finances

Section 1: All churches and associations in this body shall pay a representation fee annually. The amount of this for an association is \$200.00 per member church. The fee for local churches is \$10.00 per delegate.

Section 2: All Cooperative Plan funds coming into this body shall be spent under a budget plan. This budget must be approved by the body while in session, and no fund may be used in any way except as budgeted.

Section 3: Mileage for the Executive Committee members and standing Board members shall be paid at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. Expenses are to be paid from each Board member's account. If a called meeting requires a member to stay overnight, his room and board will be paid from the General Fund or his Board's account. Mileage and expenses shall be paid for the Moderator to attend the denomination's annual Leadership Conference.

By-Laws

Section 1: It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside over all deliberations of this body while in session. All meetings shall be governed by Roberts Rules of Order.

Section 2: The Assistant Moderator shall assume the duties, rights and privileges of the Moderator or Clerk in the absence of either.

Section 3: It shall be the duty of the Clerk to make and keep records of all the business proceedings and activities of this body.

Section 4: (1) It shall be the duty of the State Executive Office to receive all funds, pay all appropriate bills, disburse co-operative and designated funds in a timely manner according to the State Association's budget; (2) It shall be the duty of each State Board Treasurer to receive all funds for the board he serves, pay all appropriate bills, and disburse appropriate funds in a timely manner. (3) The State Executive Office and all State Board Treasurers shall use the same accounting system. (4) Each treasurer of the State Association shall submit his / her records to the State Association's Audit Committee annually for audit.

Section 5: It shall be the duty of the auditing committee to conduct a financial audit of each treasurer's books annually. The audit shall take place after the fiscal year and before the State Association convenes. The date for the audit will be agreed upon by the audit committee and the various treasurers who shall be present at the time their books are audited.

Section 6: It shall be the duty of the Budget Committee to make recommendations to the State Association concerning the total State Association Budget and the allocations of State Cooperative receipts.

Section 7: Each officer, board member and standing committee or commission member must be in good standing with a Free Will Baptist Church which is a member of this body. He must be in good standing with his local association and must live within the boundaries of this Association. No person shall serve on more than one board at the same time.

Section 8: The Executive Committee shall have full authority to do all acts for and in the name of the Association when the Association is not in session and shall make a general report of all their actions to the body annually.

Section 9: Amendments to this Constitution and By-Laws must be put before the body while in session one day before voted on, and must be read at least twice and passed by a two-thirds of the delegates present.

Constitution and By-Laws of the Florida State Free Will Baptist Mission Board

Article I – Name

This Board shall be known as the Florida Free Will Baptist Mission Board, Inc.

Article II – Purpose

This purpose of this board shall be that of promoting mission work among Free Will Baptists in the State of Florida, beginning new mission works in the state of Florida, and overseeing the missionary and the mission work until the mission is able to assume full self-supporting status.

Article III – Membership

This board shall be composed of members elected by the State Association and shall serve terms established on a rotational basis. One member's term shall expire annually. The number of members of this board shall be determined by the Constitution and By-Laws of the State Association

Article IV – Officers and Committees

Officers of this board shall be Chairman and Secretary / Treasurer. These officers shall hold office for one (1) year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms. The board members have the option of hiring a treasurer who is not a board member. Members of the board shall elect the officers and/or hire the treasurer of the board. Committees may be appointed by the chairman elected by the board as the need arises.

Article V – Meetings

Meetings shall be held as the need arises. Necessary meetings may be called by the chairman or any three members.

Article VI – Finances

This board shall receive its finances from churches and individuals making special contributions, cooperative program allocations, interest on loans, and special offerings received through promoting missions. Mileage for board member expenses shall be paid from the general fund at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. All other Board travel expenses shall be reimbursed at members cost.

By-Laws

Section 1: Officers of the board shall hold office according to the terms set forth in the Constitution and shall carry out those duties peculiar to the respective offices. The Secretary shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's activities. The Treasurer shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's financial transactions. All records and property mortgages and titles shall be surrendered to the succeeding Secretary.

Section 2: A majority membership shall constitute a quorum and be duly authorized to transact business. All items of business must receive a majority vote of a quorum before it is considered final. All members not present in meetings shall be notified of decisions made by the Board.

Section 3: All members shall endeavor to support mission work through cooperative efforts of the Board. Any member that fails to cooperate with the board for a period of one year may, upon recommendation of the Board, be replaced by the State Association.

Section 4: A complete report of the Board Meetings and activities and a complete financial report must be presented to the annual State Association Meeting.

Section 5: Missions and Churches receiving financial support must be in good standing with an association or quarterly meeting affiliated with the state or national association and must have a pastor in good standing with the Free Will Baptist denomination.

Section 6: The board shall have the right, by majority vote, to purchase property where there is good possibility for organizing a Free Will Baptist Church. Full title must be acquired, and no investment shall exceed the appraised value

of the real property. Missionaries and mission works receiving funding from the Mission Board will be under the direct supervision of the mission board. Missionaries serve mission works at the discretion of the board. Missions and churches with Pastors employed by the board shall be under the authority of this board shall be under the authority of this board for any no routine purchases or financial obligations.

Section 7: The mission board will be responsible for administering the Mission Shares Program un the guidelines set by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Section 8: Any work receiving financial support must agree to support the denominational cooperative program.

Section 9: The Board shall have the right by majority vote to sell any personal or real property it deems is not necessary for continued religious use.

Section 10: Nominal grants by the Board to worthwhile churches or missions may be made when it is in the interest of the denominational cause in which benefits are certain. Grants of this nature shall be subject to money being immediately available and shall not exceed \$1000.00 without joint approval of the Mission Board and the State Executive Committee or Association.

Section 11: The Constitution and By-Laws may be amended by a majority vote of the Board members with the approval of the State Body.

Constitution of the Christian Ministries Board of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

Article I - Name

This board shall be known as the Christian Ministries Board of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Article II - Duties

Section 1. The board shall (1) Promote the educational aims of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists;

(2) Coordinate & direct youth training and competitive activities; (3) Encourage and equip Christian leaders and workers for effective ministry through the local Church.

Section 2. The board shall give a report of its activities, financial statement, and property inventory, and present a budget request to the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists at its annual meeting.

Article III - Membership

Section 1. The board shall be composed of five members who shall be elected for a term of five years, arranged whereby only one member's term expires annually. Unexpired terms will be filled by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Section 2. Officers of this board shall be (1) Chairman, (2) Secretary, (3) Treasurer. Officers shall be elected by the board for one year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms.

Article IV - Meetings

Section 1. Meetings shall be held annually with additional meetings called by the chairman, or by any three members, as necessary.

Article V - Finances

Section 1. This board shall receive its finances from (1) Cooperative program allocation, (2) Fund raising projects, (3) Registration fees, and (4) Designated giving.

Section 2. Appropriate expenses incurred on official board business shall be paid or reimbursed from the general fund of the Christian Ministries Board. Mileage shall be paid at the current IRS rate.

Article VI - Amendments

This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.
