THE THIRD ANNUAL SESSION OF THE GEORGIA UNION ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS.

Convened with Double Branch church in Dooly county, Ga., commencing Saturday morning, Nov., 20, 1897. The former Moderator and also the Clerk being absent, the body was called to order by Bro. H. V. J. Ethridge, by singing and prayer.

Appointed the place for the next Association to be held with Free Will Union church to commence Friday before the 4th Sunday in October 1898, Rev. E. Matthews to preach the introductory sermon, Rev. W. Wright, alternate. After taking the parting benediction, adjourned.
