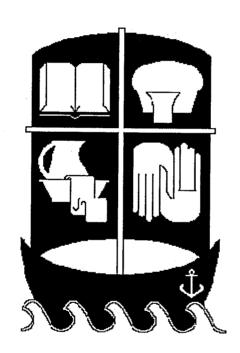

### REPORT NO. 3

### REPORT of the PROMOTIONAL SECRETARY

As I reviewed the reports from our state boards, committees and treasurers for 2011, I was pleased with the things accomplished during the past year even as our churches faced a severe economic downturn. It was exciting to see that not only have the incoming donations held steady over the last year but the spirit of cooperation among our boards as we try to determine the best way to use the Lord's money has been great. Since each state ministry is funded by the Together Way Plan, there has always been a good attitude of giving and sharing percentages allocated through this program. Delegates at our annual State Association make the final determination how the funding will be allocated to each board. While I'm on the subject of the Together Way Plan and state giving, I noticed that a few member churches of our state did not respond this past year with any gifts to our state program.

Illinois is blessed with wonderful facilities at Camp Hope, dedicated workers and volunteers spend hundreds of hours working with the children, and good men oversee its maintenance and operation. The Camp Board reported that our summer camps had almost 400 young people attending this year.

The Christian Education Board is planning another Marriage Retreat at the Rend Lake Resort located near Ina on April 13 and 14. This board is also seeking new ways to help with the finances of all our bible college students.

Our Illinois Board of Missions is underwriting Brother Tyler Penn and the "Illini Initiative" in the Champaign area. The CTS Board continues to host competitive activities for our young people with the State Competition set to meet at the Ina Church on April 27 and 28. On September 13-15, the Master's Men Board will sponsor a men's retreat at Camp Hope. The Disaster Relief Team was very busy in 2011. The Adult Camp continues to meet each year at Camp Hope on Sunday through Wednesday evenings. I commend all our boards for their good work.

Teens going on E-Team mission trips (I do not have a complete list at the time of this report) will soon be contacting your church for prayers and financial help.

Let me share some news about preachers and churches. We want to welcome Brother Walter Freeman, pastor of the Oak Grove Church and Brother Edward Krantz, pastor at the Freedom Church and Brother Scott Bee, pastor at the Decatur Church . At the time of this report, the Oak Valley Church , Salem Church and New Hope Church need a pastor. The Immanuel Church in Joliet and the Faith Church in Milan were closed in 2011. The Victory Church is moving to a new location and a new facility very soon. Pastor Jon Cannon and Pastor Ernie Lewis will be preaching at our National Convention in Memphis , Tennessee in July.

The Illinois Newsletter (state paper) and ONE Magazine (national periodical) are free publications available to all Free Will Baptist families. I mentioned in an earlier report that, "the USPS has come up with a new sorting system for mailings which requires a new style of folding, sealing and processing for the Illinois Newsletter. The new process has given us a decrease in the mailing rate but has almost tripled my time in getting the mailing ready. Hopefully, this will be better with time and practice". (It has not improved) If you are interested in receiving either or both of these publications, please submit your name and address and it will be added to our mailing lists. Also, if you know of individuals who no longer need these mailings, please send in that information as well.

I had the opportunity to attend many state board meetings, eight quarterly meetings, the National Leadership Conference and the National Association. I serve on a local Rescue Mission board, as an IMB Ambassador, and on the National Executive Board. To each church: Please support all special annual offerings, especially the WMO in April. Thank you again for the privilege to serve as Promotional Secretary.
