SATURDAY MORNING

JANUARY 29, 2005

Bro. Jerry Buckner welcomed the delegates back to the Smithville first FWB Church. Bro. Phillip Hawkins led the congregation in singing, "I'm redeemed" and "We have come into his house". We were led in a devotion by the host pastor Bro. David Young. His scripture text was taken from Psalms ch.37. Prayer was led by Bro. Paul Taylor.

The **Business Session** was opened by moderator Bro. Jerry Buckner reading the Rules of Decorum. Delegates were seated. The moderator asked if there were any visitors. None were present. The clerk, Bro. Bobby Tosh read the church letters and the minutes from the September session of the Liberty Association. There were no changes or additions and they were approved.

Bro. Tim Farley presented the **Treasurer's Report**, it was approved. Bro. Russell Walker presented the **Finance Committee Report** with a recommendation that \$1,000 be given to the Upper Cumberland Fellowship of Free Will Baptists for the Rally for Free Will Baptist Home Missions. The recommendation was voted on and passed.

The **Youth Camp Report and CTS Report** was given by Bro. Rod Dablemont. He asked that the churches try and get more children involve in the youth camp, as attendance has been down some for the past few years. He also encouraged more churches to get involve in the up-coming CTS competition with area competition being held at the Cookville FWB church in early April.

The **Presbytery Report** given by Bro. Tony Barnett containing the following recommendations:

1. To accept the Union Grove Free Will Baptist Church into the Liberty Association.
2. To accept Bro. Jim Mott to be licensed and pastor at Union Grove FWB church.

3. To accept Bro. Mike Gillock into the association and to pastor Knight's Chapel FWB Church.

All recommendations from the Presbytery were voted on and approved.

Bro. Jack Taylor presented the report from the **Freewill Baptist Family Ministries** and his report was received as information. Bro. Jack also gave a report for Dr. Thigpen with greetings from the **Tn. State Office**. This report was also received as information.

FRIDAY NIGHT

Sept 23, 2005

We were welcomed to the Covenant Church of Soddy Daisy by Bro. Marcus Clagg . Bro. Marcus opened the service by leading us in prayer. The Church Choir sang a couple of songs and Bro. Adam Clagg offered up a prayer for the services.

The Church Choir led the congregation in a medly of hymns. The Moderator, Bro. Jerry Buckner was introduced and he thanked the Covenant Church for their hospitality and for hosting the 30th annual meeting of the Liberty Association. An offering was taken in the amount of \$144.00. The Moderator introduced Bro. Mike Gillock from the Knight's Chapel Church, who was to deliver the evening message. Prior to the message Bro. Johnny Reeves led an alter of prayer. Bro. Mike delivered the evening message titled "John did no Miricle". His text was taken from Matt. Ch 11 vs 7-11 and John Ch 10 vs 37-42. After an inspiring message, Bro. Jack Taylor led the dismissal prayer.

SATURDAY MORNING

Sept 24, 2005

The Saturday session was opened with the Covenant Church Choir singing and leading the congregation in "Lord I lift your name on high". Bro. Marcus Clagg held the morning devotion reading scripture from Psalm chapter 61.

The **Business Session** was called to order and Bro. Jerry Buckner welcomed the delegates back to the Covenant Church. Bro. David Young opened the session with prayer. The Moderator, Bro. Jerry Buckner appointed Bro. Mike McCoy of the Crossville Chuch as the Assistant Moderator for this session to replace Bro. Stryl Paramore, who was unable to attend this session due to a death in the Cookeville Church. Bro. Jerry read the Rules of Decorum and the Delegates were seated. The moderator asked if there were any visitors. Bro. Bert Tippet and his wife from the FWB Bible College were recognized. The clerk, Bro. Bobby Tosh read the minutes from the May session held at the Signal Hills Church and the letters from the churches for this session of the Liberty Association. There were no changes or additions and they were approved.

Bro. Russell Walker presented the **Finance Committee Report**, and asked Bro. Kenneth Aikers to explain more about the Disaster Relief Team, which is sponsored by the FWB Masters Men. Bro. Kenneth explained the work and stated that the team had just come back from Gulf Port, Mississippi where they had been working on a FWB Church hit by the Hurricane. Bro. Kenneth invited the congregation to view the responder truck outside in the parking lot during intermission. After Bro. Kenneth's remarks, the committee recommended \$2,000 be presented to the Masters Men and earmarked for the Disaster Relief Team. It was voted on by the delegates and approved. The Finance Committee also recommended that \$1,000 be given to the FWB Bible College rally to be held in Feb.2006. This was also voted on and approved. Bro. Tim Farley presented the **Treasurer's Report** and it was approved.

