The 45th Annual Session of the Florida Women Active for Christ met May 24 - 26, 1995, at the Ocala Hilton in Ocala, Florida. The theme of the meeting was "Great and Mighty Things Thru Prayer," based on Jeremiah 33:3.

She shared three recently published books that would be good for our auxiliaries to obtain and read. She then spoke on the theme of prayer and how through prayer and Bible study we can accomplish great things. She shared a missionary story about how God answers prayer; she gave encouragement to have a positive outlook on things in our lives, to pray often during the day , and to be a blessing to others.

President Diana Bryant called the business session to order, this being the first meeting under the new name of "Florida Women Active for Christ."
