

Convening at:Forest Hill FWB Church, AdelDate:January 18, 2014, 9:30 am

PRELIMINARIES:

- The congregation sang "Just A Little Talk With Jesus" and "Glory to His Name", then Pastor Carl Morrison welcomed the Association and Bro. Teddy Burch led in an opening prayer.
- Moderator Josh Crozier called the Session to order, and as the first item of business received the special offering for the LRA Mission Board and Camp Board which totaled \$226.00.
- The clerk gave the Credentials Report as follows: 11 churches reported with 7 pastors, 5 other ministers, 9 deacons, and 23 delegates present. All elected delegates were seated by a vote from the standing delegates. The total voting delegation was 44.
- The minutes of the last meeting were read, and Clerk Keith Lloyd gave the

Treasurer's Report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to receive each report as given.

REPORTS OF BOARDS AND COMMITTEES:

LRA Camp Board:

Camp Board Treasurer Keith Lloyd submitted a complete financial report, and gave updates on camp rentals of the facility to outside groups. He encouraged churches to continue to give financial support in order to retire the indebtedness. This year's Junior Camp will be held on June 8th – 12th.

LRA Mission Board:

Sis. Melonie Brown reported on the World Mission Offering coin banks and offered information and prayer cards from home missionaries.

LRA Finance Committee:

A partial report from the Finance Committee was given. The complete report is as follows: *Balance Brought Forward*: \$5,711.07; *Total Receipts*: \$3,152.00; *Balance On Hand*: \$8,863.07.

<u>Annual Obituary Report</u>

As the delegates stood in honor and silence, Clerk Keith Lloyd read the names of those from our Association who went to be with the Lord in 2013. Bro. Billy Sumner offered a prayer of thanksgiving for their lives.

GAFWB Camp Board:

Bro. Edward Mathews reported that the State Teen Camp will be held on June 1-6 at Camp Echeconnee in Lizella. Background checks will again be required adult counselors and helpers who will be attending camp.

GAFWB Mission Board:

Bro. Keith Lloyd reported that the Cartersville Mission Work has been closed. The state is looking for a potential buyer for the property, but is responsible for satisfying the debt on the mortgage in the mean time. Georgia currently has no active mission works in progress.

GAFWB Mission Board:

Bro. David Landers reported that the date for the State Youth Competition has been tentatively set for May 3 at the Albany 1st FWB Church.

A motion was made to receive all Board and Committee reports as information. The motion was seconded and carried.

The Association recessed briefly.

NEW BUSINESS:

> The Ordaining Council moved to ordain Tanner Stahl, David Landers, and

- Sean Mercer, all of whom serve in Homerville FWB Church, as Ministers of the Gospel. The motion was seconded and carried.
- Hearing of the conditions, odors, and leaks inside the old restroom facility at Camp Little River, which has served as classroom and craft space in recent years, a motion was made to condemn and demolish the building. The motion was seconded and carried.
- The clerk read Nominating Committee recommendations. Hearing no other nominations from the floor, a motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve these nominations by acclamation
- Bro. Ronald Wallace reported on the self-supporting status of the Northern Lights FWB Church in Fairbanks, AK, and thanked the Association for their support. Bro. Ron is currently serving as the interim pastor of the Open Door Church in Valdosta.
- After announcements, a rising vote of thanks was given to the Forest Hill Church for being such gracious hosts of the Association.

A motion was made to adjourn. The motion was seconded and carried.

MORNING WORSHIP SESSION:

- The worship service began with the congregation singing, "He Set Me Free", "Living In Canaan Now", and "Do Remember Me".
- Pastor Larry Johnson, of the Ozias Church, brought the morning message from 2nd Chronicles 7:14 and Nehemiah 1:4-8 on the subject of America's need for revival. After the invitation and a time of special prayer, Bro. Keith Lloyd dismissed the Association with a prayer of benediction.

<u>Convening at</u>: Zion Hill FWB Church, Millwood <u>Date</u>: January 15, 2011, 9:30 am

PRELIMINARIES:

- The congregational sang "Brethren We Have Met to Worship". Pastor Keith welcomed the Association and explained that the meeting had been moved to Zion Hill from Camp Little River because of freeze damage resulting in no water to the camp facilities. Bro. Josh Crozier led in an opening prayer.
- Moderator Bill Lewis called the session to order.
- A special offering for the LRA Mission Board and Camp Board was received and totaled \$127.00.
- The Credentials Committee Report was given as follows: 12 churches reported with 6 pastors, 6 deacons, and 18 delegates present. All elected delegates were seated by a vote from the standing delegates. The total voting delegation was 30.
 The minutes of the last meeting were read, and Clerk Keith Lloyd gave the Treasurer's Report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to receive each report as given.

REPORTS OF BOARDS AND COMMITTEES:

LRA Ordaining Council:

Having received a letter of good standing from the independent Free Will Baptist Church which held his credentials, Bro. Josh Crozier, pastor of the Homerville FWB Church is now officially recognized as an Ordained Minister of the LRA.

