NEXT SESSION: Zion Hill FWB Church, Millwood, GA January 18, 1992 The Little River Annual Association of Free Will Baptists met October 19, 1991 at Pine Level Free Will Baptist Church, Norman Park, GA at 9:30 A.M. The theme was "The Pastors Responsibility To The Church and To His Family", and "The Responsibility Of The Church".

The congregation sang "At Calvary". Prayer was by Bro. Rowan Sirmans. The devotional was given by Bro. Bill Barksdale on the responsibility of the church using Luke 14:16-24 for his text. Bro. Jackie Cabaniss welcomed us to Pine Level FWB Church. Acting Moderator, C. M. Chafin, Jr., called the meeting to order by having Bro. R. S. Hayes lead us in prayer. The Credentials Committee report was by Sister Louise Ivey as follows: 13 churches reporting, 7 pastors, 2 other ministers, 9 deacons, 20 delegates, with 38 total voting delegates. Herbert Waid, Georgia Promotional Secretary, brought the morning message on "The Pastors Responsibility To The Church and To His Family". The following scriptures were used: Genesis 2:18, I Timothy 3:2, 4; Ephesians 5:22, 25; I Peter 3:7, Ephesians 6:1, I Timothy 5:1-2, and Isaiah 49:15. Truly a very Biblical, touching message.
