# 1984 MINUTES OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE OF ORIGINAL FREE WILL BAPTISTS

The Resolutions Committee recommended that we give a rising vote of thanks to Tee's Chapel for hosting the General Conference. This was approved and carried out by the body.

This report was adopted.

Old Business: There was discussion on ways to improve contact with those out of state churches. There was no action taken on this matter.

New Business: All ministers present were recognized and representatives

from the enterprises.

The congregation joined in singing, "I Am Thine, O Lord," followed by the morning offering.

Carolina Bible Institute invited the General Conference to meet in its facilities for the 1985 session. This was accepted by motion.

Special music was presented by Rev. Jack Lassiter and Rev. Joe Griffith. Also singing by The Rev. Bruce Jones and wife Judy.

Dr. Floyd Cherry presented the Norning Message titled, "Regaining

the Power." His text was from Ephesians 5:15-18.

The service ended with the congregation singing, "Blest Be the Tie," led by President Hargrove.

The poor attendance at the recent meetings of the General Conference was the subject for discussion. A motion was made by Ransome McAbee to recommend to the body that we move the date for the meeting of the General Conference to Monday after the fourth (4) Sunday in June. Motion was seconed by Harry Jones. There was discussion about changing the format of the conference program. This was tabled until a later meeting. Harry A. Jones dismissed the Board with prayer.
