Functions of Committees

Planning Committee: The Planning Committee consists of the Moderator, Executive Director/Treasurer, and Chairman of each Board and reports to the Executive Committee. The responsibilities of the Planning Committee are to make intermediate and long range plans for State Ministries; coordinate the efforts of the Mission Board and Christian Ministries Board; to plan the State Association theme and speakers; and to handle any items of review by the Executive Committee or the State Body.

Steering Committee: The Steering Committee consists of the Moderator, Clerk, Executive Director/Treasurer, the Chairman of the Christian Ministries Board and the President of the Florida Women Active for Christ. Others may be appointed by the Moderator on a special needs basis. It exists for the purpose of coordinating our annual State Meeting. The responsibilities of this committee shall be: to negotiate with the various locations concerning rates and arrangements and to recommend locations to the State Body; to work with the various Convention Bureaus to secure sites; to make site inspections when necessary; to set and approve the catering contracts for meeting rooms and meal functions with the host hotel; to coordinate the meeting times and room specifications for each session; to set the schedule for the State Meeting; to coordinate the registration process for the State Meeting; and to be the on-site liaison for hotel staff.

Budget Committee: The Budget Committee consists of three members of the Executive Committee appointed by the Moderator one year in advance. The Executive Director/Treasurer serves as an exofficio member. The responsibility of this committee is to analyze and compile the State's General Fund Budget. Budget requests will be submitted in writing. A representative will be available from Florida standing boards and commissions to provide information to the committee. The Executive Director will present his operating expenses and the Coordinator expense. Direction from the State Moderator concerning administrative items will be provided. The Budget Committee has the authority to request additional information in compiling the budget. This budget will be presented to the Executive

Committee for approval and recommendation to the State Body for final approval.

<u>Auditing Committee:</u> The Auditing Committee is composed of three members who shall be elected for three year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee. They are to review financial documents to determine that the Treasurer's report of each board and State Association clearly reflects the financial activity for the year.

Promotional Team Concept:

The Executive Director: The Executive Director is the chief administrative officer of our State. He is tasked with being the point man, representing the state ministries, not necessarily the office, to our associations and churches. He is the primary contact with our National Association, the editor-in-chief of *The Coordinator*, and the State Treasurer. This is a part-time position requiring two dates a month to be traveling. (Complete details of this position are laid out in its job description.)

The Editor of the Coordinator: The editor is tasked with delegating articles to be written and compiling the content of the state newsletter in whatever time period and manner published.

State Executive Director's Report April 2014

"I know of no State Association that does more for its churches than does the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists." Those were the words of an individual who served within an agency of our National Association of Free Will Baptists. This statement should be a great encouragement to everyone in our State because it confirms that we are accomplishing one of the aims of the Executive Office, our State Association officers and boards. It is truly our desire to provide ministries and opportunities that will benefit the churches within our State Association.

Our State Association's programs, seminars and retreats during 2013 provided education, renewal and challenge for those within our churches and our pastors. Here is a brief wrap up of last year's events:

- The Minister's Retreat for 2013 was held at the Hampton Inn in Fernandina Beach on January 21-23. Twenty-three ministers and minister's wives joined to together for a time of relaxation and renewal. Mark McPeak, Director of Advancement for International Missions, challenged us about "Ministering in Today's Culture."
- ➤ Our annual Mission Shares Golf Tournament provided fellowship, enjoyment, the opportunity to enjoy some golf and to raise funds for our Mission Shares Plan of Support. Twenty-five golfers (and two beverage servers) converged on The Plantation in Crystal River for the tournament which raised over \$2100 for Mission

In addition to these events, 2013 saw our State Association serve as the host for our National Convention, which was held in Tampa. Reflecting on the convention motivates us to recognize the contribution of so many from our State who had a hand in making the convention a success. From the National Steering Committee, to FWAC leaders, volunteers who built and manned the booth, along with volunteer ushers and countless others, Florida Free Will Baptists stepped up and did a great job in welcoming our National Association to Florida. (A breakdown on expenses beyond the \$30,000 Host State Fee is attached to this report.)

It has been my privilege to represent the Florida State Association in each of the district associations of our state at least once during the year, and in a number of individual churches. Beyond the associations and churches, I was able to represent our State association in both Christian Workers Conferences, the Seniors' Summit, the Mission Shares Golf tournament, on the Board of the Free Will Baptist Home for Children in Eldridge, AL, the Master's Men Deep South Golf Tournament, a meeting of State Promotional Men, the Leadership Conference, and the National Association convention. In addition, I participated in the Rejuvenate Conference and the Religious Conference Management convention for meeting planners.

