



RANDALL HOUSE REPORT GIVEN BY HAROLD HARRISON. HE ANNOUNCED THAT COMING IN 1989 ARE A NEW TEEN CURRICULUM AND A NEW ADULT CTS CURRICULUM. THE THIRD 7 YEAR CYCLE IN THE ADULT SS CURRICULUM WILL END IN 1990 AND A NEW 9 YEAR CYCLE WILL BEGIN. HE ALSO MENTIONED THE 3RD VOLUME OF THE RANDALL HOUSE COMMENTARY AND OTHER NEW BOKS. REPORT RECEIVED.

FWB BIBLE COLLEGE REPORT GIVEN BY RONALD CREECH. HE ANNOUNCED A BACK TO BASICS CONFERENCE IN SEPTEMBER. THE COLLEGE FINISHED THE YEAR IN THE BLACK WITH THEIR BEST YEAR EVER FOR GIVING. BRO. CREECH ALSO DISCUSSED THE PROBLEM OF LOWER EN-ROLLMENT AND THE NEED FOR MORE STUDENTS. REPORT RECEIVED.

NATIONAL HOME MISSIONS REPORT GIVEN BY TRYMON MESSER. HE STATED THAT THERE WERE 59 MISSIONARY FAMILIES, WITH THE 4TH FAMILY GOING TO THE TARGET CITY OF PHOENIX, AZ. GREAT THINGS ARE HAPPENING IN MEXICO WITH 30 FWB CHURCHES THERE, ALL PASTORED BY NATIONALS. BRO. MESS' LSO DISCUSSED THE NEED OF MONEY TO BUY LAND FC NEW CHURCHES. REPORT RECEIVED.

SOUTHEASTERN FWB COLLEGE REPORT GIVEN BY JOE ANGE. HE REVIEWED ALL THE MIRACLES GOD DID FOR THEM TO GET ALL THEIR BUILDINGS ERECTED SINCE LAST JUNE AND STILL HAVE CLASSES WITH 179 STUDENTS. BRO. ANGE ALSO INFORMED THE GROUP ABOUT 2 NEW PROGRAMS – SECONDARY EDUCATION AND ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE FOR SECRETARIES AND COMPUTER OPERATORS. REPORT RECEIVED.

IN REFLECTING ON THE RESOLUTION OF LAST YEAR ON AIDS AND ITS ENCOURAGEMENT TO BE INFORMED AND INFORM OTHERS OF OUR CONGREGATION CONCERNING AIDS AND THE IMPLICATION OF THE SINFULNESS OF AIDS, WE RECOGNIZE ANOTHER ASPECT OF THE PROBLEM. THE STATISTICS OF THE FUTURE VICTIMS BY THE MID 1990'S ARE STAGGERING. WHEREAS: SOME HAVE ALREADY COME IN DIRECT CONTACT WITH VICTIMS (WHETHER THEY WERE INNOCENT OR OTHEWISE NOT WITHSTANDING, WE HAVE BECOME PAINFULLY AWARE OF THE POTENTIAL FOR THE PROBLEM OCCURRING IN OUR OWN CHURCH CONGREGATIONS AND IMMEDIATE COMMUNITIES. BE IT RESOLVED: THAT WE TAKE SPECIAL NOTE AND PRAYERFULNESS IN DEAL-ING WITH THESE ISSUES. GOD LOVES SINNERS, ALL SINNERS. MAY WE BE PREPARED IN OUR HEARTS, SOUL, AND SPIRIT, SHOULD THIS EXPERIENCE BE OURS.

CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE

WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE FREE WILL BAPTIST DENOMINA-TION BEING BAPTIZED UPON THE PROFESSION OF OUR FAITH IN CHRIST AND REALIZING THE NECESSITY OF A BOND OF UNION AND FELLOWSHIP AMONG US AS A STATE ASSOCIATION AND TO PRESERVE AND MAINTAIN CORRESPONDENCE AND CO-ORDINATION AMONG US,DO THEREFORE ADOPT THIS CONSTITUTION FOR OUR BETTER DENOMINATIONAL GOVERN-MENT.

