MORNING PRELIMINARIES

Opened in prayer by Riley Giddens. Congregational singing led by Riley Giddens singing: "Praise Him, Praise Him" and "Glomy To His Name". Morning Devotions were by Ronnie Moore, Friendship Pastor: "When Does God Call?" Welcome was by Chester Rineer and the response returned by Bill Barksdale.

MORNING BUSINESS MEETING

Session called to order by Moderator J. B. Mercer. Credentials Committee report was given by Latrelle Barksdale: I1 churches, 11 pastors, 3 other ministers, 14 deacons, 54 church delegates, for a total of 82 delegates for the day. Church delegates were seated by vote. Minutes were approved as read. A Finance Committee was appointed for the day: Buddy Hartsfield, Chairman; Mike Mercer and Ray Parrish, members.

Ronnie Moore presented (GA State) report of Missions. Billy McKinney has elected to continue without further involvement from State Mission Board. Brother Lysaker, Dublin, GA, has balance on Bond of \$40,000.00. Lawn mower is to be bought for Dublin, \$1,250. Mission Board to present need to Executive Board for \$12,000 Bank Payment due September 13, 1984 for Northside Free Will Baptist Church. To present to Executive Committee the idea of one Sunday set aside each year for raising funds independent of COOP Program. Make South Atlanta area as a prospective site for new mission work and that the work be joint project, State and National.

Report of State Camp Board submitted by Roger Spivey we read and accepted as follows: The State Camp Board met 3 times. The Little River Camp Session will be held June 17-22. The Camp fee has dropped for a family with more than one camper. (\$35 for 1st camper, \$30.00 for 2nd and \$5.00 less for each subsequent camper per family.) Rev. Walter Scarborough will serve as Camp Director for the 1984 session. New activities at camp include: rifle range, nature trail and pony rides. The Master's Men plan a work day at Camp in May.

MORNING WORSHIP SERVICE

Song service was led by Rowan Sirmans including: "Amazing Grace" and "Victory In Jesus." Offering of \$103.68 for Georgia State Cooperative was received. Mike Mercer was called upon for special music which was enjoyed by all.

Roger Spivey, Corinth Pastor brought the morning message "How Does God Call?" Host Pastor Chester Rineer gave directions for Noon Meal, offered the benediction and prayed the blessing on the meal.

AFTERNOON PRELIMINARIES

Afternoon session opened with congregational singing led by Earl Ridley followed by prayer. Songs sung were: "He Hideth My

Soul" and "I Am Thine O Lord." Afternoon devotions were presented by Curtis Alligood, Homerville Pastor, "Why Does God Call?"

AFTERNOON BUSINESS MEETING

Little River Missions Board Treasurer, C. M. Chafin, Jr., gave report and it was accepted as follows:

A motion to do away with the morning and afternoon devotions died for lack of a second.

The Ordaining Council report recommended that the clerk send a letter of recommendation on behalf of Rev. Damon Dodd. They further recommended that:

Item 14 under "Government and Ordinances" be changed to read:
No licensed minister shall be ordained until he has been licensed
for one year and is called to the pastorate of a church (or churches)
or until he becomes engaged in full-time Christian activity, the
nature of which requires the authority of an "Ordained Minister of
the Chapel" and that Item 14 under "Government and Ordinances" be
removed from this section and transferred to the section "Ministerial"
Relations" where the licensing of ministers is dealt with at length.
Ordaining Council's report was received and approved as read.

The vote on sending delegate to National Association died for lack of a second.

Motion was made and seconded to send \$500.00 to the Children's Home (Alabama). Motion was approved.

Motion was made and seconded to procure a briefcase for clerk. Motion was approved

Curtis Alligood gave information on Home Mission speakers at Homerville. He stated to the Association that those who are to submit checks, to send them to Little River clerk.

A motion to adjourn was received. We were dismissed in prayer by Earl Ridley.
