Voted, To offer the Stevens Donation to the Aurora Church, in case they will build this fall, on same conditions.

Voted, To request our Chairman to go East this summer, or fall, to elicit interest in Nebraska Mission, and to secure funds for church building and to help support Bro. Knapp.

Voted, That G. W. Knapp and A. D. Williams prepare a Program for exercises for the next Yearly Meeting.

Voted, That G. W. Knapp be appointed to visit Aurora and Central City works until Yearly Meeting.