The Coordinator continues to serve as a source of information and encouragement to our people. We appreciate the fine job that Chrissy Kinney does editing the paper and that Ron Hunter does in the lay-out for each issue. They both do a great job in making the publication the quality publication it is.

A special thank you to Mike Taggart for his work with our website (FLAFWB). Mike does a great job keeping the site current and providing all the information and forms needed for our events. We also appreciate his volunteer service as our sound tech for our meetings.

A note of thanks is also in order to the churches which so faithfully supported our State's Together or Co-operative Plan. Thanks to your consistent giving we were able to exceed our budget by a little over \$5000. Thank you to the churches that supported our Florida Mission Shares Plan of Support, as well. Our Florida State missionaries and all of our International missionaries benefit greatly from this program. While we received only about 70% of our budget, we did increase our giving to Shares by nearly \$7500. Thank you so much for your faithful and consistent giving.

Now, in the midst of my second decade in this position (completing my eleventh year), I still dream of what our State Association could do for our churches, denomination and God's kingdom. I still dream of our State Association having its own convention/retreat center; of one day having a retirement village for our pastors and people; of having pastors available to go and serve as 'interim' for churches who are faced with such a need, and of having adequate resources to support our state ministries and increase our contributions to our National ministries, as well. These dreams are not unrealistic but can only be realized through great cooperation of our churches and by educating our people about including our State Association and other ministries in their planned giving and estate planning. There will be a huge amount of resources passed on or lost over the next decade. Wouldn't it be great to see some of those resources left for Free Will Baptist ministries in Florida?

Thank you so much for the privilege of serving as your Executive Director. I appreciate the support and encouragement from so many within our state. It is an honor to serve with the boards, committees and officers of this body. They are individuals who are truly concerned about the Lord's work and are committed to see our association move forward. And as I mention every year, I thank my church people at Ryanwood Fellowship Free Will Baptist Church for allowing me to serve in this position in addition to serving as their pastor. They are not only gracious to allow me to serve in this capacity but also generous with their time and energy in helping with many ministry related matters behind the scenes.

Notice, that we have exciting news regarding college scholarships. We are now supporting 12 students in FWB Colleges. This is an increase of 1 student from the 2013 school year. Six students in Welch College, 6 students in Southeastern FWB College and we are expecting a couple of new students to enroll this fall.

The DRT trailer is going to need maintenance this year. We held off on this maintenance last year insuring that budget requirements would be met. However, the maintenance issues will be addressed this year before the State meeting.

Constitution and By-laws of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

Article I - Name of Assembly

Section 1: This assembly shall be known as "The Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Article II - Association

Section 1: This Association shall be affiliated with the National Association of Free Will Baptists, Inc.

Section 2: The Executive Director shall serve as the official representative on the General Board of the National Association of Free Will Baptists, Inc. If, for any reason, the Executive Director is unable to fulfill this responsibility, the order of appointment to this position from among the current General Officers shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk. In the event a representative is still needed, one may be elected from the body.

Article III - Representation

<u>Section 1:</u> This Association shall be composed of delegates elected from the local associations belonging to this body and delegates elected from the local churches embraced by the various associations.

Section 2: All deacons and ministers who are members of, and in good standing with, a local church and local association which are members of this body are standing delegates.

Section 3: The general officers of this body shall be standing delegates.

Section 4: The delegates shall be elected as follows: one (1) delegate for each local church composed of 100 members or fraction

thereof, and one (1) delegate for each additional 100 members or fraction thereof; (5) delegates from each local association composed of fifteen (15) churches or fraction thereof, and one (1) additional delegate for each additional four (4) churches or fraction thereof. These additional delegates cannot be used unless the churches are active and are represented in the session in which they are appointed.

Article IV - Officers, Boards and Committees

Section 1: Officers: the officers of this association shall be Moderator, Assistant Moderator, and Clerk to be elected by this Body while in regular session.

Section 2: The standing boards of this Association shall be the Florida Mission Board and the Christian Ministries Board.

<u>Section 3:</u> When the State Association deems it wise, committees or commissions may be established to perform a specific service in restricted area on more or less permanent basis. The number of members and their terms of office of any committee or commission shall be decided by vote of the State Association and the members shall be elected by the Association.

Section 4: The Executive Committee shall be composed of the Moderator, Assistant Moderator, Clerk, the Chairman of each Standing Board, and one elected member from each affiliated District Association. District Associations shall recommend their representatives on the Executive Board annually. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum.

Section 5: When vacancies occur either by death, removal from office or by resignation, the general officers shall appoint a temporary replacement until the next regular session of this body, at which time the body shall elect a permanent replacement. A proxy may be appointed by the body to fill any absentee's place who does not attend the session.

