KANSAS STATE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTIST

CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE: From long experience, we, the members of the Free Will Baptist denomination, being regularly baptised upon a profession of our faith in Jesus Christ, and realizing the necessity of a bond of union and fellowship among us as a church: and to preserve and maintain correspondence and co-ordination within us, do therefore ordain this Constitution for our better denominational government.

Article I. This Association shall be called the Kansas State Association of Free Will Baptists and shall be composed of such regularly organized and disciplined Free Will Baptist Yearly Meetings, conveniently located, as may embody themselves under this constitution.

Article 2. This Association shall consist of elected delegates from the several Yearly Meetings and Churches of which it is composed. Each Yearly Meeting is entitled to 5 delegates and every church is entitled to one delegate providing said Yearly Meeting and Churches are in good standing. Ordained ministers and ordained deacons who are serving on local church deacon board.

Article 3. The officers of this Association shall be a Moderator, Assistant Moderator, and a Clerk-Treasurer, who shall be chosen at each session of the Association, with assistants as may be found necessary. These officers with one ordained minister from each Yearly Meeting with rotating offices will serve as an Executive Board with one office to expire each year.

Article 4. Any well-organized and well-regulated Free Will Baptist Yearly Meeting, composed of such churches as conform to the practices, and

COMSTITUTION (Con't)

Article 4. (Con't) adopt the doctrines of the Free Will Baptist denomination, as published in the Treatise of the Mational Association may at any time, on application by vote of this body, become a member thereof.

- 1. Providing they adopt and adhere to State Questionnairs Mr. 1, 2, & 3 for Ministers and Deacons.
- 2. Failure to comply with this ruling concerning licensing and ordination of ministers and deacons will result in withdrawal of fellowship.

Article 5. This Association shall have power to discipline the Yearly Meetings of which it is composed, and to exclude them for disorderly walk if labor proves unsuccessful, but in no case to reverse their decisions, nor to interfere with any of their internal regulations.

Article 6. It shall be the duty of the Yearly Meetings of this Association to represent themselves by letter, delegates, and a fee of \$5.00 per church, and report their standing, and statistics; at which time the Association shall act upon such questions and topics as may be referred to it by its respective Yearly Meetings, and transact such other business not repugnant to this Constitution.

Article 7. This Association shall have power to adopt any regulations or by-laws, not inconsistent with this constitution, which may be deemed essential to the further regulation of its session.

Article 8. This Constitution may be amended or changed at any regular session of this Association by two-thirds vote present, provided the proposed amendment or change be laid on the table for at least 8 hours.

KANSAS STATE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS

BY-LAWS

- 1. All business meetings shall be opened by singing, reading a portion of God's Word and prayer, and shall be closed with prayer.
- 2. All business, except routine, shall be brought before the body by committee but should any committee refuse or fail to present to this body any business given it by any member of this Association, then such business may be presented to the body by any member.
- 3. No one shall speak more than five minutes or more than twice on the same subject without the consent of the Moderator.
- 4. Any member of this body can appeal from the decision of the Moderator to the Association, and by a two-thirds majority vote thereon, the objection shall be sustained or rejected.
- 5. No one shall leave the Association when in a business session without the consent of the Moderator.
- 6. Anyone desiring to speak shall arise and say "Brother Moderator," but shall speak no further until he or she is recognized by the Moderator.
- 7. The Moderator shall stop discussions when not carried on in a Christian spirit, or when it is likely to lead to discord or division.
- 8. The officers of this body shall submit, at every annual session, a written report of the work done for this Association.

BY-LAWS (Con't)

- 9. The Secretary-Treasurer shall keep an accurate record of all business transactions; be responsible for all funds received and disbursed; shall superintend the printing of the minutes.
- 10. This Association may correspond by messenger or otherwise with other religious bodies.
- 11. All resolutions and reports shall bear the names of all the members of the committee who favor them; and if the names be not a majority of such committee, then the clerk shall not read the resolutions or report. A minority report may be received however.
- 12. All committees shall be appointed by the Moderator who shall be assisted by a committee on committees. This committee on committees shall be appointed by the Moderator.
- 13. A majority of votes shall be final upon all subjects except to amend the Constitution and By-Laws, receive Quarterly Meetings or Associations, the changing of the members of the committees appointed by the Moderator & over ruling the Moderator, then it shall require a two-thirds majority.
 - 14. The sessions of this Association shall convene Thursday night, Friday, Friday night, Saturday until noon preceeding the third Sunday of June each year.
- 15. These By-Laws may be amended or changed at any regular session of this Association by two-thirds vote present.
 - 16. This Association shall adopt "Roberts Rules of Order."
