MORNING PRELIMINARIES

The song leaders for the day were Brothers John L. and Woodrow Herndon. Sister Anna Bennett played for each service. Opening prayer was by Brother Frank Beverly. Brother B. L. Shivar brought the morning devotions. Brother Woodrow Herndon welcomed the Association; Brother Clarence L. McMillan gave the response.

MORNING BUSINESS MEETING

Session was called to order by the Moderator, Brother Thomas Hamilton. Sister Geraldine Waid, Chairman of the Credentials Committee, reported that all of the church clerks had cooperated by sending in their annual letters soon enough to enable her to compile, and have copied, a resume of our churches annual statistics which was handed out to the delegates. *Thirteen churches reported; 13 ministers, 2 licensees, 20 deacons, and 55 elected delegates were present giving us 90 voting members for the day. All elected and appointed delegates were seated by vote of the standing delegates.

The chairman appointed Brothers Earl Ridley and William Barksdale and Sister Willie Williams to serve as the Finance Committee for the day.

The Chairman appointed Sisters Myrtice Giddens, Elva Barker, and Leona Willia to serve as the Obituary Committee for the day.

Minutes of the previous session were read and approved with one correction pointed out by the clerk, namely, that he had omitted the action of the Association electing Brother William Sumner to the State Mission Board at our July 28, 1979 session.

The Board of Christian Education reported that on September 29, 1979, it sponsored a Youth Rally at the Hahira Free Will Baptist church at 7:30 p.m. The speaker was Mr. Randy Brinson, a "born again" medical student. Some 60 people were in attendance. A hearty thanks to the Ozias young people for rendering outstanding special music. Also Bill and Wanda Cooper helped in the preliminaries, leading the testimony service and providing exciting games. Let us say "Thank you" to all of the adults who supported your young people in helping to get them there but especially we thank the Lord for the great young people He has given to us to participate in such a rally.

*By motion of the Association, the Pine Level and Ozias pastors were allowed to fill vacancies in their voting delegation even though their clerks failed to denote such authorization by their churches on their report to the Association.

(Having been petitioned by the Hahira church to examine and ordain their pastor, Brother David Cooper; and the Sunny Side church to examine and ordain their pastor, Brother Rowan Sirmans, the Association authorized the Ordaining Council to so examine.

MORNING WORSHIP SERVICE

After a song service, a Georgia State Cooperative Program offering of \$74.02 was received. Brother Buddy Hartsfield was appointed by the Chairman to serve on the Nominating Committee for the day. From the Pine Level Church, Brother Buddy Hartsfield, Sisters Brenda Hartsfield, and Freda and Mona Powell rendered special music. Brother J. B. Mercer brought the morning message. The Host Pastor, Brother B. L. Shivar, directed the Association concerning the serving of the noon meal and Brother Woodrow Herndon prayed the benediction on the service and the blessing on the noon meal.

AFTERNOON PRELIMINARIES

Following congregation singing, Brother Fred Baker led in prayer. Brother John L. Herndon and Sisters Woodrow Herndon and Leah Shivar rendered special music. Brother Herbert Waid brought the afternoon devotions.

AFTERNOON BUSINESS MEETING

Brother J. B. Mercer, Chairman of the Resolutions Committee, asked for and received a standing vote of appreciation for the fine way the Host Church, with the cooperation of the Zion Hill Church, hosted the Association.

The proposed "Government and Ordinances; Associational Decorum; Ministerial Relations; Constitution and Constitutional By-Laws" were taken from the table by motion. Brother Clarence L. McMillan made the motion to adopt the above document and to have 300 copies printed. The motion was unanimously carried by all who were voting.

Brother C. M. Chafin, Jr., reminded the Association of the current "Harvest Drive" for the Free Will Baptist Children's Home, Box 8, Eldridge, AL 35554.

Four delegates were elected for our State Association, November 15-17, 1979, at the First Free Will Baptist Church, Albany, Georgia. They were: Sisters Latrelle Barksdale; Nadyne Scott; Jane Summer and Geraldine Waid. Sister Margie Cooper was elected as an alternate. The Clerk was authorized to send \$60 to the State Executive Office for our Little River Association representation fees. Also, the Clerk was instructed to give to each of the above elected delegates, upon registering, \$25 to help with their personal expenses. The Clerk was also authorized to fill vacancies at the State meeting if all elected delegates and the alternate are not present.

The Nominating Committee Chairman, Brother William Sumner, reported. All nominees were elected as nominated.

Motion was made to stand to show appreciation to the outgoing Moderator and to all of the 1979 officers and committee, board and council members for the way they had served the Association.

Brother William Barksdale led in the closing prayer.

OF GEORGIA FREE WILL BAPTISTS
January 20, 1979, Zion Hill Free Will Baptist Church

MORNING PRELIMINARIES

The song leader for the day was Brother J. W. Franks. Sister Margaret Williams played for the opening service. Opening prayer was by Brother Audie Williams. Morning Devotions were by Brother Riley Giddens speaking from Acts 2:34-36. Welcome was by Brother J. C. Arnold; Response was by Brother Jerry Wishum.

MORNING BUSINESS MEETING

Session was called to order by Moderator, Brother Tom Hamilton. Credentials Chairwoman, Sister Geraldine Waid reported: all churches reported; 12 of 13 pastors were present; 2 of 6 other ministers were present; 15 deacons, and 50 delegates were also present giving us 79 total voting members for the day. The delegates were seated. The Chair recognized our visitors: Brother James Roebuck, State Clerk, and Brother A. C. Truluck. A finance committee for the day was appointed by the Chair: Brother Johnny Bennett; Sister Fannie Mizell; Brother J. W. Franks. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as printed. Brother Roebuck gave a report on the recent State Meeting and Brother Truluck gave greetings.

MORNING WORSHIP SERVICE

Congregational singing was led by Brother J. W. Franks, accompanied by Sister Ann Mercer. Brother Everett Williams led in the opening prayer. Georgia State Cooperative Fund Offering of \$72.48 was received. Special mustic was rendered by a trio from our Pine Level Church.
