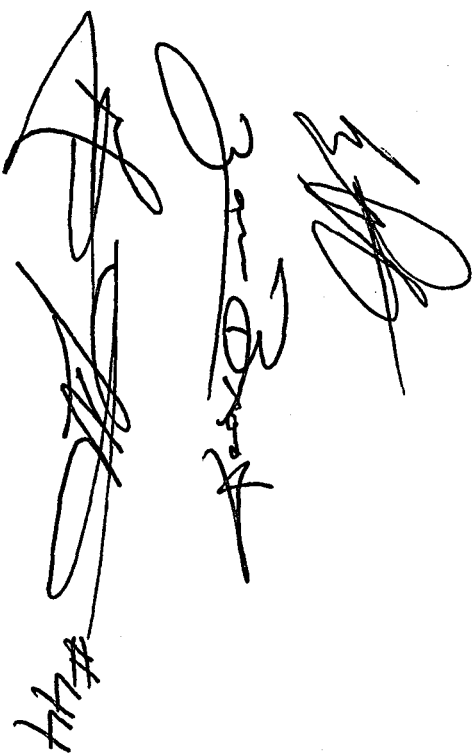

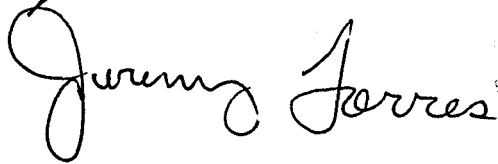

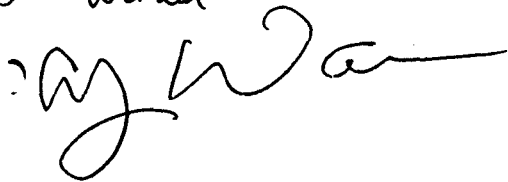

During this period the Kansas Christian Education Board started with a balance of \$13,768.41.

The Total Deposits was \$ 69,521.77 which came from Youth Camp, Men's Retreat, State Coop and donations.

Total disbursements during this period were \$64,762.00, which went to Youth Camp, Men's retreat and Teen participation in ETeam, Truth & Peace, and Youth Evangelism Team, and banking fees.

Note: in January, the board opened a new account at Valley State Bank. Most funds were transferred at that point. Final funds transferred April 25, 2024. Capital Federal Account to be closed at April's end. Additionally, the Board opened an account with Stripe to accept non-paper payments.

The ending balances were \$18528.18.

This past year has been a productive yet difficult year with progress in advancing the Kingdom of God through the Free Will Baptist Churches in Kansas.

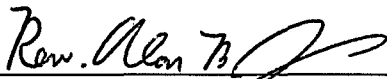
Over the year, the Executive Board met to discuss and carry out the following items:

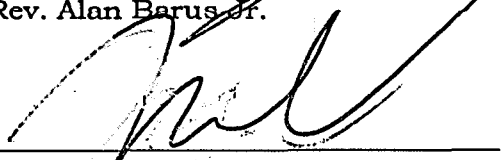
- Planning and carrying out the quarterly conference meetings

- Secured the location, selected a speaker, planned the order of events and carried out the annual state meeting

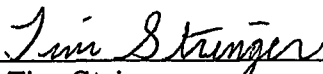
While it is certainly heartbreaking to see two churches leave our association, we are thankful to remain in fellowship with people at each church.

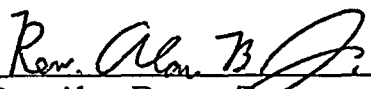

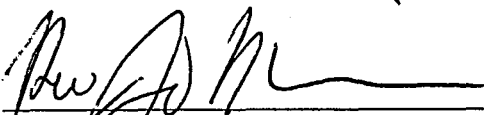
