The Ex-Comm. of the Neb. Jr. M. met at Lincoln, in Room of Brother O. E. Baker - Oct. 24 - 1896.

It was called expressly to take into consideration the matter of accepting any of the several propositions of land, for a Free Will Baptist College at Lincoln. The following business was transacted

1. Resolved, That we deem it possible to build & conduct a college in Neb.
2. That, — In view of the several propositions of land for a college we deem it best to secure definite propositions of land; And a conditional canvass of our people in Neb. & Kans. for the sale of lots, at appraised value to be from \$200. to \$400. per lot.
3. Resolved — That we ask Br. C. W. Okey, of Wheeler, Kans. to canvass the churches of Kans. for sale of lots.
4. That we employ Br. Bouché to canvass in Neb. & that we pay expense of travel & \$200. per day.
5. That we approve the plan of asking, in sale of lots 1/4 - 1/3, 1/2 to advance, with notes running three to five years, on interest, secured on the lot, ^{by mortgage} or some other way.

It was understood, that the said agents were going into their canvass, until some definite understanding is reached concerning the land, — & until getting advice from abroad.

The Executive Committee of the Nebraska Yearly Meeting, Free Baptist met at the Lincoln Free Baptist Church, at the above date, in the interest of the said Church pursuant to the call of the Secretary. After hearing the facts in the case from the members of the Lincoln Church touching the necessity of repairs to the Church the Ex. Committee voted unanimously — E. Post, O. E. Baker, R. W. Boies & G. W. Knapp present, — that we propose to the said Lincoln Church, that we will loan in their behalf, a sum of \$400. (four hundred dollars) ^{Securing the loan by mortgage on the ch.} provided they raise besides, a sum of \$200 (two hundred dollars) or more for some purpose.
