on January 26, 27, 2001

FRIDAY NIGHT

JANUARY 26, 2001

We were welcomed to the Association meetings by the host pastor and moderator, Bro. Paul Taylor. The congregation was led in singing by Bro. Donald Looney the song, "Jesus Hold My Hand". An offering was taken in the amount of **\$228.11**. The Upper Cumberland Fellowship Choir sang followed by an anointing and prayer for Bro. Raymond Riggs. Additional special singing by the the Looney's of the host church was enjoyed by all.

Bro. Russell Miller, pastor of Knight's Chapel Free Will Baptist Church brought the evening message from Psalms 42:1-5. Dismissal prayer was led by Bro. Sterl Paramore.

SATURDAY MORNING

JANUARY 27, 2001

The morning session was opened in prayer by Bro. Mark Kennedy. The Moderator recognized Bro. Carson Whiteaker on the occasion of his 87th birthday. The congregation sang, "I Never Shall Forget the Day", led by Bro. Donald Looney. The morning devotional was delivered by Bro. Jerry Proffitt from II Peter 3:10,11 entitled, "What Manner of Person Ought You to Be?" An offering was taken in the amount of **\$122.00** while the Looney Family provided an instrumental.

The **business session** began with the Moderator reading the Rules of Decorum. The church letters were read and approved. Delegates were seated. The minutes of the September, 2000 meeting were read and approved with a correction to the text passage Bro. Mark Kennedy had delivered.

The **Treasurer's Report** was given by Bro. Harold Bilbrey and accepted as read. The **State Office Report** was brought by Dr. Charles Thigpen and received as information.

Bro. Russell Walker of the **Finance Committee** made the following recommendations:

1. \$1,000 be given to the Upper Cumberland Fellowship Rally.
 2. Give \$200 to help Tennessee host the 2002 National Convention to be held in Memphis, Tennessee.
 3. That \$300 per quarter be given to the Signal Hills Church in Chattanooga, David Kell pastor.
- All three recommendations voted on and approved.

The **Upper Cumberland Youth Camp Report** was given by Bro. Kenneth Akers and was received as information. Bro. Akers also gave a report from **Master's Men** regarding upcoming events including state meeting at Cookeville Church. That report was information received.

A **CTS Report** was provided by Bro. Adam Clagg as information.

Bro. Jack Taylor provided a report on the **Upper Cumberland Fellowship Rally** as well as the **Free Will Baptist Family Ministries Report**. They were information received.

The **Presbytery Report** given by Bro. Jack Taylor offered the following recommendations:

1. Bro. Jerry Buckner's ordination papers be ratified and that he be accepted into the Liberty Association.
2. Bro. John David Wilson be licensed to preach.
3. Knights Chapel Free Will Baptist Church be accepted into the Liberty Association.

Each recommendation was voted on separately and passed. The right hand of fellowship was extended to the ministers as well as to the people of the Knights Chapel Free Will Baptist Church.

A question was posed by Bro. Daily McCowan, pastor of United Free Will Baptist Church regarding the status of that church in the Liberty Association due to it's not having deacons and being loosely organized at this time. The Moderator as well as the Chairman of the Presbytery stated that United continues to have standing in the Association the same as other churches within the Association.

Bro. Raymond Riggs thanked the Association for the money given to the Steve Riggs missionary account and he provided an update on that work in France.

Bro. Kenneth Akers dismissed the business session in prayer.

The morning worship service began by singing, "I'll Live in Glory" and "I'm Winging My Way Back Home." Following prayer requests and an altar of prayer we heard special singing by the Looney family.

The morning message was delivered by Bro. Kenneth Akers with the text from I Kings 19:11, 12 and entitled, "Having a very Special Relationship with Jesus".

Thanks was given to the people of the host church who also provided a meal following dismissal. Dismissal prayer by Bro. Bernard Houk.

3. \$1,000 be given for the Rally for Free Will Baptist Family Ministries which is scheduled for September. *Motion Approved.*

Bro. Harold Bilbrey presented the **Treasure's Report** which was accepted as read.

The **Upper Cumberland Youth Camp Report** was given by Bro. Verna Ridgell and received as information.

The **CTS Report** was given by Bro. Ronnie Lee and received as information.

The **Presbytery Report**, by Bro. Buddy Henry made the following recommendations:

1. Bro. Adam Clagg be ordained to preach the gospel. *Motion Approved.*
2. Bro. Larry Melton be ordained as a deacon at the Rickman Free Will Baptist Church. *Motion Approved.*

Bro. Jack Taylor gave a report from **Free Will Baptist Family Ministries** as well as a report on the **Upper Cumberland Fellowship of Free Will Baptists Rally**. Both reports were received as information.

