Functions of Committees

Planning Committee: The Planning Committee consists of the Moderator, Executive Director/Treasurer, and Chairman of each Board and reports to the Executive Committee. The responsibilities of the Planning Committee are to make intermediate and long range plans for State Ministries; coordinate the efforts of the Mission Board and Christian Ministries Board; to plan the State Association theme and speakers; and to handle any items of review by the Executive Committee or the State Body.

Steering Committee: The Steering Committee consists of the Moderator, Clerk, Executive Director/Treasurer, the Chairman of the Christian Ministries Board and the President of the Florida Women Active For Christ. Others may be appointed by the Moderator on a special needs basis. It exists for the purpose of coordinating our annual State Meeting. The responsibilities for this committee shall be: to negotiate with the various locations concerning rates and arrangements and to recommend locations to the State Body; to work with the various Convention Bureaus to secure sites; to make site inspections when necessary; to set and approve the catering contracts for meeting rooms and meal functions with the host hotel; to coordinate the meeting times and room specifications for each session; to set the schedule for the State Meeting; to coordinate the registration process for the State Meeting; and to be the on-site liaison for hotel staff.

Budget Committee: The Budget Committee consists of three members of the Executive Committee appointed by the Moderator one year in advance. The Executive Director/Treasurer serves as an ex-officio member. The responsibility of this committee is to analyze and compile the State's General Fund Budget. Budget requests will be submitted in writing. A representative will be available from Florida standing boards and commissions to provide information to the committee. The Executive Director will present his operating expenses and the Coordinator expense. Direction from the State Moderator concerning administrative items will be provided. The Budget Committee has the authority to request additional information in compiling the budget. This budget will be presented to the Executive Committee for approval and recommendation to the State Body for final approval.

Auditing Committee: The Auditing Committee is composed of three members who shall be elected for three year terms on a rotating basis, so that

one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee. They are to review financial documents to determine that the Treasurer's report of each board and State Association clearly reflects the financial activity for the year.

Promotional Team Concept:

The Executive Director – The Executive Director is the chief administrative officer of our State. He is tasked with being the point man, representing the state ministries, not necessarily the office, to our associations and churches. He is the primary contact with our National Association, the editor-in-chief of *The Coordinator*, and the State Treasurer. This is a part-time position requiring two dates a month to be traveling. (Complete details of this position are laid out in its job description.)

The Editor of the Coordinator – The editor is tasked with delegating articles to be written and compiling the content of the state newsletter in whatever time period and manner published. They may or may not be tasked with actual layout and printing. This could lead to a fourth area that would become the Media Coordinator for all three of these positions (to handle their perspective promotions and graphic design and printing) or he may consider delegating this to the Media Commission.

Minutes of the Sixty-Fifth Annual Session of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

The Sixty-Fifth Annual Session of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at the Lake Mary Marriott in Lake Mary, Florida on April 29 – May 2, 2009. Executive Director's Report

The 2008 calendar year proved to be a great year for our State Association to be used as a channel to further His kingdom within the State of Florida and outside our borders. God used our State to make a significant impact in His work through our Mission Shares Plan of Support, through co-operative efforts and through our participation in Project Villalba.

A check of 2008 reveals numerous successes for the year:

- Project Villalba heads the list of successes for 2008. Our State rallied around the project of helping the church in Villalba, Spain build the first free standing evangelical church in their portion of the Madrid province. We received \$71,212.59 from 33 different churches, associations and boards throughout our state. This proved to be the most significant cooperative effort our state has ever experienced.
- Our Cooperative Plan of Support proved to be positive for us. The middle of 2008 revealed that our State was in a serious financial situation. Our co-op and general funds were better than \$6,000 in the red with all our reserves used for day to day operations. An appeal went out to our churches for assistance and in the space of about six weeks we were not only out of the red, but almost \$2,000 in the black. This revealed again the graciousness of the people in our state and the fact that people will give when they are challenged and pastors will present the need.
- Each of our meetings during 2008 proved successful.
 - Our 2008 Seniors' Summit had the highest registration of any so far. This year's Summit was held in St. Augustine and included a hopeful visit to the Fountain of Youth. The only disappointment of the event was the discovery that drinking from the fountain did not bring the desired results. Rev. David Shores did an excellent job relating to the needs of the group through his messages. A special thank you to the CM Board for providing

funds for those who could not otherwise afford to attend.

