TWENTY-FIRST ANNUAL ASSOCIATION INTRODUCTORY MESSAGE SERVICE

The Liberty Association of Free Will Baptist met in its annual session at the Ten Mile Free Will Baptist Church at 74 W. Ten Mile, Madison Heights, Michigan.

Services opened by congregation standing to sing "When We All Get To Heaven" led by Bro. Ralph Clouse with Sis. Grace Langlois at the piano.

Led in prayer by Rev. C. E. Riggs.

Opening remarks and welcome extended by host pastor Rev. W. H. Teague.

Rev. Loyd Locklear, moderator, read scripture. Ephesians: chapter 3, verses 14-21. He commented on the reading of God's word.

Led in prayer by Rev. Tom Ford.

Meeting called to order.

First item of business: Call for reading of letters from various churches, to which the following responded.

1. Trinity Free Will Baptist
2. United Faith Free Will Baptist
3. Fifteen Mile Free Will Baptist
4. Gospel Free Will Baptist

5. Ecorse Free Will Baptist
6. Free Will Baptist Chapel
7. East Side Free Will Baptist
8. Athens Chapel Free Will Baptist
9. Taylor Faith Free Will Baptist

Bro. Harvey Crane came forth to speak concerning the Free Will Baptist Bible College. He spoke of the need for new dormitory furnishings for thirteen rooms at \$500.00 per room. He asked each pastor to challenge their congregation to give toward this need.

Tardy letter from the Ten Mile Free Will Baptist read at this time.

Congregation sang "We'll Work Til Jesus Comes," as regular delegation and ordained authority came forward to receive the right hand of fellowship from the moderator and to remain for an altar of prayer. Rev. Locklear asked Bro. Dale Davis who is on leave from the Army to stand to represent our service men. Rev. Locklear spoke of the great need for prayer. Other requests were made known. Altar of prayer led by Rev. C. R. Kitchen.

Ushers came forward to receive an offering for the Free Will Baptist Home for Children in Greeneville, Tennessee.

Prayer on offering by Bro. Ray Langlois. Amount received \$62.31.

Rev. Locklear reminded the congregation of the Camp Meeting, to begin May 3-8, with different pastors to speak each night and he urged all churches to participate. He also announced that the Ecorse Church will have a ground breaking ceremony May 2, and work on their new church building will begin in the month of May.

Service turned over to Rev. C. E. Riggs to bring the Introductory Message. He quoted Ephesians, chapter two in its entirety. Also Ephesians, chapter one, verses 15-19. He delivered a wonderful and enlightening message which was enjoyed by all.

Rev. Locklear returned to floor. He asked that those who appreciate Dad Riggs raise their hands to so show it.

Moderator reminded the congregation to be present at 9 A.M. on Saturday.

Rev. W. Teague gave instructions for parking on Saturday.

SATURDAY MORNING SESSION, MAY 1, 1971

Opening song "I Feel Like Traveling On", led by Bro. Ray Langlois with Bro. Howard Lindsey at the piano.

Led in prayer by Rev. Max Davis.

Moderator read scripture, Psalms 119: verses 97-105.

Roll call of delegation read by clerk.

No tardy letters.

Rules of Decorum read by moderator.

Properly seated and ready to take care of any business.

Petitionary letter from the Troy Free Will Baptist Church read. Presbytery Board retired with the pastor of this church, Rev. Charles Cooper, they acting as credentials committee.

OFFICERS ELECTION

Nominations open for moderator. Rev. Loyd Locklear elected by acclamation.

Rev. Tom Ford elected as Assistant Moderator.

Sis. Ruby Wright elected as Clerk.

Sis. Betty Wilmoth elected as Treasurer and Assistant Clerk.

Sis. Dora McCage elected as Correspondence Secretary.

Rev. W. H. Teague elected as Foreign Missions Promotional Secretary.

Executive Board retired to discuss the election of Board members. The ruling is that they check on qualifications of those who might fill Board positions.

Introductory Message for the 1972 Annual Setting: Rev. C. E. Riggs. Alternate: Rev. Ralph Shetterly.

