FRIDAY NIGHT

JANUARY 23, 1998

Brother Raymond Riggs led the congregation in singing patriotic songs followed by, "Lilly of the Valley." We were welcomed by the host pastor, Brother Paul Taylor. Visitors were recognized along with the representatives of each church. An offering was taken in the amount of \$114.04. A second congregational song was, "Love Lifted Me." The host church provided special music.

The evening message was delivered by Brother Fidel Yslas. The text was from John 3:16 with the title, "Sharing God's Love."

SATURDAY MORNING

JANUARY 24, 1998

The congregation was led in singing by Brother Donald Looney, "Victory in Jesus" and "Just a Little Talk With Jesus." The morning devotional was brought by Brother Jerry Proffit from Psalms 121. The morning offering taken and totaled \$114.15.

The **business session** was begun with the reading of the Rules of Decorum. The Church letters were read and approved with 10 churches reporting. Following the seating of delegates, the Minutes from the September, 1997 meeting were read and approved as read. The Moderator recognized visitors.

The **Finance Report** was given by Brother Jerry Buckner with the following recommendation: That \$1,000 be sent to the Upper Cumberland Fellowship of Free Will Baptists for an upcoming rally to benefit the Free Will Baptist Bible College. The recommendation was voted on and approved.

The **Treasurer's Report** was given by Brother Harold Bilbrey and approved.

The **Upper Cumberland Youth Camp Report** was brought by Brother Kenneth Akers. He indicated that the upcoming camp will be held June 7-13, 1998. Report received as information.

The **CTS Report** was given by Sister Tammy Lee and was received as information.

The **Presbytery Report** was given by Brother Marcus Clagg and included the following recommendations:

1. Brother Anthony Brown be ordained to preach the gospel.
2. Brother Josh Lowhorn be licensed for one year to preach.

3. Brother Franklin Bratcher be accepted into the Liberty Association as an ordained minister.

4. The establishment of a Ministerial Scholarship Fund:

"We the Presbytery Board of the Liberty Association recommend that a Ministerial Scholarship Fund be set up for the purpose of encouraging and also to aid the young men in our Association whom the Lord may call to preach the gospel. We suggest that the Associational Treasurer be authorized to take at least one hundred (\$100) from the general fund each session of the Association and place it in this Scholarship Fund, along with other funds that may be voluntarily given, and that these funds be deposited in a savings account to be dispersed at the discretion of the Presbytery Board.

We believe that young men who are called to preach today, could, and would be more effective and have greater opportunities if they would attend the Free Will Baptist Bible College. This would be a good start for them."

All of the recommendations were voted on separately and approved with an amendment to recommendation #4 which stated that the amount placed in the Fund be two hundred, fifty (\$250) rather than \$100 per session.

The **Free Will Baptist Family Ministries Report** was given by Brother Jack Taylor. He also provided information on the **Upper Cumberland Fellowship of Free Will Baptists**. The reports were received as information.

The **Tennessee State Report** was given by Brother Raymond Riggs who indicated that the 1998 state association meeting would be held in November at the First Free Will Baptist Church of Elizabethton. Report received as information.

Brother Sterl Paramore provided information from the **Upper Cumberland Bible Institute**.

In **New Business**, a motion was made to purchase a fire safe for the storage of Associational papers. The motion was voted on and approved.

Following the adjournment of the business session, the congregation was led in singing, "Just Over in the Gloryland" by Brother Donald Looney. Special music was provided by Donald and Angie Looney, including an instrumental.

Brother Carson Whiteaker brought the morning message. The texts were from II Timothy 4:1 & 2 and Acts 20:28 on "Taking Heed". He also gave the Ordination Charge. The Ordination prayer was led by Brother Jack Taylor with the laying on of hands by the ministers of the Association. Ordination papers and the right hand of fellowship were extended to Brothers Anthony Brown, Josh Lowhorn, and Franklin Bratcher.

A rising vote of thanks was extended to the host church for their hospitality toward the Association prior to the noon meal. Dismissal prayer by Brother Donald Looney.