- The 2008 Christian Worker's Conferences, sponsored by the CM Board, were exceptional in challenging attendees to take a serious look at their churches and their relevancy, especially to those outside the church.
- The 2008 Minister's Retreat was a cruise to the Yucatan Peninsula. The group had great fellowship and fun during the 6 day / 5 night cruise.
- The Mission Shares Golf Tournament proved to be a successful event, even though the dates had to be changed due to the arrival of Tropical Storm Fay. The number of golfers was down from previous years but everyone had a great time of fellowship and golf. Sam Lucky and Buster Brister from Vero Beach won the tournament for the fourth year in a row.

Our State Association experienced some serious challenges during the year as well. One involved our Mission Shares Plan of Support. Our Mission Shares dropped some \$26,640 from 2007 and fell almost \$28,000 below this year's Shares budget. The \$172,881.82 received in Mission Shares was the lowest amount received since 2000. The decline in the Shares plan is a major concern that must be addressed.

Another challenge from the past year concerns the securing of pastors for our churches. This continues to be a real test for several of our churches, especially our smaller, bi-vocational works. Also, we continued to deal with the need for getting a greater percentage of our churches and pastors involved in our State ministries. As long as I can remember, we have seen only a small percentage of our churches participate in our conferences, retreats and programs. It is the desire of our State Association to provide programs and ministries that will assist our churches in fulfilling their part of the Great Commission. The conferences are designed to help our churches train and disciple their people; our Seniors' Summit is designed to offer

fellowship and encouragement to our seniors; our Mission Shares program assists our churches in their role of spreading the Gospel; our ministers' retreats provide renewal and encouragement for our pastors; and *The Coordinator* serves to keep our people informed with ministry opportunities and denominational news.

Let me express my commendations to the team that produces *The Coordinator*. Chrissy Kinney has adapted well in her role as editor and Ron Hunter continues to serve us well in layout and design. Daniel Perez and Jose Rodriguez have done an excellent job in working on our Spanish edition of *The Coordinator*. It is with regret that we had to discontinue the publishing of our Spanish edition at the beginning of 2009. In my opinion, *The Coordinator* continues to be one of the best publications among our Free Will Baptist State Associations.

I would also like to commend our officers, boards and committees for their hard work in making our State Association function. They continue to strive to make a difference in our churches and in our denomination. Their commitment to their mission and the sacrifice of their time makes my task much easier.

A special commendation goes to Mike Taggart for his work with our State Association's website. Mike has done a tremendous job in bringing our website up to date and in maintaining the site. You can find needed information about State Association activities, and registration forms for events. The address has changed to FLAFWB.com.

As we look forward to the events in 2009, I want to encourage you to promote these events within your churches and associations. These events are planned at this time:

- Mission Shares Golf Tournament, August 28-29 at the Plantation Inn in Crystal River. This year's location will offer a lot of convenience since participants will be staying on the golf course property. The cost will be \$150 per player for double occupancy. Single occupancy will be \$200 per player. This will include 2 rounds of golf, a steak

dinner on Friday night, breakfast on Saturday morning and your room.

- Christian Workers' Conferences which are tentatively scheduled for September 18-19 in Orlando and November 6-7 in Destin.
- Seniors' Summit, October 19-21 at the Plantation Inn in Crystal River. This year's excursion will include a trip to Homosassa Springs State Park. The park offers the opportunity to see a number of animals native to Florida, as well as viewing manatees up close. We are pleased to announce that the registration fee will remain the same as previous years. The \$225 per couple will cover 2 nights stay, 2 full breakfasts, the excursion to Homosassa Springs State Park and lunch on Tuesday.

It's important to me for everyone to be reminded that these events don't take place just to have something to do, or for purely social reasons. Our purpose is to advance the Kingdom and support the work of the gospel. Through these events, we hope to be teaching, encouraging, edifying the body, and helping to support our ministries financially. Building relationships and having opportunity for good Christian fellowship is vitally important in today's world. In uncertain times we can draw strength from each other, and as we have said so many times, we can accomplish so much more for the Lord together than any one of us can alone.