Dr. Charles Thigpen gave the **Tennessee Promotional Office Report** as information.

Bro. David Kell gave a report on the Signal Hills Mission Church.

A **Nominating Committee** was selected by the Moderator with the following members: Bro. Mark Kennedy, chair, Bro. Kenneth Akers, and Bro. Bernard Houk.

FRIDAY NIGHT

SEPTEMBER 21, 2001

The pastor of the church, Bro. Frank Bratcher welcomed the Association to the church and read Jeremiah 33:3. Bro led congregation in singing "Amazing Grace". Brian Bratcher. An offering was taken in the amount of \$161.00. Special singing was provided by Brian and Traci Bratcher of the host church. Additional singing provided by Bro. Coleman Looper and family.

Bro. Coleman Looper delivered the evening message from Hosea 6:1-6 with the title, "For I desired mercy". The congregation had a special prayer for the nation in light of tragic events earlier in the month. Dismissal prayer by Bro. Raymond Riggs.

SATURDAY MORNING

SEPTEMBER 22, 2001

Moderator Paul Taylor welcomed everyone to the morning session. The congregation was led in singing, "I Feel Like Traveling On" and "Kneel At The Cross", by Bro. Brian Bratcher. A devotion was delivered by Bro. Brian Bratcher from Matthew 14:22-31 entitled, "Stepping out of the boat". We were led in prayer by Bro. Sterl Paramore. An offering was taken in the amount of \$96.10. The congregation sang, "Amazing Grace".

The **business session** was begun with the Moderator reading the Rules of Decorum. The church letters were read and accepted as read. Following the seating of delegates Bro. Tony Barnett opened the business session in prayer. The Minutes of the May, 2001 meeting were read and approved. Visitors were recognized.

The **Finance Report** was given by Bro. Russell Walker with the following recommendations:

1. That \$1,000 be given to the Upper Cumberland Fellowship of Free Will Baptists for the Free Will Baptist Bible College Rally.
2. To continue to support the Carthage Free Will Baptist Mission with \$300 per quarter.

The **Treasurer's Report** was brought by Bro. Harold Bilbrey and approved as read.

Bro. Raymond Riggs addressed the delegates. He expressed pride in the Association and how it has grown since its organization in 1976 to extend its reach around the globe. He expressed concern, however, that churches are not supporting the Association as stated in the bylaws, 5% of undesignated offerings. He recommended that all churches strive to comply with this amount and stressed the importance of doing it now in light of fact that National Convention will be held in Tennessee in 2002. This address received as information.

Bro. Sterl Paramore gave a report from the **Upper Cumberland Bible Institute** which was received as information. He also provided a report from the **Tennessee Home Mission Board** with details about the work in Memphis and the fact that Bro. Wayne Wagner is now traveling around the state to promote the project to pay off the Memphis work. Both reports received as information.

The **Upper Cumberland Youth Camp Report** was given by Bro. Kenneth Akers. The dates for 2002 camp are June 23 through 29. He also promoted the upcoming Liberty Association Youth Retreat on November 16th and 17th. Bro. Akers also provided a report from **Master's Men**, providing details about Operation Saturation which will assist the Carthage Mission, along with many other Home Mission churches. Reports received as information.

The **CTS Report** was also given by Bro. Kenneth Akers and received as information.

Bro. Mark Kennedy delivered a report on the **Upper Cumberland Fellowship of Free Will Baptists**. The Rally raised \$25,400 for Free Will Baptist Family Ministries.

Dr. Charles Thigpen delivered a report from the **Tennessee State Office**. He stressed the importance of doing our part in hosting National Convention of Free Will Baptists in Tennessee in 2002.

The **Free Will Baptist Family Ministries Report** was provided by Bro. Jack Taylor. He informed the delegates that a recent flood caused \$250,000 I damage to the properties. Report received as information.

The **Presbytery Report** was given by Bro. Jack Taylor with the following recommendation. The Presbytery requests permission to remove all ministers not complying with the Constitution and Bylaws of the Liberty Association from the roster of Associational ministers. Bro. Raymond Riggs made motion to amend the Presbytery request to have the names read of those to be removed. The names and reasons are as follows:

1. Bro. Stephen Clagg has moved out of state and never transferred credentials.
2. Bro. Roger Dial is not active in any church as far as known to the committee. A letter had been sent to Bro. Dial with no response received.
3. Bro. Irwin Detweiler has joined an independent Free Will Baptist Church in Pikeville, Tennessee.
4. Bro. Robert Sheppard, Jr. is divorced and remarried.
5. Bro. Fidel Yslas is no longer a member of any church in the Association. He was sent a letter but no response was received.

The amended motion was voted on and passed.
