- 2. We recommend that Rev. Emory Corbitt be received into the fellowship of the Association pending a letter of recommendation from the Martin Association. M.M.S.C.
- 3. The Ordaining Council received a letter from the Union Association requesting a letter of recommendation for Rev. Ronny Moore who has united with that Association. We recommend that such a letter be granted and the Clerk send the letter.