It has been my privilege to serve as your Executive Director during this past year. I have been honored to represent the Florida work at 21 district association meetings; numerous local churches, two Christian Workers Conferences; the Minister's Retreat; the Seniors' Summit; The Mission Shares Golf Tournament; National Association of Free Will Baptists convention; the Leadership Conference; the Religious Conference Management Association; Rejuvenate Conference and the Palmer Leadership Institute. The Lord has been gracious in providing safety. He has also allowed me to minister to, minister with, and fellowship with some of the finest people in the State of Florida. Thank you for your hospitality and for your support.

Christian Ministries Board Report

National Youth Conference: We had a very successful year with our State and National Youth Conference. This year, we had 102 entries in our State Youth Competition. We had 61 entries, with 31 placing in the top three in their respective categories at the National Youth Conference.

Christian Workers Conferences: We had 41 in attendance at the Orlando Christian Workers Conference, and 92 for the north conference. Roy Harris did a wonderful job and received a lot of great comments on the seminar this year. Our CWC this year is "Staying Relevant in the 21st Century." He took a detailed look at six different areas that will make or break a church's effectiveness in reaching the 21st Century World.

Minister's Retreat: The theme for this year's Minister's Retreat was "Emotional First Aid," with Dr. Eddie Moody, Jr. speaking. First Aid for the Emotional Hurts provided pastors with the tools and knowledge needed to help the hurting through significant issues of life. The retreat was held January 19-22, 2009 at Historic St. Augustine Beach.

Scholarship and Evangelistic Grants: We were able to help six students in the fall semester and eight in the spring semester.

Thank you for allowing us to share in the ministries of the Florida Free Will Baptists.

Mission Board Report

Your Florida Free Will Baptist Mission Board experienced disappointments and great joy during 2008. We thank you for standing with us and supporting the work of Free Will Baptists in Florida and around the world.

Effective April 1, 2008, our church planting effort in Ft. Myers was closed. Missionary pastor, Rev. Daryl Ellis, was compensated through August 1, 2008 on a declining scale. We are grateful for his efforts. Perhaps God will yet use us to launch a work in that area.

At this time last year, Rev. Andres Sancho and his wife Nora, our Hispanic church planters in West Palm Beach, were anticipating their move to a larger facility. The new facility was occupied in late summer and dedicated in a special service on September 20, 2008. It was the privilege of several board members to join our Executive Director at that event. Brother Andres will be recognized to bring a personal report.

The board continues its efforts to know and follow God's will for a new church plant in our state. During the year contacts were made and an interview conducted.

2009 is bringing new challenges and opportunities. Pray God will give us His grace and wisdom. We do not take lightly the responsibility to serve Him with you.

The roll call was read with the following members present: Donnie Hussey, Steve Faison, Randy Bryant, Larry Clyatt, Charlie Elliott, Jimmy Aldridge, Sid Baker, Sam Lucky, R. C. Wiggins and Lonnie Buser. Jonathan Bowman and Ron Burger were seated as proxies from Liberty and Salem Associations respectively.

1. We have heard the report from the Executive Office, the State Treasurer, the Christian Ministries Board, the Florida Mission Board, Mission Shares Committee, the Steering Committee, the Planning Committee, and the Budget Committee. We recommend the acceptance of the reports and adoption of the budgets.
2. We recommend that we assist the Christian Ministries Board financially by giving \$2,000 from the General Fund.
3. We recommend that we proceed with planning and implementing the Palmer Leadership Institute as modeled by the National Association of Free Will Baptists, adapting to Florida State Association as needed.
4. We recommend the description of the responsibilities of the Executive Director as listed in the Digest of Reports be updated.

Current:

The Executive Director – He is tasked with being the point man, representing the state ministries, not necessarily the office, to our associations and churches. This is a part-time position requiring two dates a month to be traveling.

Recommended:

Executive Director: The Executive Director is the chief administrative officer of our State. He is tasked with being the

point man, representing the state ministries, not necessarily the office, to our associations and churches. He is the primary contact with our National Association, the editor-in-chief of *The Coordinator*, and the State Treasurer. This is a part-time position requiring at least two dates a month for traveling. (Complete details of this position are laid out in its job description.)

