Functions of Committees

<u>Planning Committee:</u> The Planning Committee consists of the Moderator, Executive Director/Treasurer, and Chairman of each Board and reports to the Executive Committee. The responsibilities of the Planning Committee are to make intermediate and long range plans for State Ministries; coordinate the efforts of the Mission Board and Christian Ministries Board; to plan the State Association theme and speakers; and to handle any items of review by the Executive Committee or the State Body.

Steering Committee: The Steering Committee consists of the Moderator, Clerk, Executive Director/Treasurer, the Chairman of the Christian Ministries Board and the President of the Florida Women Active for Christ. Others may be appointed by the Moderator on a special needs basis. It exists for the purpose of coordinating our annual State Meeting. The responsibilities of this committee shall be: to negotiate with the various locations concerning rates and arrangements and to recommend locations to the State Body; to work with the various Convention Bureaus to secure sites; to make site inspections when necessary; to set and approve the catering contracts for meeting rooms and meal functions with the host hotel; to coordinate the meeting times and room specifications for each session; to set the schedule for the State Meeting; to coordinate the registration process for the State Meeting; and to be the on-site liaison for hotel staff.

Budget Committee: The Budget Committee consists of three members of the Executive Committee appointed by the Moderator one year in advance. The Executive Director/Treasurer serves as an ex-officio member. responsibility of this committee is to analyze and compile the State's General Fund Budget. Budget requests will be submitted in writing. A representative will be available from Florida standing boards and commissions to provide information to the committee. The Executive Director will present his operating expenses and the Coordinator expense. Direction from the State Moderator concerning administrative items will be provided. The Budget Committee has the authority to request additional information in compiling the budget. This budget will be presented to the Executive Committee for approval and recommendation to the State Body for final approval.

Auditing Committee: The Auditing Committee is composed of three members who shall be elected for three year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee. They are to review financial documents to determine that the Treasurer's report of each board and State Association clearly reflects the financial activity for the year.

Promotional Team Concept:

The Executive Director – The Executive Director is the chief administrative officer of our State. He is tasked with being the point man, representing the state ministries, not necessarily the office, to our associations and churches. He is the primary contact with our National Association, the editor-in-chief of The Coordinator, and the State Treasurer. This is a part-time position requiring two dates a month to be traveling. (Complete details of this position are laid out in its job description.)

The Editor of the Coordinator – The editor is tasked with delegating articles to be written and compiling the content of the state newsletter in whatever time period and manner published.

Minutes of the Sixty-Seventh Annual Session of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

The Sixty-Seventh Annual Session of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at the Jacksonville Marriott in Jacksonville, Florida on April 27 – 29, 2011. This was a combined meeting with the Florida Women Active for Christ and the Florida Youth Conference. The theme for the meeting was "Does Jesus Care."

Wednesday, April 27, 2011 – Evening Worship Service

The Christian Ministries Board report was given by Charlie Elliott. Motion (C. Elliott) Second (C. Hutchinson) Carried.

The Randall House Publication report was given by Ron Hunter. The report was received as information.

The Florida Mission Board report was given by Larry Clyatt. Missionaries Andres Sancho (West Palm Beach) and Yoan Chirino (Melbourne and Vero Beach) brought greetings to the body. Larry Clyatt also presented the Mission Shares budget

as well. Motion (L. Clyatt) Second (E. Hutchinson) to accept the report and adopt their budgets. Carried.

The National Home Missions Board report was given by Rick Bowling. The report was received as information.

The International Missions Board report was given by Sam McVay. The report was received as information.

The Florida State Executive Director report was given by Randy Bryant. Motion (K. Stott) Second (S. Lucky). Carried.

The National Executive Department report was given by Keith Burden. The report was received as information.

The final Executive Committee report was given by Steve Faison. Motion (S. Faison) Second (P. Dillon) to accept the report and adopt item by item. Carried.

Item 2.1: Motion (J. Pinson) Second (S. Lucky) to accept the recommendation. Carried.

Item 2.2: Motion (J. Christian) Second (C. Hutchinson) to accept the recommendation. Carried.

Item 3: The Budget Committee report given by John Gilliland. Motion (J. Gilliland) Second (S. Lucky) to accept the budget. Carried.

Item 4: Motion (K. Stott) Second (L. Craddock) to accept this as information. Carried.

The Alabama Children's Home report was given by Danny Williams. This report was received as information.

The Auditing Committee report was given by Andres Sancho. Motion (A. Sancho) Second (J. Pinson) to receive the report. Carried.

