THE MARYLAND STATE ASSOCIATION BY-LAWS

1. The clerk or his assistant or in their absence the senior minister in years shall call the Association to order if a quorum is present. The Moderator or in his absence the Assistant Moderator shall take charge. If neither is present, a Moderator Pro Tem shall be elected.

2. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to enroll the ordained personnel and delegates to this Association who shall sign the register upon arrival with name, address, and Quarterly Meeting they represent. Visitors will also be registered.

3. It shall be the duty of each Quarterly Meeting belonging to this Association to send a letter to each annual meeting of this Association reporting in the same its statistics and benevolent work. Any Quarterly Meeting belonging to this Association may be dismissed from the Association by a two-thirds vote of all members present.

4. Each session shall be opened by Scripture reading and prayer and shall be closed with prayer.

5. By a two-thirds vote of all members present a ruling of the Moderator can be overruled.

6. The Moderator shall have the same privileges to speak as any other person, provided the Chair is filled.

7. This Association may correspond by letter or otherwise with other religious bodies.

8. This Association shall sit with open doors except when it shall go into a committee of the whole.

9. Any person not a member of this Association may be allowed to take part in discussion by obtaining permission from the Moderator and properly identifying themselves.

10. Anyone desiring to speak shall stand and address the Moderator by the appellation "Brother Moderator" but shall not speak further until recognized by the Moderator.

11. It shall be the duty of each member of the Association to be present at the time appointed for each meeting. Anyone wishing to retire should first obtain permission from the Moderator.

12. The Moderator of this Association must be an ordained minister.

13. The Moderator shall not allow discussion when not carried on in a Christian spirit or when he thinks it will cause discord or division.

14. No person shall be allowed to nominate more than one member of any committee provided the person nominated be elected.

15. It shall be the duty of the Moderator to seat delegates in a body in a designated section at the beginning of each session.

16. Five Members or a majority of the resident members present shall constitute a quorum in conference.

CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE

We the members of the Free Will Baptist denomination, being baptized upon the profession of our faith in Christ and realizing the necessity of a bond of union and fellowship among us as a State Association and to preserve and maintain correspondence and coordination among us, do therefore adopt this Constitution for our better denominational government.

1. This yearly meeting shall be called The Maryland State Association of Free Will Baptist and shall be composed of such regularly organized and well disciplined Free Will Baptist Quarterly Meetings conveniently located as may embody themselves under this Constitution.

2. The business of this Association shall be conducted by the ordained ministers and deacons and elected delegates and clerks who are members of a Quarterly Meeting within this Association. Each Quarterly Meeting is entitled to three delegates from each Church, in addition to the ordained personnel who are standing delegates.

3. The officers of this Association shall be elected for a term of three years, except the Moderator and Assistant Moderator, which shall be elected annually at the close of the meeting of this Association.

4. Any well-organized Free Will Baptist Quarterly Meeting composed of such church as conform to the usages and adopt the doctrines and the Treatise of the Constitution and By-Laws of this Association may at any time, upon application and by majority vote of this Association, become a member thereof.

5. From this time (June 1970) forward, any minister or deacon applying for membership in this Association must first meet the qualifications set forth in I Timothy, Chapter 3 and Titus, Chapter 1. No minister or deacon shall hold membership in this Association if he or his wife have a living companion from a previous marriage.

6. This Association shall have authority to discipline the Quarterly Meetings of which it is composed and exclude them for practices contrary to the Constitution and By-Laws of this Association.

7. The annual meeting of this Association shall convene on Friday morning at 9 o'clock before the fourth Sunday in June and shall have power to adopt any regulations or by-laws not inconsistent with the further regulation of its sessions.

8. This Association shall not recognize any minister or delegate unless they comply with the Constitution and By-Laws thereof.

9. Parliamentary procedure will be governed by "Robert's Rules of Order."

10. The Constitution and By-Laws of this Association may be altered or amended at any regular session by a two-thirds vote of the members present, providing the change has been submitted in writing, and tabled from one previous Annual Session.

