# Minutes of the Little River Association's Annual Session when Convened at the Sunnyside F.W.B Church on January 18, 2003

The meeting opened with the congregational song "Just Over in the Gloryland", followed with a prayer led by Rev. Billy Sumner. Bro. Buddy Jordan, a licensed minister from the Sunnyside Church, brought the morning devotion from 2 Timothy 3:16-4:9, on the subject of the importance of Scripture.

The welcome from the host church was given by Rev. Sim Youngblood. Moderator Jeff Goodman then called the meeting to order.

The Credentials Committee report was given by Sis. Michelle Mercer and was as follows: 12 churches reported with 8 pastors, 9 deacons, 6 other ministers, and 38 delegates present. A motion was made and carried by the standing delegates to seat all other church representatives. The total voting delegation was 61.

The State COOP Offering was received and totaled \$79.30.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, and the Treasurer's Report was given by Clerk Keith Lloyd. A motion was made and carried to receive each report as given.

#### Reports and Actions of Boards and Committees:

#### LRA Camp Board:

- \* Rev. Roger Mercer gave information concerning Camp Ozias, thanked the Camp Board for their service to the LRA, and thanked the churches of the LRA for their prayers and financial support.
- \* A written financial report was presented and becomes an integral part of these minutes.

#### LRA Mission Board:

\* Special thanks was given to the Mission Board for planning and organizing the Mission Rally, to the LRA churches for their prayers and financial support, and to Sis. Melonie Brown who spear-headed the Rally. GA State Mission Board:

\* Rev. Keith Lloyd reported that the Atlanta mission work has been closed, and that there is a SBC group interested in leasing the building with the option to buy. The sale of the Atlanta work will be on the agenda at the State Meeting in March. Rev. William Selph stated that he had received information that a FWB group was interested in reorganizing the church. More information will be sought concerning this.

#### GA State Camp Board:

\* Rev. Jeff Goodman reported on the success of the Winter Teen Retreat. GA State Teen Camp is scheduled for June 2-6, at Camp Echeconnee in Lizella.

#### GA State Trustee Board:

\* Rev. Keith Lloyd reported on the State Office Building Project. The GA Trustee Board requested that the GA Executive Board authorize a \$100,000 loan to move forward with the project. The Executive Board made no decision on this request, but decided instead to let the Association decide at the State Meeting. The possibility was also presented of making an "in-house" loan to the GA Trustee Board from GA Camp Board funds. This will also be presented at the State Meeting.

#### Finance Committee:

- \* Sis. Maxine Franks reported for the Finance Committee. Her report was as follows:
- \* Beginning balance: \$584.88; Total receipts: \$1698.80; Balance on hand: \$2283.68. Motion, seconded and carried to receive this as a partial report, due to the absence of one church's fees.

#### Nominating Committee:

\* Rev. Roger Mercer gave the report for the Nominating Committee and received additional nominations from the floor. A motion was made to cease nominations and elect by acclamation, and was seconded and carried. The Nominating Committee report becomes an integral part of these minutes.

(brief recess)

Old Business: None

#### New Business:

- 1) LRA delegates to the State Meeting were nominated as follows: Sis. Heather Goodman, Sis. Joyce Trumbo, Sis. Michelle Mercer, and Bro. Eric Foster-Whiddon. A motion was made, seconded and carried to seat these as delegates to the GAFWB 2003 session.
- 2) A motion was made, seconded and carried to give authority to the Moderator and/or the Clerk to appoint substitute delegates at the State Meeting if necessary.
- 3) A motion was made, seconded and carried for the LRA delegates to support the sale of the Atlanta mission work at the State Meeting.
- 4) Rev. Roger Mercer, on behalf of the LRA Camp Board, reported the following: a Teen Lock-In will be held on Feb 28-Mar 1 at Camp Ozias and the cost is \$5 per person; LRA Junior Camp is scheduled for June 15-20, and, additional beds are needed as soon as possible. The Camp Board asks that each LRA church purchase one half of a bunk bed for a cost of \$130, preferably before Feb. 1st. This will make available 12 new sleeping spaces at a minimal cost to each church. Report was received as information.
- 5) Rev. Jeff Goodman, reporting on behalf of the GA Camp Board, recommended that the LRA vote to approve an "in-house" loan to the GA Trustee Board from the GA Camp Board, for the purpose of completing the State Office Project. A motion was made, seconded and carried to accept this recommendation. The LRA delegates will vote accordingly at the State Meeting.
- 6) Rev. Teddy Burch, reporting on behalf of the LRA Ordaining Council, recommended that a letter of good standing for Rev. Damon Dodd be forwarded to the Union Association. A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve this recommendation. Bro. Dodd has united with the Grace FWB Church in Moultrie, and with his health deteriorating quickly, earnestly needs our prayers.
- 7) Rev. Mitchell Deems recommended that the LRA sell the property it owns in Nashville and use the proceeds towards the indebtedness on Camp Ozias. The Trustee Board was instructed to investigate this possibility and report back to the Association.
- 8) Clerk Keith Lloyd read the Obituary Report from the LRA churches. After standing for a moment of silence in honor of the deceased, Rev. Mitchell Deems led the Association in a prayer of thanks for their faithful service and example.

#### Resolutions:

#1. Whereas, the Sunnyside Free Will Baptist Church has been very gracious and hospitable in hosting the Association, and have received us with love and kindness; therefore, Be it resolved, that we offer to them a rising vote of thanks and appreciation.

(accepted and acted upon)

A motion was made, seconded, and carried to adjourn from the business portion of our meeting.

Sis. Stacy Dejanes ministered to us with two special songs entitled, "On the Other Side" and "Power in Prayer". Rev. Teddy Burch brought the morning message from Luke 17:11-19, and his subject was also the theme of our meeting, "Where Are The Nine?". "Amazing Grace" was sung as an opportunity to respond to the Word was offered. Special prayer was offered for Bro. Buddy Jordan's brother, Terrell. Bro. Harvey Hamilton dismissed us in prayer and offered thanks for the food. A wonderful and bountiful lunch was provided by the members of the Sunnyside Free Will Baptist Church.
