Minutes of Quarterly Meeting of January 21, 1989

Mission District Association of Free Will Baptists met with Northcrest Free Will Baptist Church on Saturday, January 21, 1989. The meeting began at 9:50 with John Davis leading the singing and Bro. Bobby Ferguson leading the opening prayer. Two churches were represented and this was a quorum; so the moderator declared the meeting in session and proceeded to seat the delegates. The standing delegates were first recognized and then the names from the church letters and all were charged with their responsibilities. The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the clerk, followed by the treasurer's report; both reports were accepted as read. The moderator appointed the following persons to serve as a Resolutions Committee: John Davis, chm., Elaine Martin, and Gaylon Vaughn. Sister Elaine Martin said that there was nothing to report from the Christian Education Board but that there was \$602.56 in the treasury. John Davis, reporting for the Mission District Home Missions Bd., said that there was about \$1,050.00 in their treasury. Bro. Bobby Ferguson, reporting on State business, said that most of the plans for the State meeting had been finalized. The meeting will be in McAllen on June 14, 15, and 16, and the La Quinta Motel will be the headquarters. Fellowship time came next with the moderator leading in prayer.

The worship hour began at 11:00 with more singing led by John Davis and prayer by Bro. Gaylon Vaughn. A worship offering of \$17.00 was received. The special music for the worship hour was a beautiful duet, "Sheltered in the Arms of God," sung by Marilyn and Michelle Wilson. Bro. Herbert Richards, who was the speaker for the day, began his message with a beautiful tribute to his wife, Margaret, in honor of their forty-ninth wedding anniversary. Bro. Richards chose Acts 11:26b for his scripture reference and titled his message "So You're A Christian". He said that we have lost sight of what God expects of us; and that if we want to be called Christians, we must demonstrate the characteristics of Christ: Love, Concern, Forgiveness, Purity, and Unwavering dedication. The closing prayer for the morning session and the blessing on the food was prayed by Bro. Roy Wilson.

After a delicious lunch, the afternoon session began with more singing and prayer. The afternoon devotional was brought by Bro. Kenneth Marker of San Antonio who emphasized the joy and happiness we experience in Christ.

The business session began with the report from the Resolutions Committee which was read by John Davis. There were only two items for consideration; Item #1: Be it resolved that we give a love offering of \$75.00 to Bro. and Sister Richards. Motion to adopt made by Bro. Vaughn; motion carried. Item #2: Be it resolved that we give the host church a rising vote of thanks for the delicious meal and their hospitality. Motion carried with all standing to show their appreciation.

There was no old business but there was one item of new business listed on the Northcrest Church letter. This request reads as follows: We recommend that we consider realigning with Central Texas District Association of Free Will Baptists. There was lots of discussion on this matter; Bro. Bobby Ferguson, speaking for Central Texas District, said that there might be advantages to this. Those who opposed were concerned about the distance to be traveled in attending meeting. The moderator asked that this request be put into a motion so that it could be entered into the minutes; motion was made by Bro. Gaylon Vaughn. Since this involves a constitutional change, motion to table was made by Sister Elaine Martin; motion carried. Another motion was made by John Davis that any communication necessary for this transition be handled by the Executive Committee; motion carried. Other items: The Mission District Home Missions Bd. will make a recommendation at the next quarterly meeting on how to use the \$300.00

It was announced that the Free Will Baptist Church at Tyler had held their organizational meeting. Further information--the next quarterly meeting of Mission District will be at Zion Church on April 22, 1989. There was no further business; motion to adjourn was made by Sister Martin, with all standing for the closing prayer.

Mission District Association quarterly meeting began at 9:50 with John Davis leading the singing and Bro. Gaylon Vaughn leading the opening prayer. Mrs. Becky Touchet of the host church extended a gracious welcome to the meeting. Bro. Bobby Joe Davis, moderator, called the meeting to order. Seating of the delegates was the first order of business; standing delegates were first recognized and then the appointed delegates; they were charged with their responsibilities and seated. Next, the minutes were read and approved, followed by the treasurer's report; this, too, was approved as read. The following persons were appointed to serve as a Resolutions Committee: Bro. Gaylon Vaughn, chm., Bro. A.C. Stuart, and Sis. Dee Asencio. Sis. Elaine Martin, speaking for the Christian Education Bd., said that she had nothing to report but that there was \$691.62 in their treasury. Andy Davis, who had visited Free Will Baptist Bible College on April 6, 7 and 8th, was asked to give his impressions of the school. Andy said that he was much impressed with the facilities, the food, and was looking forward to attending this next semester. John Davis, reporting for the Mission District Home Missions Bd., said that there was about \$1,090.00 in their treasury. Bro. Roy Wilson, speaking for the Texas State Home Missions Bd. said that they were still looking for land in San Antonio but that it was very expensive; also the Board would be meeting in Corsicana on Monday, April 24, and would be discussing this further. They also plan on presenting guidelines for new churches at the State Meeting in June.

