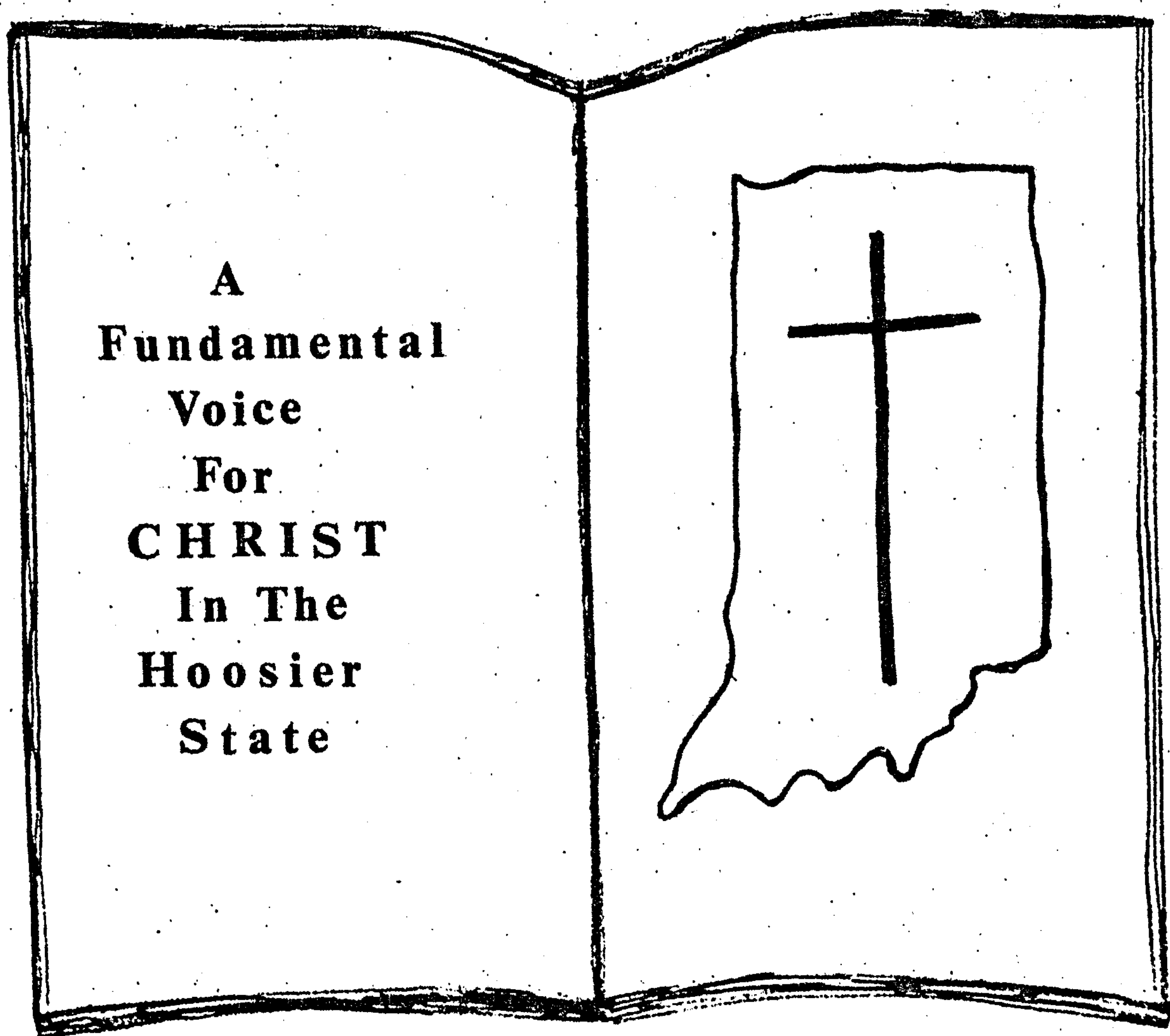

The 18th session of the Indiana State Association of Free Will Baptists met with the First Free Will Baptist Church of Ft Wayne, Indiana.

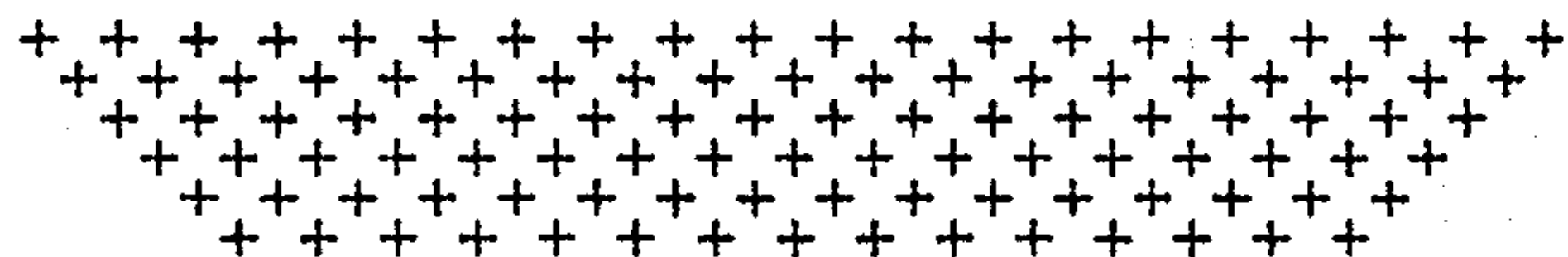