GENERAL BOARD

The General Board of this Association shall meet at 7:00 P. M. on Thursday before the regular Annual Session convenes on Friday morning, and shall consist of the following: Moderator, Clerk, Executive Committee, also two members-at-large from each Quarterly Meeting and the Chairman of all Boards and Committees. It shall be the duty of all members of this Board to be present at the time appointed for each meeting. Proxy representation will be accepted upon presentation of a statement signed by the member. All meetings of this Board shall convene with open doors except when resolved into a committee of the whole. Any person not a member of this Board may be allowed to take part in the discussions by obtaining permission from the Moderator.

DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution of the Maryland State Association of Free Will Baptist, any assets of the organization then remaining shall be conveyed to such organizations then existent dedicated to similar objectives to those of this organization, selected by the Executive Board at the time of dissolution, which organization must be exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as amended or under successor provisions of the Code as may be in effect at the time of dissolution.

MINUTES

Friday, June 24, 1983

9:00 A. M. Session

The 17th Annual Session of the Maryland State Association convened with the Yorkshire Free Will Baptist Church, Manassas, Virginia. The theme for this session was "Constrained by Love". Scripture reference II Corinthians 5:12.

The meeting opened with congregational singing of "Victory in Jesus" led by Bro. Roger Wilson with Sister Martha Ramey at the piano.

The session was then called to order by Rev. Murray Southwell, Clerk who read from II Timothy 2: 1-7 and offered prayer.

Rev. Lester Horton, Moderator, took charge of the meeting and recognized the host pastor, Rev. Lonnie Salyer, who extended a welcome to all.

Rev. Horton then recognized those visitors in attendance from different denominational departments: Bro. Waddell-Foreign Missions; Bro. Green-Randall House Publications; Bro. Raper-Free Will Baptist Childrens Home; Bro. Haas-Southeastern Bible College; Bro. Thomas-Home Missions; Dr. Worthington-Executive Department; Bro. Creech-Free Will Baptist Bible College.

The Moderator called for a reading of the letters and seating of the delegates. Clerk, Rev. Murray Southwell read letters from the Northern Virginia Quarterly Conference, New River Quarterly Conference, Maryland/New Jersey Conference, and Central Virginia Quarterly Conference. MSC to accept letters and to seat delegates with Pastors making adjustments as to delegates.

The Moderator noted the appointment of Mrs. Betty Goodnough as secretary pro tem in the absence of Sister Lockee.

Members of the Committee on Committees as appointed by the Moderator were: Rev. Elzo Bevan, Rev. Lonnie Salyer & Rev. Vergel Maness.

A partial report was given by the Committee on Committees by Rev. Elzo Bevan:

Nominating Committee: Rev. William Steele, Bro. Clyde Settle & Bro. Cossie Meade.

Budget Committee: Rev. David Reece, Bro. Curtis Byrd & Rev. Houston Mullins.

Report not acted upon at this time.

GENERAL BOARD REPORT - June 23, 1983 - was passed out to those present and read by the clerk. MSC to adopt this report and to deal with recommendations item by item.

STATE TREASURER'S REPORT was presented. MSC to receive as presented.

STATE MISSIONS TREASURER'S REPORT was presented. MSC to accept this report.

MODERATOR'S REPORT of expenses for the past year was presented. MSC to receive this report.

MOTION to consider the General Board's recommendation that the Moderator be at liberty to attend the National Leadership Conference if he so chooses. MSC that this be approved.

MOTION to consider the Home Missions Board report as presented and adopt its recommendations item by item.

MOTION to consider

1. That hospitalization benefits be increased for the Missionary from \$85.00 to an amount sufficient for family coverage with the option of \$25,000.00 life insurance, purchased through the Board of Retirement & Insurance, and paid through the National Home Mission Board. MSC to accept this recommendation.

MOTION to consider

2. That the Heritage Church assume one-third of the present Pastor's salary, the amount of their payment per month \$488.92. MSC to accept this recommendation.

