



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

Little River Association of Free Will Baptists Minutes of the Annual Session

<u>Convening at</u>: Camp Little River <u>Date</u>: January 19, 2019, 9:30 am

PRELIMINARIES:

- Rev. Teddy Burch, the Assistant Moderator, welcomed the Association. Bro. Mike Paulk sang a special and Rev. Carl Morrison led in prayer.
- Assistant Moderator Teddy Burch called the Session to order, and as the first item of business received the special offering for the LRA Mission Board and Camp Board which totaled \$242.00.
- The clerk gave the Credentials Report as follows: 10 churches reported with 8 pastors, 4 other ministers, 10 deacons, and 25 delegates present. All elected delegates were seated by a vote from the standing delegates. The total voting delegation was 47.
- The minutes of the last meeting were read, and Clerk Keith Lloyd gave the Treasurer's Report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to receive each report as given.

REPORTS OF BOARDS AND COMMITTEES:

LRA Camp Board:

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- Camp Board Treasurer Keith Lloyd submitted financial reports, gave updates regarding the need for facility repairs and improvements, warned of the upkeep exceeding the income, and let the Association know that Zion Hill Church would be spearheading the 2019 Little River Junior Camp, which will be held on June 9-13.
- Rev. Dale Bishop presented a written report from the Camp Little River Exploratory Committee. In an effort to see the camp ministry continue and flourish, they offered the following recommendations:
 - To revisit the Camp Board ministries, establishing quarterly meeting of the Board at the facilities, and to reaffirm the names, terms, and commitments of each board member;
 - To set quarterly work days, encouraging all churches to support the upkeep of the camp facility both physically and financially;
 - To obtain estimates for foreseeable repairs and upgrades covering the next 5 years;
 - To develop camp usage rental policies, clean up requirements, and damage deposits.
- A motion was made and seconded to receive the reports of the Treasurer and of the Exploratory Committee. After several questions and a lengthy discussion, the motion carried.

The Association recessed briefly for refreshments

LRA Finance Committee:

A partial report from the Finance Committee was given. The complete report is as follows: *Balance Brought Forward*: \$5,939.30; *Total Receipts*: \$2,690.00; *Balance On Hand*: \$8,629.30.

LRA Nominating Committee:

Clerk Keith Lloyd read a list of nominations from the Committee. A motion was made and seconded to elect those nominated by acclamation. With no other nominations from the floor, the motion carried.

GAFWB Camp Board:

Rev. Edward Mathews reported that GAFWB Teen Camp will be held on June 23-28 at Camp Echeconee in Lizella. Cost is \$165 for early bird registration and \$190 afterwards.

GAFWB Mission Board:

- Rev. Dale Bishop submitted a written report from the Mission Board, which included the status of the Liberty Church revitalization effort, the progress of the Tifton church plant, and the property in Cartersville.
- Rev. Josh Bennett gave an update on the church plant in Tifton. Awaken Church continues to grow, has purchased a building, and will be holding several work days to begin renovating the property for church use.

A motion was made to receive all GAFWB reports as information. The motion was seconded and carried.

OLD & NEW BUSINESS:

- Rev. Josh Bennett requested permission for the Awaken Church to utilize the Camp Little River facility to host two mission teams that will be coming to help the church on June 23-28 and July 6-13. Both groups will make donations to cover the cost of utilities. A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the request.
- After announcements, a rising vote of thanks was given to the Sunnyside Church for being such gracious hosts to the Association.
- The Clerk read the Annual Obituary Report, followed by a moment of silence and a prayer of thanksgiving for the testimony of the departed saints who had been faithful to serve in our churches.
- > A motion was made, seconded, and carried to adjourn.

MORNING WORSHIP SESSION:

- Rev. Alvin Baldwin, pastor of the Friendship Church, brought the morning message from 2nd Chronicles 7:14.
- Rev. Teddy Burch made closing remarks and Bro. Clifford Pope dismissed us with prayer.