5. Based on a request from the Alabama Children's Home, we recommend that the Executive Director serve as a Board Member, and that one additional Board member be brought from the Nominating Committee.
6. We recommend that Rev. Larry Clyatt serve as a proxy to the 2009 General Board meeting at the National Convention in Cincinnati, OH due to the vacancy left by Rev. Paul Smith's relocation to Georgia.
7. We recommend the amendment of our Constitution to address the affiliation with the National Association of Free Will Baptists and our representation on its General Board. We recommend the following addition to the Constitution be adopted at this session of the Florida State Association:

Article II Association

Section 1

This Association shall be affiliated with the National Association of Free Will Baptists, Inc.

Section 2

The Executive Director shall serve as the official representative on the General Board of the National Association of Free Will Baptists, Inc. If, for any reason, the Executive Director is unable to fulfill this responsibility, the order of appointment to this position from among the current General Officers shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk. In the event a representative is still needed, one may be elected from the body.

Each of the subsequent Articles of the Constitution will then be numbered appropriately.

8. We recommend the adoption of the Mission Shares Proposed Budget.
9. We recommend the adoption of the Budget Committee Report.
10. We recommend the dissolution of the Historical Commission and the money in their account be reverted back to the General Fund. In doing so, we recommend an amendment to the Constitution as follows:

Current:

Section 7: Each standing board and the Historical Commission shall be composed of five members which shall be elected for five (5) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually.

The auditing committee shall be composed of three members which shall be elected for three (3) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee.

The budget committee will be appointed by the Moderator a year in advance. The committee will consist of three members from the Executive Committee and the State Treasurer will serve as an ex-officio member.

Recommended:

Section 7: Each standing board and ~~the Historical Commission~~ shall be composed of five members which shall be elected for five (5) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually.

The auditing committee shall be composed of three members which shall be elected for three (3) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee.

The budget committee will be appointed by the Moderator a year in advance. The committee will consist of three members from the Executive Committee and the State Treasurer will serve as an ex-officio member.

Credentials Committee Report

1. We have received the reports and dues from the following associations: Central, Greater St. John's, Hispanic, Indian River, Liberty, Salem S. Florida and W. Florida. We recommend their delegates be seated for this session.
2. Due to the dissolution of the Citrus Association, we have received reports and dues from the Encuentro Con Dios FWB Church and the First FWB Church (Ocala) who have been unable to join another association prior to the reporting date. We recommend seating their delegates for this session only with the understanding they will be joining an association in the near future.
3. We recommend the seating of any properly registered standing delegates and local church delegates for this session.

Constitution and By-laws of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

Article 1 – Name of Assembly

Section 1: This assembly shall be known as “The Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Article II – Association

Section 1: This Association shall be affiliated with the National Association of Free Will Baptists, Inc.

Section 2: The Executive Director shall serve as the official representative on the General Board of the National Association of Free Will Baptists, Inc. If, for any reason, the Executive Director is unable to fulfill this responsibility, the order of appointment to this position from among the current General Officers shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk. In the event a representative is still needed, one may be elected from the body.

Article III – Representation

Section 1: This Association shall be composed of delegates elected from the local associations belonging to this body and delegates elected from the local churches embraced by the various associations.

Section 2: All deacons and ministers who are members of, and in good standing with, a local church and local association which are members of this body are standing delegates.

Section 3: The general officers of this body shall be standing delegates.

Section 4: The delegates shall be elected as follows: one (1) delegate for each local church composed of 100 members or fraction thereof, and one (1) delegate for each additional 100 members or fraction thereof; (5) delegates from each local association composed of fifteen (15) churches or fraction thereof, and one (1) additional delegate for each additional four (4) churches or fraction thereof. These additional delegates cannot be used unless the churches are active and are represented in the session in which they are appointed.

Article IV – Officers, Boards and Committees

Section 1: Officers: the officers of this association shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, and Clerk to be elected by this Body while in regular session.

Section 2: The standing boards of this Association shall be the Florida Mission Board and the Christian Ministries Board.

Section 3: When the State Association deems it wise, committees or commissions may be established to perform a specific service in restricted area on more or less permanent basis. The number of members and their terms of office of any committee or commission shall be decided by vote of the State Association and the members shall be elected by the Association.

Section 4: The Executive Committee shall be composed of the Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, the Chairman of each Standing Board, and one elected member from each affiliated District Association. District Associations shall recommend their representatives on the Executive Board annually. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum.