The **Youth Camp Report** was given by Bro. Kenneth Akers. He reported that 11

children were saved during this year's camp. He invited all churches to participate in the youth retreat to be held in Gatlinburg on Nov. 11th and 12th. Kenneth also gave a schedule for the Youth camp for the 2006 and 2007 year. The camp will be held June 18th thru June 24th 2006 and June 17th thru June 23rd 2007. It will continue to be held at Fall Creek Falls State Park. He encouraged each church to get their youth involved with the youth camp and youth retreat programs. Anyone needing information should contact Bro. Kenneth. This report was accepted as information.

No CTS Report was given .

Bro. Tony Barnett presented the **Presbytery Report** recommending that the Carthage FWB Church be received into the Liberty Association as a self supporting Church, that Bro. Steven Rogers of the Covenant Church be ordained , Bro. Martin Westbrook of Covenant be licensed, Bro. Zack Bates of Covenant be licensed and Bro. Gary Lewis of the Crossville Church be licensed to preach the Gospel. The Presbytery also recommended that the meeting schedules for the Liberty Association remain as in the past and that the Moderator would have the authority to select future sites for hosting the Associational meetings.

All recommendations were approved by the body.

Bro. Jack Taylor presented the report from the **Freewill Baptist Family Ministries**. He reported that 500 children had been served by the children's home this past year and that 138 had given their heart and lives unto the Lord. He also reported that the rally co-hosted by the Love FWB Church and Crossville 1st FWB Church's had raised between 25 and 26 thousand dollars for the Family Ministries.

Report from the **TN State Office** was also given by Bro. Jack Taylor representing Dr. Thigpen and encouraged all churches from the Liberty Association to attend the State Associational meetings to be held at the Oak Grove church in Greenville, TN. On Nov. 14th thru Nov. 16th.

These reports were received as information.

Other Business: Bro David Young of the **Nominating Committee**, reported that Bro. Jack Taylor was being recommended for another 5 years on the Presbytery board succeeding himself and that Bro. Luke Judkins was being recommended to a 5 year term on the Youth Camp Board succeeding Bro. Marcus Clagg, whose terms expires at the end of the year. All other officers to remain the same.

These recommendations were approved by the body.

Bro. Bert Tippet reported that the FWB Bible College had record enrollment and that 50 young men were being trained at present for the ministry. He also said 62 students were going to give up their fall break and go to Mississippi to help in the disaster relief efforts from the Hurricane.

Bro. Ronnie Lee reported on the Mountain Faith Mission in Hati. He said approximately 500 people attended the morning session of the VBS classes and 700 to 800 attended the night classes. These classes took place during the Labor Day weekend.

Bro. Jerry Buckner gave a report on The Walk-A-Thon for missions to be held on Saturday Sept 31st at Obey River Park in Crossville. He encouraged all churches to

participate in this Walk-A-thon.
This report was received as information.

Bro. Jerry informed the body that the January 27th and 28th, 06 meeting of the Liberty Association would be hosted by the Knight's Chapel FWB Church in Cookeville and that the May 19th and 20th meetings would be at the Crossville 1st FWB Church in Crossville.

The business session was adjourned with prayer led by Bro. Adam Clagg.

Following a short break, the morning worship service began with the Covenant Church Choir singing "Standing on Holy Ground", "You are my all in all", "This is your house", "That same Spirit" and "He lifted me out". Bro. Dan Horton asked the blessing on the offering and an offering of \$123.20 was received. The Pelfreys were introduced for the special singing. They sang "If it had not been" and "I just touched Jesus". Bro. Jerry asked all those to be licenced and ordained to assemble on the 1st pew of the church. After and alter of prayer, Bro. Grover McCoy was introduced to delivered the morning message. He titled his message "Spiritual Food". His Text was taken from Ezekel ch 3 vs 1-10. After a powerful message and prayer, Bro. Tony Barnett requested Bro. Marcus Clagg to preach the charge to Bro. Steven Rogers being ordained and to all those being licenced. Bro. Marcus text was taken from Romans ch 10 vs 14. Bro. Tony issued ordination papers to Bro. Steven and licenes to the other candidates. A right hand of fellowship was extended by the congergation.

Bro. Jerry Buckner thanked the Covenant Church for their hospitality. We were dismissed in prayer and a blessing was asked on the food.