Convening at:Sunnyside FWB Church, KirklandDate:July 28, 2018, 9:30 am

PRELIMINARIES:

- The congregation sang an opening song and the Pastor of Sunnyside, Rev. Teddy Burch, welcome the Association an led in an opening prayer.
- Moderator Josh Crozier called the Session to order, and as the first item of business received the special offering for the LRA Mission Board and Camp Board which totaled \$220.00.
- The clerk gave the Credentials Report as follows: 9 churches reported with 7 pastors, 2 other ministers, 8 deacons, and 23 delegates present. All elected delegates were seated by a vote from the standing delegates. The total voting delegation was 40.
- The minutes of the last meeting were read, and Clerk Keith Lloyd gave the Treasurer's Report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to receive each report as given.

REPORTS OF BOARDS AND COMMITTEES:

LRA Ordaining Council:

- The ordination of Zion Hill's Youth Pastor, Bro. Chris Walker, is pending the completion of his examination and Association approval.
- The former pastor of Cool Springs, Bro Marlon Daniels, never completed the ordination process through the Little River Association.

LRA Mission Board:

Rev. Tanner Stahl has relocated to Tupelo. His vacated positions on the LRA and GAFWB Mission Boards need to be filled.

LRA Camp Board:

- Camp Board Treasurer Keith Lloyd submitted financial reports of the Camp Board and Junior Camp. There were no renters in 2018. Due to the cost of maintenance, utilities, insurance, and the lack of financial support from the majority of the LRA churches, Bro Keith suggested that it may be time for the Association to look into other potential usages for the camp. Otherwise, it will become difficult to financially sustain the facilities.
- Camp Director David Landers reported that Little River Junior Camp had 29 campers. The downturn in camp participation is statewide.
- Moderator Josh Crozier discussed the need for those who use the Camp to be held responsible for cleaning afterwards. He also informed the Association that Homerville would be stepping aside in their lead role for Junior Camp 2019. Zion Hill has agreed to step up to assume that role.
- > A motion was made, seconded, and carried to receive the report.

LRA Finance Committee:

A partial report from the Finance Committee was given. The complete report is as follows: Balance Brought Forward: \$4,603.30; Total Receipts: \$1,466.00; Balance On Hand: \$6,069.30. Moderator Josh Crozier appointed Teddy Burch, Jeremy Buhro, David Landers, and Keith Lloyd to serve on the 2019 Nominating Committee.

A motion was made to receive all LRA reports as information. The motion was seconded and carried.

GAFWB Camp Board:

Moderator Josh Crozier reported that Teen Camp had just under 100 campers. Camp attendance has declined rapidly in recent years.

GAFWB Mission Board:

Rev. Josh Bennett gave an update on the church plant in Tifton. The church name is "Awaken". They have had over 100 in attendance at each of the three preview services. Plans are to hold an official launch in September. He also invited the Association to participate in a seminar on August 3 entitled, "Tech Savvy Parenting'.

GAFWB Trustee Board:

No report

GAFWB Christian Education Board:

- David Landers reported that the Little River Association had no contestants in the National Youth Competition.
- > The Senior Citizen's Retreat will be held in November.

A motion was made to receive all GAFWB reports as information. The motion was seconded and carried. (The Association recessed briefly.)

OLD & NEW BUSINESS:

- A Camp Little River "Exploratory Committee", which will meet in cooperation with the Camp Board to assess future plans for the camp facility, was nominated as follows: Nina Rowe, James Corbitt, Curtis Knight, Corey Hayes, and Dale Bishop. A motion was made, seconded, and carried to appoint this committee.
- A motion was made to appoint Dale Bishop to the GAFWB Mission Board, Jeremy Buhro to the LRA Mission Board, and Ronnie Lieupo to the LRA Camp Board. The motion was seconded and carried.
- At the request of the Clerk, a motion was made to allow the destruction of LRA receipts, bank statements, and other records that were 10 years old or older. The motion was seconded and carried.
- After announcements, a rising vote of thanks was given to the Sunnyside Church for being such gracious hosts to the Association.
- > A motion was made, seconded, and carried to adjourn.

MORNING WORSHIP SESSION:

- The congregation sang "Tis So Sweet to Trust in Jesus" and "Victory in Jesus". Rev. Josh Bennett, pastor of the Awaken Church, preached from Acts 17:16-34 on the subject, "Times Are Changing".