Section 5: When vacancies occur either by death, removal from office or by resignation, the general officers shall appoint a temporary replacement until the next regular session of this body, at which time the body shall elect a permanent replacement. A proxy may be appointed by the body to fill any absentee's place who does not attend the session.

Section 6: General officers of the Association shall serve for the term of two (2) years.

Section 7: Each standing board shall be composed of five members which shall be elected for five (5) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually.

The auditing committee shall be composed of three members which shall be elected for three (3) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee.

The budget committee will be appointed by the Moderator a year in advance. The committee will consist of three members from the Executive Committee and the State Treasurer will serve as an ex-officio member.

Section 8: This body shall have the right to discipline any officer or board member who does not conduct his office in a Christian and business-like manner according to the rules of Christian conduct laid down in the New Testament.

Section 9: The Executive Committee is to hire an Executive Director and to oversee his office. The Executive Director is to be a non-voting member of all boards and committees.

Article V – Meetings

Section 1: Regular: This association shall convene annually in a joint meeting with the Florida Women Active for Christ and the Youth Conference on a Wednesday evening, Thursday, Friday and Saturday as close to the first Sunday in May as possible.

Section 2: Special: The Executive Committee may be called into session by the Moderator, or by a majority of its members.

Section 3: Quorum: Fifty (50) percent of the delegates shall constitute a quorum.

Article VI – Finances

Section 1: All churches and associations in this body shall pay a representation fee annually. The amount of this for an association is \$200.00 per member church. The fee for local churches is \$10.00 per delegate.

Section 2: All Cooperative Plan funds coming into this body shall be spent under a budget plan. This budget must be approved by the body while in session, and no fund may be used in any way except as budgeted.

Section 3: Mileage for the Executive Committee members and standing Board members shall be paid at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. Expenses are to be paid from each Board member's account. If a called meeting requires a member to stay overnight, his room and board will be paid from the General Fund or his Board's account. Mileage and expenses shall be paid for the Moderator to attend the denomination's annual Leadership Conference.

By-Laws

Section 1: It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside over all deliberations of this body while in session. All meetings shall be governed by Roberts Rules of Order.

Section 2: The Assistant Moderator shall assume the duties, rights and privileges of the Moderator or Clerk in the absence of either.

Section 3: It shall be the duty of the Clerk to make and keep records of all the business proceedings and activities of this body.

Section 4: (1) It shall be the duty of the State Executive Office to receive all funds, pay all appropriate bills, disburse cooperative and designated funds in a timely manner according to the State Association's budget; (2) It shall be the

duty of each State Board Treasurer to receive all funds for the board he serves, pay all appropriate bills, and disburse appropriate funds in a timely manner. (3) The State Executive Office and all State Board Treasurers shall use the same accounting system. (4) Each treasurer of the State Association shall submit his/her records to the State Association's Audit Committee annually for audit.

Section 5: It shall be the duty of the auditing committee to conduct a financial audit of each treasurer's books annually. The audit shall take place after the fiscal year and before the State Association convenes. The date for the audit will be agreed upon by the audit committee and the various treasurers who shall be present at the time their books are audited.

Section 6: It shall be the duty of the Budget Committee to make recommendations to the State Association concerning the total State Association Budget and the allocations of State Cooperative receipts.

Section 7: Each officer, board member and standing committee or commission member must be in good standing with a Free Will Baptist Church which is a member of this body. He must be in good standing with his local association and must live within the boundaries of this Association. No person shall serve on more than one board at the same time.

Section 8: The Executive Committee shall have full authority to do all acts for and in the name of the Association when the Association is not in session and shall make a general report of all their actions to the body annually.

Section 9: Amendments to this Constitution and By-Laws must be put before the body while in session one day before voted on, and must be read at least twice and passed by two-thirds of the delegates present.

Constitution and By-Laws of the Florida State Free Will Baptist Mission Board

Article I – Name

This Board shall be known as the Florida Free Will Baptist Mission Board, Inc.

Article II – Purpose

The purpose of this Board shall be that of promoting mission work among Free Will Baptist in the State of Florida, beginning new mission works in the state of Florida, and overseeing the missionary and the mission work until the mission is able to assume full self-supporting status.

