Minutes of Meeting April 14, 1984

Mission District Association convened with Northcrest Free Will Baptist Church on April 14, 1984.

The meeting was opened with congregational singing, lead by Bro. Crosby. Opening prayer was offered by Bro. Teel.

Bro. Davis extended a welcome from their church. Bro. McKinley gave a very timely devotion using Acts 4:29-33 as his text. Bro. McKinley spoke on our need for boldness, Oneness in our relationship, and a Unity of Spirit and love with each other and God.

The conference was called to order by the moderator, Bro. Bobby Joe Davis. Bro. Marvin Lehr read the constitution and by-laws.

A partial report of the Credential Committee was given. Three churches was represented by letters and dues.

The moderator read a letter from Bro. Ken Marker. Bro. Marker informed the Mission District that as of 2-18-84, Glory FWB Mission would become inactive because of health reasons, and lack of finances. However Glory Mission will not be dissolved. He asked that we, as a district, pray for him and Sis. Marker.

The delegates names was read and all delegates was seated.

The minutes of the previous meetings was read and approved.

The treasurers report was read and approved.

The moderator appointed the Resolutions committee. Bro. Ken Marker to chair, with Sister Crosby and Bro. Vaughn to serve with him.

The moderator appointed a nominating committee. Bro. Teel to chair, with Sister Asensie and Bro. Lehr to serve with him.

Bro. Teel gave the Christian Education Board report. There was 58 persons present for the Mission Conferences held in Feb. 1984.

Bro. Lehr gave the Home Mission Board report.

There was a discussion on the feasibility of another Mission Conference next year. Everyone approved this idea as the last one was enjoyed so much.

After the morning recess the worship hour was began with congregational singing. Bro. Walker was the noining speaker. He gave a report on the State Work before beginning his message. The State Office is operating in the

black again. This was accomplished by cutting some travel, and by typing and reading the State Meeting minutes before they went to the printer. The minutes should be mailed to all churches by the end of April. He also reported on building programs going on in Texas. And the way God is blessing Texas FWB. The Book Store, because of lack of needed friends, will be payed out of the State Work. He said by our State Meeting in June all debts will be paid. Bro. Walker reminded us of the State Meeting, to be held June 7-9 at First FWB Church of Dallas, located in Duncanville, Texas, The National Association Meeting July 15-19 at Riltle Rock, Arkansas and Old Fashion Camp Meeting in August 13-17. Bro. Ron Parker has gotten moved to Tyler and is holding week-night meetings in his home.

Bro. Walker brought a very inspiring message using II. Cor. 5:14 & 15.

After a delicious lunch our Association Moderator, Bro. Teel called the session to order. Bro. Vaughn offered the opening prayer. Bro. Lindley lead in congregational singing. Bro. & Sis. Hyatt sang a very beautiful special.

Business resumed with the Resolution Committee report. A motion was made to accept the report and vote on it item by item. A second was made by Bro. Lehr.

Resolution #1. Whereas Youth Rallies are no longer held and \$110.56 remains in the youth account, be it resolved that the entire \$110.56 be allotted to the Christian Education Board for Youth Activities. Resolution carried.

Resolution #2. Be it resolved we give Northcrest Church a rising vote of thanks for a wonderful meal and hospitality as host church. Resolution carried.

The nominating committee gave their report. Bro. Teel made the motion the report be accepted, with a second by Bro. Lehr. Motion Carried.

The nominating committee report read as follows:

We, the nominating committee, nominate Gerald Vaughn to serve out the unexpired term of Glen Vaughn on the Mission District Home Mission Board. Bro. Teel made the motion that Bro. Gerald be elected, with a second from Bro. Lehr. Motion carried.

The Credential Committee gave their final report as follows:

I. We recommend that we receive Bro. George Hyatt into the full fellowship of the Mission District Association, pending the receipt of a letter of recommendation from the Midessa District Association.

II. We find Bro. Frank McKinley sound in doctrine and sincere in his desire for the ministry, but refer him back to the body to decide re his licensure in view of his previous marriage, in that the board was dead locked over this issue.

A motion and second was made to accept Resolution #1. Motion carried.

A motion and second was made on Resolution #2. Motion carried.

A vote of the church body was taken, with a 9-2 vote in favor of Bro. McKinley being licensed to preach by the district.

A motion and second was made giving the Association Moderator the authority to appoint delegates at the state meeting, and for two men to set on the General Board from your District.

The next semi-annual meeting is to be held at Christ's FWB Church in October 1984.

A motion and second was made to adjourn. Motion carried.