MOTION to consider

3. That we erase the amount Bro. Reece's account is in the red by transferring \$1,500.00 from the State Mission General Fund and \$1,000.00 from the State General Fund making a total of \$2,500.00. MSC to accept this recommendation.

MOTION to consider

4. That all our churches contribute monthly to the Fredericksburg project. MSC to accept this recommendation.

MOTION to consider

5. That we express our appreciation for a job well done by giving Bro. Reece \$200.00 toward his expenses to attend the National Association in Ohio. MSC to accept this recommendation.

MSC to accept the General Board's recommendation that we recommit ourselves to 3% of undesignated funds for State work.

Bro. David Reece, Missionary to Fredericksburg gave report on the progress of the work there. He reported spiritual growth in the Lord among the

members through the special project undertaken by the membership to read the Bible through in a year. He reported that work is progressing and concrete will soon be poured to lay the foundation for their church building. God's blessings were upon them during revival services with evangelists, the Worthington twins. He reported they were looking forward to their Fall revival services with Dr. Jerry Cohen. He also noted that they were printing a newsletter and anyone who would like to receive it should give him their address.

Bro. Reece also shared information as to some financial calculations he had arrived at and stated that if each church in the Maryland State gave \$10.00 per week per church to the State Missions Fund that the State could support a missionary in the field without cutting into funds in the National Home Missions.

MSC to receive as information the report of Bro. Roy Thomas, General Director of the National Home Missions Department.

MSC to receive as information the report of Bro. James Earl Raper from the Greenville Children's Home.

MSC to recess from business session until after the Woman's Auxiliary session in the afternoon.

The 11:00 o'clock worship services began with congregational singing of "When the Roll is called Yonder". Special Music presented by the "Christian Heart Quartet" from Bloss Church. Presiding, Bro. Tommy Meade with opening remarks and scripture from Psalms 37:1-5 followed by congregational singing of "He Lives". Message brought by Rev. Elzo Bevan from II Corinthians 5:11 - "The Challenge".

RECESS FOR LUNCH

The afternoon session began at 1:30 P. M. with the Woman's Auxiliary Program. Presiding was the Maryland State President, Karen Southwell. Opening hymn by congregation was "Love Lifted Me". Mrs. Lottie Horton, Secretary/Treasurer, gave progress report. Bro. Roger Wilson rendered special music by singing "Statue of Liberty". The theme "Thou Shalt Love" based on Luke 10:27. Message brought by Bro. Roy Thomas using text from Nehemiah 1:1-4.

MSC to receive the report of Bro. Joe Haas from the Southeastern Free Will Baptist College as information.

MSC to receive the report of Bro. Fred Green from Randall House Publications as information.

A synopsis of the STATE MISSIONS REPORT as submitted by Rev. Lester Horton, Chairman, follows:

Grace Free Will Baptist Church in Trevilians, Virginia was organized with 13 charter members. They

have secured property with a church building on it; and due to growth of the Sunday School, additional classrooms are already under construction. This church has united with the Northern Virginia Conference. Rev. Roger Bevins is Pastor.

The Stafford Church has purchased property and is ready to begin construction. Rev. Joel Cantrell is Pastor.

Grace Free Will Baptist Church in Elkton, Maryland welcomed 12 new members in the last year. They have purchased three acres of choice property. Rev. Vernon Coleman is Pastor.

Shiloh Church in Criglersville, Virginia continues to win souls and new members. Rev. Harold Pickeral is Pastor.

The above-mentioned churches are not supported by the Mission Board and are to be commended for their efforts.

Rev. Vergel Maness is serving as missionary to Vineland, New Jersey under the National Home Mission Board. He needs our prayers and support.

The Fredericksburg Project under the direction of Rev. David Reece is making progress on getting their building started. The congregation has agreed to assume 1/3 of Bro. Reece's salary. This Project is the responsibility of this Association to raise the funds to underwrite the project. Pastors were asked to keep the challenge before their churches.
