FRIDAY NIGHT

JANUARY 20, 1995

4. Recommend that Bro. Raymond Riggs replace Bro. Earl Langely on the Presbytery Board for his term which expires in 1999. Motion approved.

The **Finance Committee Report** was presented by Bro. Holman with the following recommendations:

1. Give \$1,000 to the Free Will Baptist Bible College. Motion approved.
2. Give the Covenant Mission work \$300 per Quarterly session for a total of \$900 for the year. Motion approved.

Bro. Harold Bilbrey presented the **Treasurer's Report** which was approved as read.

The **Youth Camp Report** was presented by Bro. Kenneth Akers. The report was received as information. He indicated that the 1995 camp will feature Bro. Rick Locklear as camp evangelist. The annual Fall Youth Retreat is scheduled for November 3 & 4, 1995 in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee.

A report from the **Children's Home** was brought by Bro. Jack Taylor, Middle Tennessee representative. The name of the home has been changed to the Free Will Baptist Family Ministries in order to capture the enlarged scope of services. The four divisions of the home are: Trula Cronk Home for Children, Path Shelter, Stanley Foster Care Program and Oaks Family Conference Center and Camp. The report was received as information.

Bro. Roy Harris brought a report from the **Free Will Baptist Bible College** and was received as information.

A **Tennessee State Office Report** was presented by Bro. Raymond Riggs. Received as information.

In old business, a motion was made that elected officers to the Association be made standing delegates to the associational meetings. Motion made, seconded and approved. The business session was then adjourned.

After a short break the morning worship began with Bro. Wilson leading the congregation in singing, "After the Sunrise." An offering was taken in the amount of \$96.29.