Tim Owen asked for volunteers to serve as delegates to the National Association in Charlotte, NC. Peggy Clyatt will serve as a delegate. Motion (R. Draper) Second (P. Dillon) to empower Assistant Moderator to appoint other delegates as available. Carried.

Motion (c. Hutchinson) Second (R. Draper) to table the constitution change (Article VI Section 1) replacing \$200 with \$300. Carried.

Article VI Section 1 Currently: "All churches and associations in this body shall pay a representation fee annually. The amount of this for an association is \$200.00 per member church. The fee for local churches is \$10.00 per delegate."

Proposed: "All churches and associations in this body shall pay a representation fee annually. The amount of this for an

association is \$300.00 per member church. The fee for local churches is \$10.00 per delegate."

We were recessed for the evening.

Thursday, April 28, 2011 - Evening Worship Service

Alejandro Rodriguez led the congregation in singing Shout To The Lord. Jim Christian led in prayer. The Mass Choir sang He Will Carry You. The congregation sang He Lives. New Mercy from FWBBC sang Where Would We Be Without the Love of Jesus and No One Understands Like Jesus. The congregation sang Above All. Alejandro Rodriguez sang Find Us Faithful. Larry Clyatt introduced our speaker for the evening, David Williford. He spoke from Psalm 46:1 encouraging us to lean on God in the face of uncertainty and difficulties.

After announcements, Larry dismissed us in prayer.

Friday April 29, 2011, Morning Business Session

Tim Owen called the meeting to order, Jimmy Aldridge opened session in prayer.

The Nominating Committee report was given by John Pinson. Motion (L. Cutler) Second (R. Draper) to receive report. This motion was amended to read, To accept the motion and elect as a slate of officers. (J. Gilliland) Second (R. Draper) Carried.

Tim Owen introduced the motion laid on the table from Thursday's session regarding constitutional change. Motion (J. Gilliand) Second (R. Draper) to remove the motion from the table. Carried. Motion voted on. Carried.

Background was given to policy set in motion regarding reporting opportunities to our state association. Motion (Steve Berry) had been presented in writing Second (M. Taggart): "I make a motion that Southeastern Free Will Baptist College or other Free Will Baptist ministry be allowed to give a report on the state floor provided we have a church in the state that is willing to send a letter in advance requesting in writing the annual desire to receive a report at the State Meeting." Motion failed.

Executive Director's Report

From as far northwest in Florida as Bratt and as far southeast as Miami, Florida Free Will Baptists are some of the finest, most gracious people God ever put on this earth. Thank you for the privilege to serve our State Association and the districts, churches and people that make up our association. God has certainly been good to us!

"As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace;" (1 Peter 4:10) I recognize that this position is totally about serving, and it is a tremendous privilege to serve the Florida Free Will Baptist family. It has been my honor to represent our State in every district association throughout the year (at least once) in various local churches, in both of our Christian Workers' Conferences, the Palmer Leadership Institute, the Senior's Summit, Mission Shares Golf Tournament, on the Free Will Baptist Children's Home Board, at the Rejuvenate Conference for meeting planners, the Master's Men Deep South Golf Tournament, and the National Association meeting.

2010 proved to be a challenging year for our State Association. We faced real shortfalls in both our cooperative plan of support and our Mission Shares Plan. We need to determine how to move beyond where we are now to accomplish more for His kingdom. During the past year, many of our churches faced financial difficulties, while others grappled with the feasibility of continuing to be a viable ministry. Still others faced the challenge of continuing to support outside ministries in the economic downturn. Thankfully, several of our churches are doing very well and are seeing numerous people come to the Lord. Others are very thankful to be simply "holding their own" in the current economic climate. In the midst of these challenges, however, God has been good to us!

We are deeply grateful to the districts and churches that have faithfully supported our State Association. Because of your faithfulness we were able to sustain our ministries, conferences and retreats which were very successful in 2010:

- The Minister's Retreat for 2010 was a cruise from Port Canaveral to the Bahamas in January. There were 22 that participated. David Shores, Promotional Secretary from the Illinois State Association of Free Will Baptists spoke during our worship time.
- The Mission Shares Golf Tournament had lower participation than previous years, but the fellowship was great and we were able to raise approximately \$1000 for our Mission Shares Plan of Support. This was done through registration fees and hole sponsorships. David Buser and Kaulen Hatton took the trophy home for the second year in a row. Jonathon and Jeff Bowman finished in a tie after 36 holes but a "play off" hole decided the winner. Special thanks to the churches and groups that sponsored a hole for the tournament.
- The annual Christian Workers' Conference sponsored by our Christian Ministries Board, proved to be one of the best conferences to date. Dr David Gibbs III, from Christian Law Association served as the speaker. He addressed "The Legal State of our Nation," "Fighting for Dear Life," "I'm Going To Sue You," and "Estate Planning." Evaluations were very favorable as to the benefits of these conferences.
- Flexibility proved to be the key word for our Annual Senior's Summit
 in October. While the retreat provided relaxation, fun, fellowship,
 and worship opportunities for those in attendance, we were faced
 with several last minute changes in plans. Our scheduled speaker,
 Rev Bert Tippett, was hospitalized just prior to the meeting and Rev

William Smith did a great job filling in. The excursion for the retreat was to be the Holy Land Experience but at the last minute a "free day" was scheduled for the park and the place was packed. We opted to go to the Wycliffe Bible Translators "Discovery Center" instead. Even with all the last minute changes, the retreat proved to be successful.

The first phase of our Palmer Leadership Institute scheduled for
October was postponed due to the health of our speaker, Dr Doug
Earls, and conflicts in scheduling with other pastors. We were able
to have the first installment in January of this year. Fifteen pastors
joined us in the first of three sessions. All in attendance expressed
great appreciation for the conference.

On top of all these events I was fortunate enough to gain recertification as a Certified Meeting Professional. Thank you for your support and encouragement in this challenging accomplishment.

Details about retreats and conferences for 2011 are not finalized at this point. We do have dates set for each of the conferences. The Christian Workers Conference will be held on September 16-17 in Orlando and November 4-5 in Destin. Our Seniors' Summit will be meeting October 3-5 and the second session of the Palmer Leadership Institute will be held on October 14-15 at the Courtyard by Marriott on Old St Augustine Road in Jacksonville. The annual Mission Shares Golf Tournament will be held at the Plantation Inn in Crystal River on August 19-20.

I would like to commend those who work diligently to make our State Association's ministries what they are. *The Coordinator* continues to keep our people informed and updated with news from across the state. Chrissy Kinney and Ron Hunter continue to do a great job with the editing and lay-

out of our publication. They have done a tremendous job in making the transition to the new smaller, condensed version of our newsletter.

Many thanks go to Mike Taggart for his work on our website. The website has served as an excellent means of providing the updates, pictures and forms relative to our various events. You are encouraged to visit FLAFWB.com for information concerning events and activities for Florida Free Will Baptists.

I also need to thank the folks at Ryanwood Fellowship Free Will Baptist Church for their selfless support and encouragement of my work with the Florida State Association. They graciously support both me and the ministries of the State. It has been a privilege to minister with the officers, boards and committees of our State Association. Each of these individuals serves with a heart for the Kingdom and a desire to further the overall work of Florida Free Will Baptists. Thank you for allowing me to be a small part in what God is doing in and through the State of Florida.

Constitution and By-laws of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

Article I - Name of Assembly

Section 1: This assembly shall be known as "The Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Article II - Association

Section 1: This Association shall be affiliated with the National Association of Free Will Baptists, Inc.

Section 2: The Executive Director shall serve as the official representative on the General Board of the National Association of Free Will Baptists, Inc. If, for any reason, the Executive Director is unable to fulfill this responsibility, the order of appointment to this position from among the current General Officers shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk. In the event a representative is still needed, one may be elected from the body.

Article III - Representation

Section 1: This Association shall be composed of delegates elected from the local associations belonging to this body and delegates elected from the local churches embraced by the various associations.

Section 2: All deacons and ministers who are members of, and in good standing with, a local church and local association which are members of this body are standing delegates.

Section 3: The general officers of this body shall be standing delegates.

Section 4: The delegates shall be elected as follows: one (1) delegate for each local church composed of 100 members or fraction thereof, and one (1) delegate for each additional 100 members for fraction thereof; (5) delegates from each local association composed of fifteen (15) churches or fraction thereof, and one (1) additional delegate for each additional four (4) churches or fraction thereof. These additional delegates cannot be used unless the churches are active and are represented in the session in which they are appointed.

Article IV - Officers, Boards and Committees

Section 1: Officers: the officers of this association shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, and Clerk to be elected by this Body while in regular session.

Section 2: The standing boards of this Association shall be the Florida Mission Board and the Christian Ministries Board.