1. THIS YEARLY MEETING SHALL BE CALLED "THE MARYLAND STATE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS" AND SHALL BE COMPOSED OF SUCH REGULARLY ORGANIZED AND WELL DISCIPLINED FREE WILL BAPTIST QUARTERLY MEETINGS CONVENIENTLY LOCATED AS MAY EMBODY THEM-SELVES UNDER THIS CONSTITUTION.

2. THE BUSINESS OF THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL BE CONDUCTED BY THE ORDAINED MINISTERS AND DEACONS AND ELECTED DELEGATES AND CLERKS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF A QUARTERLY MEETING WITHIN THIS ASSOCIATION. EACH QUARTERLY MEETING IS ENTITLED TO THREE DELEGATES FROM EACH CHURCH, IN ADDITIC TO THE ORDAINED PERSONNEL WHO ARE STANDING DELEGATES.

3. THE OFFICERS OF THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL BE ELECTED FOR A TERM OF THREE YEARS, EXCEPT THE MODERATOR AND ASSISTANT MODERATOR, WHICH SHALL BE ELECTED ANNUALLY AT THE CLOSE OF THE MEETING OF THIS ASSOCIATION.

4. ANY WELL-ORGANIZED FREE WILL BAPTIST QUARTERLY MEETING COMPOSED OF SUCH CHURCH AS CONFORM TO THE USAGES AND ADOPT THE DOCTRINES AND THE TREATISE OF THE CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THIS ASSOCIATION MAY AT ANY TIME, UPON APPLICATION AND BY MAJORITY VOTE OF THIS ASSOCIATION, BECOME A MEMBER THEREOF.

5. FROM THIS TIME (JUNE 1970) FORWARD, ANY MINISTER OR DEACON APPLYING FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THIS ASSOCIATION MUST FIRST MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS SET FORTH IN I TIMOTHY, CHAPTER 3 AND TITUS, CHAPTER 1. NO MINISTER OR DEACON SHALL HOLD MEMBERSHIP IN THIS ASSOCIATION IF HE OR HIS WIFE HAVE A LIVING COMPANION FROM A PREVIOUS MARRIAGE. 6. THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL HAVE AUTHORITY TO DISCIPLINE THE QUARTERLY MEETINGS OF WHICH IT IS COMPOSED AND EXCLUDE THEM FOR PRACTICES CONTRARY TO THE CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THIS ASSOCIATION.

7. THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL CONVENE ON FRIDAY MORNING AT 9 O'CLOCK BEFORE THE FOURTH SUNDAY IN JUNE AND SHALL HAVE POWER TO ADOPT ANY REGULATIONS OR BY-LAWS NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE FURTHER REGULATION OF ITS SESSIONS.

8. THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL NOT RECOGNIZE ANY MINISTER OR DELEGATE UNLESS THEY COMPLY WITH THE CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS THEREOF.

9. PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE WILL BE GOVERNED BY "ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER."

10. THE CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THIS ASSOCIATION MAY BE ALTERED OR AMENDED AT ANY REGULAR SESSION BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT, PROVIDING THE CHANGE HAS BEEN SUBMITTED IN WRITING, AND TABLED FROM ONE PREVIOUS ANNUAL SESSION.

THE MARYLAND STATE ASSOCIATION BY-LAWS

1. THE CLERK OR HIS ASSISTANT OR IN THEIR ABSENCE, THE SENIOR MINISTER IN YEARS SHALL CALL THE ASSOCIA-TION TO ORDER IF A QUORUM IS PRESENT. THE MODERATOR (OR IN HIS ABSENCE THE ASSISTANT MODERATOR) SHALL TAKE CHARGE. IF NEITHER IS PRESENT, A MODERATOR PRO TEM SHALL BE ELECTED.

2. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF THE SECRETARY TO ENROLL THE ORDAINED PERSONNEL AND DELEGATES TO THIS ASSOCIATION WHO SHALL SIGN THE REGISTER UPON ARRIVAL WITH NAME, ADDRESS, AND QUARTERLY MEETING THEY REPRESENT. VISITORS WILL ALSO BE REGISTERED.

3. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF EACH QUARTERLY MEET-ING BELONGING TO THIS ASSOCIATION TO SEND A LETTER TO EACH ANNUAL MEETING OF THIS ASSOCIATION REPORT-ING IN THE SAME ITS STATISTICS AND BENEVOLENT WORK. ANY QUARTERLY MEETING BELONGING TO THIS ASSOCIATION MAY BE DISMISSED FROM THE ASSOCIATION BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

4. EACH SESSION SHALL BE OPENED BY SCRIPTURE READING AND PRAYER AND SHALL BE CLOSED WITH PRAYER.

5. BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT, A RULING OF THE MODERATOR CAN BE OVERRULED.

6. THE MODERATOR SHALL HAVE THE SAME PRIVILEGES TO SPEAK AS ANY OTHER PERSON, PROVIDED THE CHAIR IS FILLED.

7. THIS ASSOCIATION MAY CORRESPOND BY LETTER OR OTHERWISE WITH OTHER RELIGIOUS BODIES.

8. THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL SIT WITH OPEN DOORS EXCEPT WHEN IT SHALL GO INTO A COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE.

9. ANY PERSON NOT A MEMBER OF THIS ASSOCIATION MAY BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PART IN DISCUSSION BY OBTAIN-ING PERMISSION FROM THE MODERATOR AND PROPERLY IDENTIFYING THEMSELVES.

10. ANYONE DESIRING TO SPEAK SHALL STAND AND ADDRESS THE MODERATOR BY THE APPELLATION "BROTHER MODERATOR" BUT SHALL NOT SPEAK FURTHER UNTIL RECOG-NIZED BY THE MODERATOR. 11. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF EACH MEMBER OF THE ASSOCIATION TO BE PRESENT AT THE TIME APPOINTED FOR EACH MEETING. ANYONE WISHING TO RETIRE SHOULD FIRST OBTAIN PERMISSION FROM THE MODERATOR.

12. THE MODERATOR OF THIS ASSOCIATION MUST BE AN ORDAINED MINISTER.

13. THE MODERATOR SHALL NOT ALLOW DISCUSSION WHEN NOT CARRIED ON IN A CHRISTIAN SPIRIT OR WHEN HE THINKS IT WILL CAUSE DISCORD OR DIVISION.

14. NO PERSON SHALL BE ALLOWED TO NOMINATE MORE THAN ONE MEMBER OF ANY COMMITTEE PROVIDED THE PERSON NOMINATED BE ELECTED.

15. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF THE MODERATOR TO SEAT DELEGATES IN A BODY IN A DESIGNATED SECTION AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH SESSION.

16. FIVE MEMBERS OR A MAJORITY OF THE RESIDENT MEMBERS PRESENT SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM IN CON-FERENCE. THE GENERAL BOARD OF THIS ASSOCIATION SHALL MEET AT 7:00 P.M. ON THURSDAY BEFORE THE REGULAR ANNUAL SESSION CONVENES ON FRIDAY MORNING, AND SHALL CON-SIST OF THE FOLLOWING: MODERATOR, CLERK, EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, ALSO TWO MEMBERS-AT-LARGE FROM EACH QUARTERLY MEETING AND THE CHAIRMAN OF ALL BOARDS AND COMMITTEES. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF ALL MEMBERS OF THIS BOARD TO BE PRESENT AT THE TIME APPOINTED FOR EACH MEETING. PROXY REPRESENTATION WILL BE ACCEPTED UPON PRESENTATION OF A STATEMENT SIGNED BY THE MEM-BER. ALL MEETINGS OF THIS BOARD SHALL CONVENE WITH OPEN DOORS EXCEPT WHEN RESOLVED INTO A COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE. ANY PERSON NOT A MEMBER OF THIS BOARD MAY BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PART IN THE DISCUSSIONS BY OBTAINING PERMISSION FROM THE MODERATOR.

DISSOLUTION

IN THE EVENT OF THE DISSOLUTION OF THE MARYLAND STATE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTISTS, ANY ASSETS OF THE ORGANIZATION THEN REMAINING SHALL BE CONVEYED TO SUCH ORGANIZATIONS THEN EXISTENT DEDICATED TO SIMILAR OBJECTIVES TO THOSE OF THIS ORGANIZATION, SELECTED BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AT THE TIME OF DIS-SOLUTION, WHICH ORGANIZATION MUST BE EXEMPT UNDER SECTION 501 [E] (3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 AS AMENDED OR UNDER SUCCESSOR PROVISIONS OF THE CODE AS MAY BE IN EFFECT AT THE TIME OF DISSOLUTION.
