FRIDAY NIGHT

JANUARY 27, 2006

Bro. Tim Nash led the congregation in the opening song "Leaning on the everlasting arms" Bro. Mike Gillock welcomed the Liberty Association to the Knights Chapel Church and Bro. Mike McCoy led the opening prayer. The service was turned over to the Moderator, Bro. Jerry Buckner who recognized Bro. Carson Whitaker, celebrating his 92nd birthday on that day. The congregation gave Bro. Whitaker a standing ovation. Bro. Tim Nash led the congregation in the song Trust and Obey". Special singers were introduced, Linda Huddleston, her daughter Alana and Hanna Gillock from the host church. They sang two songs "He's Father to me" and "When it's down to you and me".

After the special singing, an offering of \$332.74 was taken. Bro. Albert Harris asked the blessing on the offering. The moderator introduced the speaker, Bro. Kenneth Akers and Bro. Kerry Higgins led the congregation in an altar of prayer. After prayer Bro. Kenneth gave a little overview of the youth camp activities, the teen retreat in Gatlinburg and the master's men's disaster relief team. He asked for all the churches to get involved in these activities.

Bro. Kenneth then delivered the evening message entitled Change/Love. His text was taken from Hebrews ch. 12 vs. 27 thru 29 and Hebrews ch. 13 vs 1 thru 8. After a wonderful message, we were dismissed in prayer by Bro. Carson Whitaker.

SATURDAY MORNING

JANUARY 28, 2006

Bro. Tim Nash led the congregation in the opening song "Where the Soul Never Dies" and Bro. Mike Gillock welcomed the Liberty association and its delegates back to Knights Chapel. Bro. Mike then led the morning devotion. His text was taken from Genesis ch. 12 vs. 7-9 and Genesis ch. 13 vs. 3 and he spoke about Abram seeking the Promised Land and churches leaving their tents and altars. Dr. Charles Thigpen led an altar of prayer.

The **Business Session** was opened by moderator Bro. Jerry Buckner reading the Rules of Decorum. Delegates were seated. The moderator asked if there were any visitors. Dr. Thigpen from the Bible College was present. The clerk, Bro. Bobby Tosh read the minutes from the September session of the Liberty Association. There were no changes or additions and they were approved. He, then read the letters from the representing churches and they were accepted.

Bro. Tim Farley presented the **Treasurer's Report**, it was approved. Bro. Tim Farley (sitting in for Bro. Russell Walker) presented the **Finance Committee Report** with a recommendation that \$1,000 be given to the foreign missions rally to be held in May. The recommendation was voted on and passed. The finance committee also recommended that \$1000 be given to the youth camp as a one time deal to help with the expenses of funding the camp. This was also approved by the body.

The **CTS Report** was given by Bro. Rod Dablemont. He asked that the churches get their children involved in the CTS competition to be held at the Cookeville church. He stated that March 10th would be the cut off time for fielding teams for the April competition.

The **Presbytery Report** given by Bro. Tony Barnett containing the following recommendation:

1. To ordain Bro. Jim Mott from the Union Grove Free Will Baptist Church.

This recommendation was approved by the body.

Bro. Jack Taylor presented the report from the **Freewill Baptist Family Ministries**. Bro. Jack stated that the home had been in existence for 67 years and that he felt this last year had been the best. Bro. Jack told of one of the homes, where an altar had been made from a coffee table and 3 young men in the home re-dedicated their lives to the Lord. One other young man in that home had gotten saved around that coffee table. Bro. Jack also informed the assembly of the upcoming rally for the Free Will Baptist Bible College to be held at the Cookeville Free Will Baptist Church on Feb. 24, 2006. These reports were accepted as information by the body.

Dr. Charles Thigpen gave a report from the **TN State Office**. He spoke of putting God first in everything we do. Bro. Thigpen also told the assembly of the upcoming 2006 Mid-Tenn Christian Worker's Conference to be held on the campus of the Bible College April 22, 2006. He urged everyone that could to attend this workshop. Dr. Thigpen also informed us that he will retire at the end of this year from the college after serving for the last 15 years. This report was accepted as information by the body.

Other Business: Bro. Jack Taylor spoke on full time pastor's retirement. The body agreed that the Liberty Association should continue to help fund this thru the state office for our full time pastors. Some payments had been omitted in error, due to changes in our treasurer's office. These are to be brought up-to-date. Bro. Jerry Buckner gave an update on foreign missions. He stated that April had been designated for foreign missions and asked that every church in the association get involved in some type program of giving during this time. Bro. Jerry also updated the assembly of the Walk-a-thon for foreign missions in which 3 of our churches had participated during Oct. 2005. Those participating were One Eleven Fellowship, Love FWB and Taylor's Seminary. He asked for other churches to see him for information about the Walk-a-thon for Oct. 2006. Bro. Jerry thanked Knight's Chapel for hosting this conference. He informed the assembly that the May conference would be held at the Crossville 1st Freewill Baptist Church. Bro. Roger Cooper dismissed the business session with prayer.

Following a short break, the morning worship service began with Bro. Tim Nash leading the congregation in "When We all get to Heaven" and "No not One". The morning offering was taken in the amount of \$213.50. Bro. Josh Phillips asked the blessing on the offering. Special music was presented by Bro. Doug Vaughn singing "Never Grow Old" and "The Old Account was Settled Long Ago". Bro. Tim Nash, Sister Velma Peek and Sister Thelma Cuninghame sang "Vision". After the singing, Bro. Steryl Paramore led an altar of prayer and Bro. Craig Mahler was introduced as the morning speaker. Prior to the message Bro. Craig sang "Because He Loved Me". He then provided an inspiring message entitled "God Has All Power". His text was taken from Matt. Ch.9 vs. 18-26.

Bro. Tony Barnett asked Bro. Jim Mott to come forward for ordination. Bro. Bernard Houk preached a challenging charge to Bro. Jim. His text was taken from 1st Timothy ch 3 vs. 1-7 and Titus ch 1 vs. 5-13. Bro. Dan Horton was then asked to lead prayer with laying on of hands by the Presbytery. Bro. Jim was given his ordination papers and he and his wife were extended the right hand of fellowship by the congregation.
