

January 20, 2007, 9:30 am

PRELIMINARIES:

Moderator Teddy Burch welcomed the association and led in an opening prayer. The meeting began with the congregational songs, "Living By Faith" and "Leaning on the Everlasting Arms". Rev. Bill Lewis, pastor of the Open Door Church, welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Moderator Teddy Burch called the meeting to order, and Rev. Larry Johnson opened the business session with prayer. The Credentials Committee Report was given as follows: 11 churches reported with 10 pastors, 1 other minister, 9 deacons, and 50 delegates present. All elected delegates were seated by a vote from the standing delegates. The total voting delegation was 70.

> The State Coop Offering was received and totaled \$238.80.

> The minutes of the last meeting were read, and Clerk Keith Lloyd gave the Treasurer's Report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to receive each report as given.

REPORTS OF BOARDS AND COMMITTEES:

LRA Mission Board:

Sis. Melonie Brown gave the Mission Board report. This year's Annual Mission Rally will be held on Saturday, February 10th, 2007, 5:00 pm, at the Homerville FWB Church. Featured missionaries will be: Dr. Bill Lewis, Open Door Fellowship; Rev. Bill Crank, Cartersville mission work; and, Rev. William Smith, GAFWB Executive Secretary. Each church is asked to bring an offering of at least \$300 to this rally. The funds generated will be divided equally and given to the two participating Georgia missionaries.

Nominating Committee:

Committee Chairman Rev. Jeff Goodman took nominations from the floor. After all offices were nominated, a motion was made, seconded and carried to elect by acclamation. The slate of officers will appear in the Annual Minutes.

Finance Committee:

Sis. Maxine Franks gave a report from the Finance Committee. A motion was made, seconded and carried to receive the report. The complete report is as follows: Balance Brought Forward: \$911.29; Total Receipts: \$1980.80; Balance On Hand: \$2892.09.

GAFWB Camp Board:

Rev. Jeff Goodman reported on the success of the Teen Winter Retreat and informed the association of the dates for Teen Summer Camp. **GAFWB Mission Board**:

Sis. Melonie Brown gave the GAFWB Mission Board report. The 2nd Annual Damon C. Dodd Mission Offering will be held on March 4th. All churches are encouraged to give to this offering in support of Georgia mission works.

(Brief recess)

Executive Committee:

Having received a petition from the newly-established Solid Rock FWB Church of Tifton, Georgia to enter into the fellowship of the LRA, and having found everything satisfactory in the organization, doctrine and practices thereof; the Executive Committee recommends granting their request and receiving the church into the full fellowship of the association. A motion was made, seconded and carried to receive the Solid Rock FWB Church of Tifton, Georgia into the full fellowship of the LRA. Rev. William Sumner is the pastor and the church is meeting in a rented facility at 1613 Ferry Lake Road in Tifton.

Ordaining Council:

- ➤ Having examined Bro. Aaron Clanton, pastor of the Corinth FWB Church, and having found him to be sound in doctrine and meeting all Biblical qualifications, the Council recommends that he be ordained as a Minister of the Gospel at a time and place of his choosing. A motion was made, seconded and carried to ordain Bro. Clanton and to hold his credentials within the LRA.
- ➤ A letter from the Union Association was received on behalf of Rev. Terron Stonecypher, a member of the Forest Hill Church, with some reservations because of his not meeting their attendance and membership requirements. The LRA now holds Bro. Stonecypher's credentials.

LRA Camp Board:

Camp Board Interim Treasurer Keith Lloyd submitted a financial report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to accept the report. This financial report becomes an integral part of the minutes.

OLD BUSINESS:

None.

NEW BUSINESS:

- ➤ Sis. Melonie Brown reported that 3 groups from the LRA had reported to the Georgia Women Active for Christ (GWAC) with 44 members.
- Rev. Fred Hersey, a former missionary and now a Georgia pastor representing the International Missions Board, encouraged all association churches to get involved in the World Missions Offering by utilizing the "Change the World" coin banks. A short video presentation was shown and the coin banks were made available.
- ➢ Sis. Julia Faye Ogletree, Sis. Maxine Franks, and Sis. Melonie Brown volunteered to serve as LRA delegates to the GAFWB 71st Annual Session. Sis. Mary Lynn Ayers volunteered to serve as an alternate. A motion was made, seconded and carried to seat the aforementioned as delegates.