LRA Camp Board:

- Camp Board Treasurer Keith Lloyd submitted a financial report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to accept the report. This financial report becomes an integral part of the minutes.
- Camp Board Treasurer Keith Lloyd reported that the indebtedness to the Church Extension Loan Fund for Camp Little River was fully retired as of January 12, 2011. He encouraged the Association to continue their financial support of the Camp because insurance, pest control, and utilities will continue to cost the Association approximately \$4,500 per year.
 In order to make the Camp self-supporting, the facility must be made rentable by correcting potential sewage problems, upgrading kitchen equipment, and installing a swimming pool. Having already discussed another loan with the Church Extension Loan Fund, Bro. Keith informed the association that he was prepared to offer a motion during new

business to proceed with borrowing up to \$40,000 for the aforementioned capital improvements to Camp Little River.

After questions regarding liability and maintenance issues, the report was received as information.

LRA Mission Board:

Sis. Melonie Brown informed the Association of plans to hold a late winter or early spring mission rally with Alaskan missionary Ron Wallace as the featured speaker. Her report was received as information.

LRA Nominating Committee:

Nominating Committee Chairman Keith Lloyd read a list of nominations. Hearing no other nominations from the floor, a motion was made that nominations cease and to proceed to elect by acclamation. The motion was seconded and carried. The slate of officers and committee members for 2011 will appear in the Annual Minutes.

LRA Finance Committee:

- A partial report from the Finance Committee was given. A motion was made seconded and carried to receive the partial report.
- The complete report is as follows: Balance Brought Forward: \$2956.79; Total Receipts: \$2056.00; Balance On Hand: \$5012.79. The complete report becomes an integral part of the minutes.

The Association recessed briefly for light refreshments. Upon reconvening, business resumed with State Board reports.

GAFWB Camp Board:

- Teen Camp will be held on June 5-10 at Camp Echeconnee in Lizella.
- ➢ LRA Jr. Camp will be held on June 12-16 at Camp Little River.

GAFWB Mission Board:

- Rev. Fred Hersey reported as a representative from the GAFWB Mission Board and the National Association International Mission Board.
- Currency exchange rates and the devaluing of the dollar are taking a major toll on the International Missions budget. Cuts are being made, but Bro. Hersey encouraged prayer for the dollar's value to strengthen. He also made coin banks available for the annual World Mission Offering.

Georgia mission works in Cartersville and Harris County are doing well, but plans to begin other works has been suspended until the current financial crunch subsides.

GAFWB C.E. Board:

Dr. Bill Lewis reported that the retreat fees will be increased slightly due to Georgia Cooperative Budget shortfalls. The next retreat on the schedule is the Couples Retreat at Lake Blackshear on February 25-26.

GAFWB Trustee Board:

Clerk Keith Lloyd reported that the Bainbridge church property has been deeded to the State Association and will probably be sold soon.

OLD BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS:

- A motion was made to adopt Constitutional changes reducing the frequency of LRA business sessions from four annually to two annually, held in January and July; to increase district representation fees from \$1/per member/per session to \$2/per member/per session; and, to designate the special offering received at each session be divided equally between the LRA Camp and Mission Boards. The motion was seconded and carried. A motion was made to secure a capital improvement loan from the Church Extension Loan Fund of up to \$40,000 for all of the recently approved Camp Little River upgrades. The motion was seconded and carried. \succ A motion was made to appoint Melonie Brown, Faye Ogletree, Michael Chafin, and Cindy Lloyd as delegates to the 75th Annual Session of the GAFWB, and to give the Clerk and Moderator authority to appoint alternate delegates as needed. The motion was seconded and carried. > As the Association stood for a moment of silence, the Clerk read the Annual Obituary Report. Moderator Bill Lewis offered prayer thanking God for the lives and testimonies of those departed. \succ A motion was made to applaud the Zion Hill Church for hosting the Annual Session on such short notice. The motion was seconded, carried, and acted up accordingly.

With no other business at hand, a motion was made to adjourn. The motion was seconded and carried.

MORNING WORSHIP AND FELLOWSHIP:

- The worship service began with the congregation singing "We Have Come Into His House". Sis. Christy Hurst sang a special entitled, "Come Morning".

FREE WILL BAPTIST CHURCH COVENANT

To be careful of one another's happiness and reputation, and seek to strengthen the weak, encourage the afflicted, admonish the erring, and as far as we are able, promote the success of the church and of the Gospel.

We will everywhere hold Christian principle sacred and Christian obligations and enterprises supreme; counting it our chief business in life to extend the influence of Christ in society, constantly praying and toiling that the Kingdom of God may come, and His will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

To this end we agree to labor for the promotion of approved educational and denominational enterprises, the support of missions, the success of Sunday Schools, and evangelistic efforts for the salvation of the world, and may the God of peace sanctify us wholly, and preserve us blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
