The Chairman ^{reported} that the Congregationalists, through Rev. Lewis Gregory offered \$450.00 for the Courtland house, and might give \$500.00.

Voted to authorize the Chairman to sell the Courtland house to the Congregationalists, or other for \$600.00

Voted that in case the Courtland house is sold or in case otherwise the \$100 can be raised, the Chairman is hereby authorized to purchase the old Congregationalist church building in Lincoln at \$500, in the latter case \$100 to be paid down, and the rest in time.

Voted that whereas W. H. Edger has failed and refused to act as a member of the Executive Committee, his place is therefore, hereby declared vacant, and Hor. B. F. Cannon is elected to fill the vacancy thereby created.

Voted that the Chairman be authorized to arrange for a Minister's Institute in connection with the next Yearly Meeting to commence the Monday evening before.

Adjourned to the call of the Chorus.

The Executive Committee of the Neb. Yearly Meeting of Free Will Baptists met at the call of the Chairman at the house of E. W. Sisco. Present C. Root, A. D. Williams, and E. W. Knapp. Adjourned till Monday, Apr. 26 1886 at Lancaster Co. Sheriff's office.

Met according to adjournment at Sheriff's office Apr. 26 1886. Present A. D. Williams, C. Root & E. W. Knapp.

Voted to ratify and adopt the action of the Chairman in purchasing a lot in Lincoln, Neb. corner of 16th and R. St. for church purposes for \$2,500.

Voted to authorize and direct the Chairman to solicit, collect, and disburse funds for the erection of a church on said lot, no debt to be made beyond subscriptions, and amount reasonably certain to come in in a short time that is, make no permanent debt.

Voted to authorize and direct the Chairman to secure plans and specifications for the above ~~named~~ church, and superintend the work on the same.

Voted to approve and adopt the sale of the Courthand house and lot to the congregationists for \$600, \$200. to be paid down, and \$400 in one year.

Voted that when received by the Board, all deeds and other legal papers be signed for, and in behalf of the Executive Comt., the Chairman Secretary and Treasurer.

Voted that \$10. of the next money received from the H. M. Branch be paid to Rev. J. Masters, for Evangelistic work, \$5. to A. J. D. Fry, and \$20. to Rev. Joseph Westley, for the same.

Voted that the rest of the money heretofore appropriated by the H. M. to us, be used for the benefit of the Lincoln lot and house.

Voted to approve the appointment of Rev. C. Stair to the Jefferson Co. Circuit.

Voted to pay the expenses of Father Root and Bro. Knapp in attending the present and last session of the Executive Com. \$4. to former, and \$6.75 to the latter.

Voted to locate the next session of the Y. M. C. at Lincoln, provided the chairman can make the necessary arrangements.

Voted that G. W. Knapp visit the Central City church and kindly inform them that the vote to give them a letter for the Aurora Q. M. cannot be regarded as legal, on the ground that no person is brought a right to vote on his is it our care to invite and persuade them to resume their place in the Q. M.
Adjourned to the call of the Chair.