Section 6: General officers of the Association shall serve for the term of two (2) years.

Section 7: Each standing board shall be composed of five members which shall be elected for five (5) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually.

The auditing committee shall be composed of three members which shall be elected for three (3) year terms on a rotating basis, so that one new member shall be elected annually. Members of the auditing committee may not be members of any standing board or committee.

The budget committee will be appointed by the Moderator a year in advance. The committee will consist of three members from the Executive Committee and the State Treasurer will serve as an exofficio member.

Section 8: This body shall have the right to discipline any officer or board member who does not conduct his office in a Christian and business-like manner according to the rules of Christian conduct laid down in the New Testament.

Section 9: The Executive Committee is to hire an Executive Director and to oversee his office. The Executive Director is to be a non-voting member of all boards and committees.

<u>Article V - Meetings</u>

Section 1: Regular: This association shall convene annually in a joint meeting with the Florida Women Active for Christ and the Youth Conference on a Wednesday evening, Thursday, Friday and Saturday as close to the first Sunday in May as possible.

Section 2: Special: The Executive Committee may be called into session by the Moderator, or by a majority of its members.

Section 3: Quorum: Fifty (50) percent of the delegates shall constitute a quorum.

Article VI - Finances

Section 1: All churches and associations in this body shall pay a representation fee annually. The amount of this for an association is

\$300.00 per member church. The fee for local churches is \$10.00 per delegate.

Section 2: All Cooperative Plan funds coming into this body shall be spent under a budget plan. This budget must be approved by the body while in session, and no fund may be used in any way except as budgeted.

Section 3: Mileage for the Executive Committee members and standing Board members shall be paid at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. Expenses are to be paid from each Board member's account. If a called meeting requires a member to stay overnight, his room and board will be paid from the General Fund or his Board's account. Mileage and expenses shall be paid for the Moderator to attend the denomination's annual Leadership Conference.

By-Laws

Section 1: It shall be the duty of the Moderator to preside over all deliberations of this body while in session. All meetings shall be governed by Roberts Rules of Order.

Section 2: The Assistant Moderator shall assume the duties, rights and privileges of the Moderator or Clerk in the absence of either.

Section 3: It shall be the duty of the Clerk to make and keep records of all the business proceedings and activities of this body.

Section 4: (1) It shall be the duty of the State Executive Office to receive all funds, pay all appropriate bills, disburse cooperative and designated funds in a timely manner according to the State Association's budget; (2) It shall be the duty of each State Board Treasurer to receive all funds for the board he serves, pay all appropriate bills, and disburse appropriate funds in a timely manner.

(3) The State Executive Office and all State Board Treasurers shall use the same accounting system. (4) Each treasurer of the State Association shall submit his/her records to the State Association's Audit Committee annually for audit.

Section 5: It shall be the duty of the auditing committee to conduct a financial audit of each treasurer's books annually. The audit shall take place after the fiscal year and before the State Association convenes. The date for the audit will be agreed upon by the audit

with the state or national association and must have a pastor in good standing with the Free Will Baptist denomination.

Section 6: The board shall have the right, by majority vote, to purchase property where there is good possibility for organizing a Free Will Baptist Church. Full title must be acquired, and no investment shall exceed the appraised value of the real property. Missionaries and mission works receiving funding from the Mission Board will be under the direct supervision of the Mission Board. Missionaries serve mission works at the discretion of the Board. Missions and churches with Pastors employed by the board shall be under the authority of this Board for any non routine purchases or financial obligations.

Section 7: The Mission Board will be responsible for administering the Mission Shares Program under the guidelines set by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Section 8: Any work receiving financial support must agree to support the denominational cooperative program.

Section 9: The Board shall have the right by majority vote to sell any personal or real property it deems is not necessary for continued religious use.

Section 10: Nominal grants by the Board to worthwhile churches or missions may be made when it is in the interest of the denominational cause in which benefits are certain. Grants of this nature shall be subject to money being immediately available and shall not exceed \$1,000.00 without joint approval of the Mission Board and the State Executive Committee or Association.

Section11: The Constitution and By-Laws may be amended by a majority vote of the Board members with the approval of the State Body.

Constitution and By-Laws of the Florida State Free Will Baptist Mission Board

Article I - Name

This Board shall be known as the Florida Free Will Baptist Mission Board, Inc.

Article II - Purpose

The purpose of this Board shall be that of promoting mission work among Free Will Baptist in the State of Florida, beginning new mission works in the state of Florida, and overseeing the missionary and the mission work until the mission is able to assume full self-supporting status.