Section 3: When the State Association deems it wise, committees or commissions may be established to perform a specific service in restricted area on more or less permanent basis. The number of members and their terms of office of any committee or commission shall be decided by vote of the State Association and the members shall be elected by the Association.

Section 4: The Executive Committee shall be composed of the Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, the Chairman of each Standing Board, and one elected member from each affiliated District Association. District Associations shall recommend their representatives on the Executive Board annually. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum.

Section 5: When vacancies occur either by death, removal from office or by resignation, the general officers shall appoint a temporary replacement until the next regular session of this body, at which time the body shall elect a permanent replacement. A proxy may be appointed by the body to fill any absentee's place who does not attend the session.

Section 6: General officers of the Association shall serve for the term of two (2) years.

Section 7: Each standing board shall be composed of five members which shall be elected for five (5) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually.

The auditing committee shall be composed of three members which shall be elected for three (3) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee.

The budget committee will be appointed by the Moderator a year in advance. The committee will consist of three members from the Executive Committee and the State Treasurer will serve as an ex-officio member.

Section 8: This body shall have the right to discipline any officer or board member who does not conduct his office in a Christian and business-like manner according to the rules of Christian conduct laid down in the New Testament.

Section 9: The Executive Committee is to hire an Executive Director and to oversee his office. The Executive Director is to be a non-voting member of all boards and committees.

Article V - Meetings

Section 1: Regular: This association shall convene annually in a joint meeting with the Florida Women Active for Christ and the Youth Conference on a Wednesday evening, Thursday, Friday and Saturday as close to the first Sunday in May as possible.

Section 2: Special: The Executive Committee may be called into session by the Moderator, or by a majority of its members.

Section 3: Quorum: Fifty (50) percent of the delegates shall constitute a quorum.

Article VI - Finances

Section 1: All churches and associations in this body shall pay a representation fee annually. The amount of this for an association is \$200.00 per member church. The fee for local churches is \$10.00 per delegate.

Section 2: All Cooperative Plan funds coming into this body shall be spent under a budget plan. This budget must be approved by the body while in session, and no fund may be used in any way except as budgeted.

Section 3: Mileage for the Executive Committee members and standing Board members shall be paid at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. Expenses are to be paid from each Board member's account. If a called meeting requires a member to stay overnight, his room and board will be paid from the General Fund or his Board's account. Mileage and expenses shall be paid for the Moderator to attend the denomination's annual Leadership Conference.

By-Laws

Section 1: It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside over all deliberations of this body while in session. All meetings shall be governed by Roberts Rules of Order.

Section 2: The Assistant Moderator shall assume the duties, rights and privileges of the Moderator or Clerk in the absence of either.

Section 3: It shall be the duty of the Clerk to make and keep records of all the business proceedings and activities of this body.

Section 4: (1) It shall be the duty of the State Executive Office to receive all funds, pay all appropriate bills, disburse cooperative and designated funds in a timely manner according to the State Association's budget; (2) It shall be the duty of each State Board Treasurer to receive all funds for the board he serves, pay all appropriate bills, and disburse appropriate funds in a timely manner. (3) The State Executive Office and all State Board Treasurers shall use the same accounting system. (4) Each treasurer of the State Association shall submit his/her records to the State Association's Audit Committee annually for audit.

Section 5: It shall be the duty of the auditing committee to conduct a financial audit of each treasurer's books annually. The audit shall take place after the fiscal year and before the State Association convenes. The date for the audit will be agreed upon by the audit committee and the various treasurers who shall be present at the time their books are audited.

<u>Section 6:</u> It shall be the duty of the Budget Committee to make recommendations to the State Association concerning the total State Association Budget and the allocations of State Cooperative receipts.

Section 7: Each officer, board member and standing committee or commission member must be in good standing with a Free Will Baptist Church which is a member of this body. He must be in good standing with his local association and must live within the boundaries of this Association. No person shall serve on more than one board at the same time.

Section 8: The Executive Committee shall have full authority to do all acts for and in the name of the Association when the Association is not in session and shall make a general report of all their actions to the body annually.

Section 9: Amendments to this Constitution and By-Laws must be put before the body while in session one day before voted on, and must be read at least twice and passed by two-thirds of the delegates present.

Constitution and By-Laws of the Florida State Free Will Baptist Mission Board

Article I - Name

This Board shall be known as the Florida Free Will Baptist Mission Board, Inc.

