Rules of Decorum read by moderator.

MODERATOR'S ELECTION:

Rev. Loyd Locklear was elected unanimously to continue as Moderator. Rev. C.E. Riggs was elected unanimously to continue as Ass't. Moderator.

Sister Shalia Clark was elected as Clerk and Sister Elsie E. Anderson was elected as Treasurer and Ass't. Clerk.

Rev. Henry McCann resigned from Presbytery Board. Resignation accepted. Rev. Carless Kitchen was elected to fill the two year term.

Free Will Baptist Chapel requested permission to withdraw from the Association. Permission granted.

Rev. James Hammons resigned from Home Mission Board. Resignation accepted.

Rev. Alpha Morrison elected by acclamation to five year term on Presbytery Board.

Vacancy on Executive Board. Rev. Billy Brown elected for five year term.

Vacancy on Home Mission Board. Brother Ray Hall elected for seven year term.

Vacancy on Home Mission Board. Brother Walt Hatfield elected for four year term.

Divine Service Committee was appointed by the Moderator: Brother Cannie Thacker, Brother Merle Marsee and Brother Eathel Clark.

Presbytery Board asked to retire. Rev. Jake Hamilton and Rev. James Hammons requested by Moderator to serve on Presbytery Board.

Congregation sang "OH, I Want to See Him" led by Brother Langlois with Jeannie Poston at the piano.

Sister Louise Owen talked to the congregation about what we can do to help the Missionaries by donating articles to the Provision Closet.

Congregation sang "He Loves Me".

Special singing by the Poston Sisters. "Show Me Thy Ways" and "I Wouldn't Take Nothing For My Journey Now".

Those to be examined by Presbytery Board recognized and retired to appear before the Board.

Congregational songs "Victory In Jesus" and "An Old Account Settled".