<u>Article III - Membership</u>

This Board shall be composed of members elected by the State Association and shall serve terms established on a rotational basis. One member's term shall expire annually. The number of members of this board shall be determined by the Constitution and By-Laws of the State Association.

<u>Article IV – Officers and Committees</u>

Officers of this board shall be Chairman and Secretary/Treasurer. These officers shall hold office for one (1) year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms. The board members have the option of hiring a treasurer who is not a board member. Members of the board shall elect the officers and/or hire the treasurer of the board. Committees may be appointed by the chairman elected by the board as the need arises.

Article V - Meetings

Meetings shall be held as the need arises. Necessary meetings may be called by the chairman or any three members.

Article VI – Finances

This Board shall receive its finances from churches and individuals making special contributions, cooperative program allocations, interest on loans, and special offering received through promoting missions. Mileage for board member expenses shall be paid from the general fund at the IRS rate for that fiscal year. All other Board travel expenses shall be reimbursed at members cost.

By-Laws

<u>Section 1:</u> Officers of the board shall hold office according to the terms set forth in the Constitution and shall carry out those duties peculiar to the respective offices. The Secretary shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's activities. The Treasurer shall maintain a permanent record of the Board's financial transactions. All records and property mortgages and titles shall be surrendered to the succeeding Secretary.

Section 2: A majority membership shall constitute a quorum and be duly authorized to transact business. All items of business must receive a majority vote of a quorum before it is considered final. All members not present in meetings shall be notified of decisions made by the board.

Section 3: All members shall endeavor to support mission work through cooperative efforts of the Board. Any member that fails to cooperate with the board for a period of one year may, upon recommendation of the Board, be replaced by the State Association.

Section 4: A complete report of the Board Meetings and activities and a complete financial report must be presented to the annual State Association Meeting.

Section 5: Missions and Churches receiving financial support must be in good standing with an association or quarterly meeting affiliated

committee and the various treasurers who shall be present at the time their books are audited.

Section 6: It shall be the duty of the Budget Committee to make recommendations to the State Association concerning the total State Association Budget and the allocations of State Cooperative receipts.

Section 7: Each officer, board member and standing committee or commission member must be in good standing with a Free Will Baptist Church which is a member of this body. He must be in good standing with his local association and must live within the boundaries of this Association. No person shall serve on more than one board at the same time.

Section 8: The Executive Committee shall have full authority to do all acts for and in the name of the Association when the Association is not in session and shall make a general report of all their actions to the body annually.

Section 9: Amendments to this Constitution and By-Laws must be put before the body while in session one day before voted on, and must be read at least twice and passed by two-thirds of the delegates present.

Constitution of the Christian Ministries Board of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists

Article I - Name

This board shall be known as the Christian Ministries Board of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Article II - Duties

Section 1: The board shall (1) Promote the educational aims of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists; (2) Coordinate and direct youth training and competitive activities; (3) Encourage and equip Christian leaders and workers for effective ministry through the local church.

<u>Section2</u>: The board shall give a report of its activities, financial statement, and property inventory, and present a budget request to the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists at its annual meeting.

Article III - Membership

Section 1: The board shall be composed of five members who shall be elected for a term of five years, arranged whereby only one member's term expires annually. Unexpired terms will be filled by the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

Section 2: Officers of this board shall be (1) Chairman, (2) Secretary, (3) Treasurer. Officers shall be elected by the board for one year and may be elected to serve succeeding terms.

Article IV - Meetings

Section 1: Meetings shall be held annually with additional meetings called by the chairman, or by any three members, as necessary.

Article V - Finances

Section 1: This board shall receive its finances from (1) Cooperative program allocation, (2) Fund raising projects, (3) Registration fees, and (4) Designated giving.

Section 2: Appropriate expenses incurred on official board business shall be paid or reimbursed from general fund of the Christian Ministries Board. Mileage shall be paid at the current IRS rate.

Article VI - Amendments

This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists.

<u>Definition:</u> The Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists is a fellowship of Christian believers, united to extend the witness of Christ and the building of His Church in the State of Florida and throughout the world.

<u>Purpose:</u> The purpose of the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists is to promote fellowship among Florida Free Will Baptists and to provide opportunity for our churches to accomplish cooperatively what they cannot do individually.

Mission: God is calling the Florida State Association of Free Will Baptists to obey His Great Commandment (Luke 10:27) and fulfill His Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20) through:

- The Exaltation of Jesus Christ (1 John 4:24; 1 Corinthians 10:31),
- The Evangelization of the Lord (Acts 2:42-47; 16:5),
- The Equipping of the Saints (Ephesians 4:11-13; 2 Timothy 2:2), and
- The Edification of the Body of Christ (Ephesians 4:15-16; Hebrews 10:24-25).