A time of fellowship was enjoyed next, with Bro. Frank McKinley leading in prayer. The worship hour began with more singing led by John Davis; John also led in prayer. The special music was a real delight; a trio composed of Dee Asencio on the violin, Joanna Davis on the flute, and Mrs. Gerald Vaughn at the piano played "Mansion Over the Hilltop". An offering of \$31.42 was received with Andy Davis leading the offertory prayer. Bro. Bobby Joe Davis brought a very good message on the seven churches from Revelations. He spoke on the characteristics of each church, noting that we, too, had lost our zeal and had become lukewarm, and desperately need to be on fire for the Lord. The dismissal prayer for the morning session and the blessing on the food was led by Sister Bell.

After a very good lunch and time of fellowship, the afternoon session began at 1:15 with more singing and prayer by Bro. Wilson. Bro. Roy also brought the afternoon devotional using 2Chronicles 7:11-14 as his text. Bro. Roy noted that the church was built according to God's blueprint but is really not a church until God is in it.

The business session began with the report of the Resolutions Committee read by Bro. Gaylon. Item #1: Be it resolved that we give \$100.00 to the Dwain Crosby fund. Motion to adopt was made by Sis. Elaine Martin; motion carried. Item #2: Be it resolved that we give the host church a rising vote of thanks for the delicious lunch and their hospitality. Motion was approved by all standing. Old business: There was one item of business that had been tabled at the previous meeting. A motion to remove this item from the table and act upon it was made by Sis. Martin; motion carried. This item of business reads as follows: We recommend that we consider realigning with Central Texas District Association of Free Will Baptists. After discussion, the motion was defeated with five voting for the proposal and eight voting opposed.

The next District meeting will be held at Christ's Church on August 12. There was no further business to be attended to; motion to adjourn was made by Andy Davis with Becky Touchet leading the closing prayer.

Mission District Association quarterly meeting began at 10:00 with Bro. Gaylon Vaughn leading the singing and Sister Bell leading the opening prayer. A welcome to the congregation was extended by Andy Davis. The conference was called to order by the moderator, Bro. Bobby Joe Davis. The standing delegates were first recognized and then the names of elected delegates were read and a motion was made by Barrie Sue Davis that all delegates be seated; motion carried. Committees for this meeting were then appointed by the assistant moderator, Bro. Roy Wilson. Serving on the Resolutions Committee were: Sisters Pat Vaughn, chairman; and Dorothy McKinley and Dee Asencio. Those appointed for the Nominating Committee were: Gaylon Vaughn, chairman, and John Davis and Dee Asencio. The minutes of the previous meeting and the treasurer's report were read and approved as read. The Christian Ed. Board reported \$716.31 in their treasury. John Davis was not present to give a report from the Home Missions Bd. at the morning session. The session then recessed for fellowship time.

Also, plans for the New Church Club were presented; this will begin on the second Sunday in September.

The worship hour began at 11:00 with Bro. Gaylon leading the singing. A worship offering of 11.25 was received with Andy Davis leading the offeratory prayer. The special music was a very beautiful duet by Marilyn and Michelle Wilson who sang an old favorite, "It Is No Secret What God Can Do". Bro. Roy Wilson was the speaker for the day and he preached a powerful message using Romans 12:1,2 as his text. He reminded us that Paul was speaking to believers in this portion of scripture and urged that we yield ourselves to the Lord's cause and not let the world squeeze us into it's mold. The dismissal prayer for the morning session and the blessing on the food was prayed by Bro. Bobby Joe Davis.

The afternoon session began at 1:15 with prayer by Bro. Gaylon Vaughn. Bro. Gaylon gave a very good devotional on the abundant life, using Romans 6:10 as his scripture reference. We were exhorted to be positive in our thinking, always expecting a blessing.

