

Move by Rev. Larry Williams and second by Rev. Lewis Williams to take off table the move to combine our present two camp boards into one board known as the Martin Free Will Baptist Youth Camp Board of Trustees. Motion carried. Move by Rev. Larry Williams and second by Rev. W. S. Driggers that action on this move be postponed until the credential committee was back in meeting. Move carried.

Rev. Larry Williams recommended that we have a Missions Sunday—Possibly switching pastors, emphasizing missions, and taking a special offering for missions. Move by Rev. Lewis Williams and second by Rev. Larry Williams that the moderator appoint a committee of three to make suggestions concerning such a day and to report back after lunch. Move carried. Moderator appointed Rev. Lewis Williams, Rev. Wendell Trussell and Rev. W. S. Driggers to this committee. Sister Eva Middleton suggested that all pastors study the by-laws in the state minutes and be informed of dues to be paid at registration at state association meetings.

## STANDING RULES FOR MARTIN QUARTERLY MEETINGS

1. Recommend that each church close their books on September 1 and mail their annual and quarterly reports to the clerk two weeks before each session.
2. The pastoral year will begin on September 1st.
3. Each church that entertains Quarterly Meetings will prepare a program for that day and be responsible for preacher and speakers and let the moderator and clerk know in advance for the meeting.
4. The Sunday School and C.T.S., Ministers and Deacons Conference, Ladies Auxiliary and any other auxiliary give an annual report to the Quarterly Meetings.
5. Obituaries of each church will give name, date of birth and date of death of members in an annual report to the Quarterly Meetings. This information will be given to the Resolutions Committee.
6. Our standing resolutions will be printed in the minutes each year.
7. Our Quarterly Meeting fee will be 25¢ per capita member at each session, or \$1.00 at the Annual Conference.
8. A Digest Committee of at least three will be elected by the body or appointed by the moderator to examine church letters and make a report of their findings.
9. Our Quarterly Meetings will be Saturday before the third Sunday in January, April, July and October at 10:00 A.M. The Annual Session will be held in October beginning at 9:30 A.M. and continuing until all business is finished.
10. That no person may serve more than one elected office in the Martin Quarterly at the same time.
11. That the Second and Annual Sessions of the Quarterly Meeting will be held at the Youth Camp with all churches acting as hosts.

12. **DISBURSEMENTS:** (A) Retain in treasury \$50 after each session (B) State Association \$5 each session (C) retain for printing minutes \$80 each session (D) National Association \$2.50 each session (E) Moderator \$5 per session, Clerk \$5 each session per one, two, three sessions, and \$20 for fourth session. (F) the remaining funds left will be allocated as follows: (a) State Cooperative Board, 5%, (b) Local Mission Board, 10%, (c) State Superannuation Board, 75%, (d) Local promotion, 10%.
13. The moderator and clerk will not serve more than three years in succession.