- ▶ Bro. Shannon Tolle, chairman of the LRA Camp Board, presented an opportunity for the association to replace the old military style bunk beds at Camp Little River with newer and safer bunk beds like the ones purchased previously. An individual has offered to purchase the older beds and mattresses for \$150 each, and the cost to replace them with newer beds and mattresses will be \$225 each. A total of 15 beds would be replaced. A motion was made, seconded and carried to sell the older beds and replace them with new ones. Every church represented volunteered to donate the additional money for a least one of the new beds, effectively covering the entire cost of the replacement without using additional camp funds.
- The Clerk read the Annual Obituary Report and the Association stood for a moment of silence, honoring the lives of those that had gone on to be with the LORD. Rev. Johnny Ware then led in a prayer of thanksgiving for their lives and service to the work of Christ thru the Free Will Baptist denomination. The Obituary Report will become an integral part of the Annual Minutes.

CLOSING ITEMS:

- > A rising vote of thanks was given to the Open Door Fellowship for their hospitality in hosting the 99th Annual Session of the LRA.
- ➤ Bro. Jonathan Tolle, a young man from the Homerville Church, has been selected to serve on the E-Team to Mexico this summer. Bro. Jonathan requested the prayers and financial support of the LRA. A special offering was received totaling \$200. An additional \$300 was given from the LRA Mission Board account.
- > Announcements, prayer requests, and praise reports were given from pastors and members of Association churches.
- > A motion was made, seconded and carried to adjourn from the business session. Rev. Carl Morrison dismissed the business session in prayer.

MORNING WORSHIP AND FELLOWSHIP:

- The congregation sang "Farther Along" and "I Am Thine, O Lord", which was followed by a special selection entitled, "We All Bow Down", by an Open Door Fellowship trio. Rev. Bill Lewis, pastor of the Open Door Fellowship, thanked the Homerville Church for their help in hosting the Annual Session and explained that Rev. Billy Hanna, the scheduled speaker for the meeting, had been unable to attend due to health issues. Bro. Lewis then brought the morning message on the subject, "Marching Orders: Our job as Christians in sharing the Gospel". After the message, the congregation sang together, "Jesus Paid It All", as an opportunity to respond to the Word was given.
- > Moderator Teddy Burch turned the meeting over to newly elected Moderator Jeff Goodman and Bro. Goodman closed the meeting in prayer.
- > The members of the Open Door Fellowship, with help from the Homerville Church, prepared a wonderful and bountiful lunch, and all who stayed enjoyed the food and time of fellowship together.

Business Session:

Moderator Teddy Burch called the meeting to order, and Rev. Larry Johnson opened the meeting in prayer.

Clerk Keith Lloyd asked those who were delegates, either standing or elected, to stand and be counted. The Credentials Committee Report was given as follows: 12 churches reported with 8 pastors, 1 other minister, 10 deacons, and 35 delegates present. All elected delegates were seated by a vote from the standing delegates. The total voting delegation was 54.

Shannon Tolle gave the following report: progress is being made on remodeling the kitchen bathrooms and dormitory wiring at the camp; the Ozias Church had relinquished the quit claim deed and all rights to camp property, and requested that the name be changed; the camp will now be called Camp Little River; and, June 4th has been set aside for all Association churches to receive a special offering for Camp Little River.

Sis. Jennifer Bishop, FWBBC student, member of the Corinth Church and daughter of missionaries Dale and Sandra Bishop, has been selected to serve as an assistant team leader for E-Team Japan in 2006. Since she is responsible for raising her own support, a motion was made, seconded and carried to assist Sis. Jennifer financially with a gift of \$500 from Mission Account funds.

> The Georgia COOP offering was received and totaled \$220.11.