Article III – Membership

This Board shall be composed of members elected by the State Association and shall serve terms established on a rotational basis. One member's term shall expire annually. The number of members of this board shall be determined by the Constitution and By-Laws of the State Association.

Article IV – Officers and Committees

Officers of this board shall be Chairman and Secretary/Treasurer. These officers shall hold office for one (1) year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms. The board members have the option of hiring a treasurer who is not a board member. Members of the board shall elect the officers, and/or hire the treasurer of the board. Committees may be appointed by the chairman elected by the board as the need arises.

Article V – Meetings

Meetings shall be held as the need arises. Necessary meetings may be called by the chairman or any three members.

Article VI – Finances

This Board shall receive its finances from churches and individuals making special contributions, cooperative program allocations, interest on loans, and

special offering received through promoting missions. Mileage for board member expenses shall be paid from the general fund at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. All other Board travel expenses shall be reimbursed at members cost.

By-Laws

Section 1: Officers of the board shall hold office according to the terms set forth in the Constitution and shall carry out those duties peculiar to the respective offices. The Secretary shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's activities. The Treasurer shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's financial transactions. All records and property mortgages and titles shall be surrendered to the succeeding Secretary.

Section 2: A majority membership shall constitute a quorum and be duly authorized to transact business. All items of business must receive a majority vote of a quorum before it is considered final. All members not present in meetings shall be notified of decisions made by the board.

Section 3: All members shall endeavor to support mission work through cooperative efforts of the Board. Any member that fails to cooperate with the board for a period of one year may, upon recommendation of the Board, be replaced by the State Association.

Section 4: A complete report of the Board Meetings and activities and a complete financial report must be presented to the annual State Association Meeting.

Section 5: Missions and Churches receiving financial support must be in good standing with an association or quarterly meeting affiliated with the state or national association and must have a pastor in good standing with the Free Will Baptist denomination.

Section 6: The board shall have the right, by majority vote, to purchase property where there is good possibility for organizing a Free Will Baptist Church. Full title must be acquired, and no investment shall exceed the appraised value of the real property. Missionaries and mission works receiving funding from the Mission Board will be under the direct supervision of the Mission Board. Missionaries serve mission works at the discretion of the Board. Missions and churches with Pastors employed by the board shall be under the authority of this Board for any non routine purchases or financial obligations.

Section 7: The Mission Board will be responsible for administering the Mission Shares Program under the guidelines set by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Section 8: Any work receiving financial support must agree to support the denominational cooperative program.

Section 9: The Board shall have the right by majority vote to sell any personal or real property it deems is not necessary for continued religious use.

Section 10: Nominal grants by the Board to worthwhile churches or missions may be made when it is in the interest of the denominational cause in which benefits are certain. Grants of this nature shall be subject to money being immediately available and shall not exceed \$1,000.00 without joint approval of the Mission Board and the State Executive Committee or Association.

Section 11: The Constitution and By-Laws may be amended by a majority vote of the Board members with the approval of the State Body.

Constitution of the Christian Ministries Board of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

Article I – Name

This board shall be known as the Christian Ministries Board of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Article II – Duties

Section 1: The board shall (1) Promote the educational aims of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists; (2) Coordinate and direct youth training and competitive activities; (3) Encourage and equip Christian leaders and workers for effective ministry through the local church.

Section 2: The board shall give a report of its activities, financial statement, and property inventory, and present a budget request to the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists at its annual meeting.

Article III – Membership

Section 1: The board shall be composed of five members who shall be elected for a term of five years, arranged whereby only one member's term expires annually. Unexpired terms will be filled by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Section 2: Officers of this board shall be (1) Chairman, (2) Secretary, (3) Treasurer. Officers shall be elected by the board for one year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms.

Article IV – Meetings

Section 1: Meetings shall be held annually with additional meetings called by the chairman, or by any three members, as necessary.

Article V – Finances

Section 1: This board shall receive its finances from (1) Cooperative program allocation, (2) Fund raising projects, (3) Registration fees, and (4) Designated giving.

Section 2: Appropriate expenses incurred on official board business shall be paid or reimbursed from general fund of the Christian Ministries Board. Mileage shall be paid at the current IRS rate.

Article VI – Amendments

This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.