The business portion of our meeting began with the report of the Resolutions Committee read by Sister Pat Vaughn, who made a motion that the report be accepted and acted upon item by item; motion carried. Item #1: Be it resolved that we send \$50.00 to the Dwain Crosby account. Motion to adopt was made by Sister McKinley; motion carried. Item #2: Be it resolved that we give \$20.00 to the Texas State Home Missions new church project. Motion to adopt made by Sister Pat Vaughn; motion carried. Item #3: Be it resolved that we give the host church a rising vote of thanks for the delicious food and good fellowship; motion carried by all standing. John Davis talked about the \$300.00 floating fund but it was decided to hold off on any decision recommendation for its use until we see what happens to Christ's Church in Corpus Christi. There was no further business to be discussed; the next meeting will be at Zion Church on October 21st. Motion to adjourn was made by Marilyn Wilson with everyone standing for the closing prayer by Bro. Roy Wilson.

Mission District Association quarterly meeting began at 9:55 with Bro. John Davis leading the singin g and Bro. Roy Wilson leading the opening prayer. Sister Elaine Martin of the host church extended a welcome to the assembly; the response was given by the moderator, Bro. Bobby Joe Davis, who then expressed his thoughts for this meeting. Bro. Davis said that each of us has the responsibility of witnessing and that we should be missionaried wherever we are.

The standing delegates were first recognized; then the names of the appointed delegates from each church were read and all were seated and charged with their responsibilities for this meeting. Visitors to the meeting were introduced and welcomed. The clerk was asked to read the minutes of the previous meeting and the treasurer's report; both reports were approved as read. The assistant moderator asked the following people to serve on committees: Resolutions Committee--Bro. John Davis, chm., sisters Dee Asencio, and Barrie Sue Davis. It was determined we would not need an obituary committee. Sister Elaine Martin reported that there was \$743.92 in the C.E. Board fund and Bro. John Davis said that there was about \$1300.00 in the Home Missions Bd. treasury. Sister Dorothy McKinley was asked for an update on Christ's Church; she said that they were still seeking a new pastor; and that the church would have a new name. Bro. Bill Jones, newly elected state mpderator, spoke briefly on the Texas state work and said that Bro. Dale Smith would be the new editor of the Texas "Challenge". Next came fellowship time with Sister Marilyn Wilson dismissing in prayer.

The worship hour began at 11:00 with more congregational singing and prayer led by Bro. John Davis. A worship offering of \$28.01 was received/. The special music was a beautiful violin solo by Sister Dee, accompanied by Alatheia McKinley on the piano. They played "The Regions Beyond". Bro. Jimmy Aldridge, who was our speaker for the day, was introduced by Bro. Roy Wilson. Bro. Aldridge, who was a foreign missionary for many years, spoke on the accomplishments of our missionary work ; he said that we have 78 organized churches overseas and that 678 souls were saved last year. Bro. Aldridge preached a very challenging message reminding us that we must believe in Jesus' power to save the worst sinners in the world if we are to be effective witnesses. The dismissal prayer for the morning session and the blessing on the food was prayed by Bro. Bill Jones.

The afternoon session began with more singing followed with prayer led by Bro. Davis. Sister Pat Vaughn brought a very timely message on stress. She said that God has an answer for this and read scriptures from Iasaih 41 and 1 Peter, chapter 5, also Matthew 11 and John 14.

The business session began with the report from the Resolutions Committee read by Sister Barrie Davis, who made a motion that the report be accepted and acted upon item by item; motion carried. Item #1: Be it resolved that we send \$100.00 to the Dwain Crosby account. Motion to adopt was made by Barrie; motion carried. Item #2: Be it resolved that we give the host church a rising vote of thanks to show our appreciation for the delicious lunch and their hospitality. Motion carried by all standing. Next came the report of the Nominating Committee, read by Bro. Gaylon Vaughn, who moved its acceptance ; motion carried. The following persons were elected to serve as officers of our association: Moderator, Bro. Roy Wilson; ass't. moderator, Bro. B.J. Davis; Clerk-treasurer, Sister Barrie Sue Davis; ass't. clerk-treasurer, Gay Davis; Parlimentarian, Bro. John Davis. Sister Gilberta Bell was elected to serve on the Mission District Home Missions Board; Sister Marilyn Wilson was reelected to serve on the Christian Education Bd.; and Bro. Roy Wilson and Bro. Gaylon Vaughn were elected to the Credentials Board.