Missionary Message: Rev. C. R. Kitchen, Alternate: Rev. Hildred Beadles.

Divine Service Committee selected by the moderator: Bro. Moore, Bro. Senters, and Bro. Looney.

Presbytery Board recommends that we accept the Troy Free Will Baptist Church into full fellowship. Motion made, seconded and carried to this effect.

An Obituary Committee was appointed consisting of Sis. Hawkins, Sis. Spriggs and Sis. Smith. Each church that has lost any members by death in the coming year are to have their clerks notify one of these sisters. They will compile a report on the background of the deceased and turn it in at the next annual setting. They also will give as complete a report as possible before the close of this setting on those who have passed on in the past year.

The Executive Board recommends Rev. C. R. Kitchen to the five year

term on the Presbytery Board. He declined. Rev. Hildred Beadles elected to the five year term.

Presbytery Board retired with candidates they are to examine.

Executive Board retired to confer with moderator.

Congregational song "I'm Redeemed".

Moderator returned to floor.

Executive Board vacancy: Rev. Carson Slagle elected to the three year term. Rev. Ray Adkins elected to the five year term.

Home Mission Board retired.

Divine Service Committee reports that they have selected Rev. Oscar Cummings, Jr. to bring the 11:00 o'clock message.

Congregational song "Where The Soul Never Dies".

Led in prayer by Bro. Granville Senters.

Rev. Max Davis came forward to bring the Missionary Message. He read scripture from St. Mark, chapter one, verses 14-15. Rev. Davis prayed and then delivered a challenging message. Invitational song "Lord I'm Coming Home". Rev. Locklear came forward extending the invitation.

Rev. Oscar Cummings, Jr. came forward to deliver the 11:00 o'clock message. Scripture reading, Hebrews, chapter 11: verses 7-10. Rev. Cummings brought an inspiring message on faith. Invitational song "Prepare To Meet They God".

Moderator came forth commenting on the forthcoming Camp Meeting, again urging all to attend. Motion made and seconded to take up nightly offerings, the money to be sent to the Free Will Baptist Bible College to help furnish the dormitories. Passed by the body.

Pastors of each church are to notify the Association Clerk as to who their delegates are to be to the Michigan State Association which will convene at the Shiloh Free Will Baptist Church on June 18-19, 1971.

Rev. W. H. Teague made announcements concerning Ladies Auxiliary and parking space for the Camp Meeting. He introduced Rev. and Mrs. Larry Whitwell, visitors from the Free Will Baptist Bible College.

Presbytery Board report: They recommend Bro. Earnest Parker and Bro. Delmon Edwards to be ordained as deacons. Rev. Don Doolin is to be issued a minister's card. Rev. Lloyd Estep is to return in six months for new credentials. Bro. Ray Pigg is to be issued a deacon's card and accepted in. Motion made and seconded to accept these recommendations. Passed upon by the body.

Bro. Fred Wilmoth resigned from the Home Mission Board. Motion made and seconded to accept his resignation.

Bro. Richard Fink resigned from his position on the Home Mission Board. Motion made and seconded to accept his resignation.

Motion made to adjourn for lunch.

Dismissed in prayer by Rev. Don Doolin.

SATURDAY AFTERNOON SERVICE, 1:30 P.M.

Opening song "Glory To His Name".

Led in prayer by Bro. Jerry Steele.

Report given by Bro. Fred Enloe of the Home Mission Board: They have selected Rev. Oscar Cummings, Jr. and Rev. James Bostic to be in charge of the Mission Church. Motion made and seconded that these two ministers and Bro. Granville Senters become members of the Home Mission Board. Passed by the body to this effect.

Motion made that we again have the minutes of the annual setting printed by the same printing company that printed them last year. Seconded and voted by majority to this effect.

Motion made that we give \$100.00 to the Youth Camp. Seconded and passed by the body.

Rev. W. H. Teague brought it to the attention of the people that workers are needed for the Youth Camp again this year.

There was some discussion concerning support for the Mission Church. Motion made and seconded that the treasurer could issue the Home Mission Board as much as \$100.00, if the need arises. Voted on and passed.
