The Littler River Annual Association of Free Will Baptist met on October 16, 1993 at the White Hall Free Will Baptist church in Waycross, Georgia at 9:30 a.m.. The theme for the day was "ENDURING SUFFERING", which was taken from I Peter 4:12-16.

The service began with the congregation singing, "SHOWERS OF BLESSINGS". The opening prayer was offered by Chester Chancey.

The morning devotion was given by Rev. Edward Matthews. The text for the morning devotion was taken from I Peter 4:12.

Brother Chester Chancey gave the welcome from the host church. Brother C.M. Chafin who was serving as the interim moderator called the business meeting to order. The Little River District Association of Free Will Baptists met in Quarterly Session, July 31, 1993, at Sunnyside Free Will Baptist Church, Kirkland, GA at 9:30 a.m. The congregational singing was led by Hal Williams. Thomas Day opened the meeting with prayer.

The devotional was brought by Mitchell Dean. Scripture was John 3:16. Hal Williams gave the welcome.

The business meeting was called to order by Bill Cooper, Clerk, in the absence of the Moderator and Assistant Moderator. The Moderator, Rev. Jackie Cabaniss, had resigned (see letter) and the Assistant Moderator, Rev. Bill Barksdale, had moved to another Association.

The Clerk asked the standing delegates for a move and second to have Bro. C. M. Chafin, Jr. a member of the Executive Committee, serve as Moderator for the day. Motion was made, seconded and carried by the standing delegates to have Bro. Chafin serve as Moderator.

The Credentials Committee report was given by Mrs. Louise Ivey.

Reporting were 13 churches, 8 pastors, 2 other ministers, 9 deacons,

28 church delegates for a total voting delegation of 47. Motion was

made and seconded that we seat the delegates from White Hall without a

letter (letter in mail). This was carried by the standing delegates.

Motion was made by Mrs. Ivey to accept the report and seat the

delegates—seconded and carried by the standing delegates.

The Finance Committee for the day was appointed as follows: L. D. Wynn, Tommy Sumner and Rev. Benry Smith. An offering for the State Coop was received—it was \$55.01.

Bill Cooper resigned as the Clerk effective at the end of todays meeting. A move and second was made to use a fill-in for Moderator today, but go ahead and elect a Clerk—motion carried. Moderator for the day, C. M. Chafin, Jr., appointed Rev. Rowan Sirmans and Rev. R. S Hayes to serve with Earl Ridley to help get a clerk for next year.

The Ordaining Council report was given by Rev. Rowan Sirmans (see report). Rev. Kent Barwick, Pastor of Homerville, was given the right hand of fellowship by the Moderator.

Bro. Barwick gave a good report from the camp session this summer (two people were saved). He also gave a report on Roll Call Sunday (see report). Rev. Steve Hughes made a motion to receive the report as information, adopt and try to reach the goals given in the report, seconded, carried. A motion was made to implement these goals and for each church to help meet the goal of 750 for the Association, seconded and carried.

The Finance report was given by Bro. L. D. Wynn (see report).

Motion made, seconded to accept the report, carried.

We were dismissed for recess by prayer.

Moderator Chafin called the meeting back in session. The minutes and treasurer's report was given. Minutes were read and approved as read. The treasurer's report was accepted as information.

Rev. Benny Smith gave a report for the State Mission Board (see report).

Rev. Herbert Waid gave a report on the National Fund Raising
Drive. The state of Georgia is about one-third there. Approximately
\$15,000-\$16,000 of the \$50,000 goal has been raised. This is to help
pay the National office debt of \$1 million. He stated that 77% of our
expense goes to missions.

The Nominating Committee nominated Rev. Barwick as Clerk. A motion was made, seconded and carried by raising of hands.

Rev. Charles Parrish made a motion to say thanks to Bill and Wanda Cooper for their work in the Association, seconded and carried by a rising vote of thanks.

Rev. Hughes gave a report on Double In A Decade (see report). He informed us of a Double In a Decade meeting at Camp Mt. Bethel, 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. on September 18. Bro. Hughes encouraged the Association to go to this meeting. Rev. Richard Adams will be the speaker.

Bro. Parrish made a motion that the Nominating Committee ask the person nominated for an office if they will be faithful if elected to the office—if not, they should not be considered for an office; seconded, carried.

Earl Ridley encouraged the people to commit themselves to work.

He ask that anyone willing to work tell the Nominating Committee.

Bro. Waid gave thanks to Bro. Barwick for his work on the National Obituary Committee.

The Resolutions Committee appointed for the day was Rev. Everett Williams and Ronny Hamm.

The Resolutions Committee asked that we give a rising vote of thanks to the host church for their hospitality.

A motion and second was made to adjourn, motion was carried. We were adjourned in prayer by Rev. Rowan Sirmans.