Article II - Purpose

The purpose of this Board shall be that of promoting mission work among Free Will Baptist in the State of Florida, beginning new mission works in the state of Florida, and overseeing the missionary and the mission work until the mission is able to assume full self-supporting status.

Article III - Membership

This Board shall be composed of members elected by the State Association and shall serve terms established on a rotational basis. One member's term shall expire annually. The number of members of this board shall be determined by the Constitution and By-Laws of the State Association.

<u>Article IV – Officers and Committees</u>

Officers of this board shall be Chairman and Secretary/Treasurer. These officers shall hold office for one (1) year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms. The board members have the option of hiring a treasurer who is not a board member. Members of the board shall elect the officers and/or hire the treasurer of the board. Committees may be appointed by the chairman elected by the board as the need arises.

Article V - Meetings

Meetings shall be held as the need arises. Necessary meetings may be called by the chairman or any three members.

Article VI - Finances

This Board shall receive its finances from churches and individuals making special contributions, cooperative program allocations, interest on loans, and special offering received through promoting missions. Mileage for board member expenses shall be paid from the general fund at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. All other Board travel expenses shall be reimbursed at members cost.

By-Laws

<u>Section 1:</u> Officers of the board shall hold office according to the terms set forth in the Constitution and shall carry out those duties peculiar to the respective offices. The Secretary shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's activities. The Treasurer shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's financial transactions. All records and property mortgages and titles shall be surrendered to the succeeding Secretary.

Section 2: A majority membership shall constitute a quorum and be duly authorized to transact business. All items of business must receive a majority vote of a quorum before it is considered final. All members not present in meetings shall be notified of decisions made by the board.

<u>Section 3:</u> All members shall endeavor to support mission work through cooperative efforts of the Board. Any member that fails to cooperate with the board for a period of one year may, upon recommendation of the Board, be replaced by the State Association.

Section 4: A complete report of the Board Meetings and activities and a complete financial report must be presented to the annual State Association Meeting.

Section 5: Missions and Churches receiving financial support must be in good standing with an association or quarterly meeting affiliated with the state or national association and must have a pastor in good standing with the Free Will Baptist denomination.

Section 6: The board shall have the right, by majority vote, to purchase property where there is good possibility for organizing a Free Will Baptist Church. Full title must be acquired, and no investment shall exceed the appraised value of the real property. Missionaries and mission works receiving funding from the Mission Board will be under the direct supervision of the Mission Board. Missionaries serve mission works at the discretion of the Board. Missions and churches with Pastors employed by the board shall be under the authority of this Board for any non routine purchases or financial obligations.

<u>Section 7:</u> The Mission Board will be responsible for administering the Mission Shares Program under the guidelines set by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Section 8: Any work receiving financial support must agree to support the denominational cooperative program.

Section 9: The Board shall have the right by majority vote to sell any personal or real property it deems is not necessary for continued religious use.

Section 10: Nominal grants by the Board to worthwhile churches or missions may be made when it is in the interest of the denominational cause in which benefits are certain. Grants of this nature shall be subject to money being immediately available and shall not exceed \$1,000.00 without joint approval of the Mission Board and the State Executive Committee or Association.

Section 11: The Constitution and By-Laws may be amended by a majority vote of the Board members with the approval of the State Body.

Constitution of the Christian Ministries Board of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

Article I - Name

This board shall be known as the Christian Ministries Board of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Article II - Duties

Section 1: The board shall (1) Promote the educational aims of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists; (2) Coordinate and direct youth training and competitive activities; (3) Encourage and equip Christian leaders and workers for effective ministry through the local church.

<u>Section2</u>: The board shall give a report of its activities, financial statement, and property inventory, and present a budget request to the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists at its annual meeting.

Article III - Membership

Section 1: The board shall be composed of five members who shall be elected for a term of five years, arranged whereby only one member's term expires annually. Unexpired terms will be filled by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Section 2: Officers of this board shall be (1) Chairman, (2) Secretary, (3) Treasurer. Officers shall be elected by the board for one year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms.

Article IV - Meetings

Section 1: Meetings shall be held annually with additional meetings called by the chairman, or by any three members, as necessary.

<u>Article V – Finances</u>

<u>Section 1:</u> This board shall receive its finances from (1) Cooperative program allocation, (2) Fund raising projects, (3) Registration fees, and (4) Designated giving.

Section 2: Appropriate expenses incurred on official board business shall be paid or reimbursed from general fund of the Christian Ministries Board. Mileage shall be paid at the current IRS rate.

<u>Article VI – Amendments</u>

This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.
