



Minutes of the Annual Session

Convening at: Homerville FWB Church, Homerville
Date: January 14, 2017, 9:30 am

PRELIMINARIES:

- The congregation sang "*Standing on the Promises*". Pastor Josh Crozier welcomed the Association and led in an opening prayer.
- Moderator Josh Crozier called the Session to order, and as the first item of business received the special offering for the LRA Mission Board and Camp Board which totaled \$105.00.
- The clerk gave the Credentials Report as follows: 10 churches reported with 5 pastors, 3 other minister, 7 deacons, and 9 delegates present. All elected delegates were seated by a vote from the standing delegates. The total voting delegation was 24.
- The minutes of the last meeting were read, and Clerk Keith Lloyd gave the Treasurer's Report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to receive each report as given.

REPORTS OF BOARDS AND COMMITTEES:

LRA Ordaining Council:

- Bro. Baldwin, pastor of the Friendship Church has not yet returned the doctrinal questionnaire sent to him by the Council.
- Bro. Jeremy Buhro, the new pastor of Open Door Fellowship, will be transferring his credentials from an Arkansas association.

LRA Camp Board:

- Camp Board Treasurer Keith Lloyd submitted a financial report.

LRA Finance Committee:

- A partial report from the Finance Committee was given. The complete report is as follows: *Balance Brought Forward: \$6,069.20; Total Receipts: \$2,587.00; Balance On Hand: \$8,656.20.*

A motion was made to receive all LRA reports as information. The motion was seconded and carried.

GAFWB Camp Board:

- Bro. David Landers reported that GA Teen Camp will be held on May 28 thru June 2 at Camp Echeconnee in Lizella; and, that Little River Junior Camp will be held on June 4 thru June 9th at Camp Little River.

GAFWB Mission Board:

- Sis. Melonie Brown reported that the Burke family's ministry in Castle Rock, Colorado has come to an end and they will be relocating to Gainesville, GA to serve under the Home Mission Board on a church revitalization project at the Liberty Church.

GAFWB Christian Education Board:

- Bro. David Landers reported on the upcoming state retreats and the Georgia Youth Competition, which will be held on May 6.

A motion was made to receive all GAFWB reports as information. The motion was seconded and carried. (The Association recessed briefly.)

OLD & NEW BUSINESS:

- Bro. Keith Lloyd read a list of nominations from the Nominating Committee. Hearing no other nominations from the floor, a motion was made, seconded, and carried to elect by acclamation.
- Bro. Tanner Stahl, on behalf of the Mission Board, requested that \$1000 be given to Rachel Pittman, from the Homerville Church, who has been chosen to travel with the E-Team to Japan. A motion was made, seconded, and carried to give this give from the Mission Board account.
- A motion was made to give the Camp Board the authority to make needed repairs and improvements to Camp Little River as those needs arise and as funding allows. The motion was seconded and carried.
- A motion was made to allow the Young Women's Association (affiliated with the Latter Day Saints) to rent Camp Little River, and that the Camp Board be given authority to make such discretionary decisions in the future. The motion was seconded and carried.
- After much discussion regarding LRA churches and pastors who are not represented at Association meetings, a motion was made to schedule a meeting with pastors to discuss the necessity of their representation in order to be in good standing with the Association. The clerk will send a letter to each pastor and church clerk in regards to this matter and the meeting. The motion was seconded and carried.
- A motion was made, seconded, and carried to give the Clerk authority to appoint delegates at the 2017 GAFWB as needed.
- After announcements and a rising vote of thanks to the Homerville Church for hosting the LRA, the Clerk read the Annual Obituary Report. After a moment of silence in honor of the deceased, Bro. Larry Hagen prayed.
- A motion was made, seconded, and carried to adjourn from business.

MORNING WORSHIP SESSION:

- The congregation sang, "Are You Washed in the Blood?", and a trio from the Homerville Church sang, "I Wanna Know How It Feels".
- Bro. Jeremy Buhro, pastor of the Open Door Fellowship Church, preached from Esther 4:13-17 on the subject, "For Such a Time As This".
- With no other business, the Association was dismissed in prayer.

PRELIMINARIES:

- The congregation sang "*Brethren We Have Met to Worship*". Pastor Keith Lloyd welcomed the Association and led in an opening prayer.
- Moderator Josh Crozier called the Session to order, and as the first item of business received the special offering for the LRA Mission Board and Camp Board which totaled \$106.00.
- The clerk gave the Credentials Report as follows: 10 churches reported with 5 pastors, 1 other minister, 5 deacons, and 8 delegates present. All elected delegates were seated by a vote from the standing delegates. The total voting delegation was 19.
- The minutes of the last meeting were read, and Clerk Keith Lloyd gave the Treasurer's Report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to receive each report as given.

REPORTS OF BOARDS AND COMMITTEES:

LRA Ordaining Council:

- The Council received a request from the Friendship Church to recognize the Church of God credentials of Pastor Alvin Baldwin as a Minister of the Gospel. Bro. Baldwin has not yet returned the doctrinal questionnaire sent to him by the Council.




