The board proceeded to the election of a member of the Ex. Committee to fill vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Rev. H. R. Murphy; when Bro. James Bortner was elected.

Dated that an Order be drawn upon the Treas. for \$35.50 in favor of J. S. Dinsmore for balance due him on expenses as Chairman for the year just closed.

Voted that we adjourn.

Dec, 28th 1894 The Executive Committee met at the Free Baptist Church, on the above date, in response to a call by the Chairman. Present, J. H. Reeves, J. S. Dinsmore, A. A. Taylor and B. F. Tremore. Meeting was called to order by J. H. Reeves Chairman. The object of the meeting was stated to be for the purpose of meeting Rev. H. M. Ford, Field Sect, of the Conference Board of North America.

Sect. Ford being called upon, responding gave a very instructive explanation of the proposed plan of work contemplated; which was in part the object of his visit. After a full and free exchange of opinion, Voted unanimously that we approve of the plans of the Conference Board in the making of an appropriation of \$140. to this Yearly Meeting for mission purposes for the present year; and that we will do the best we can to meet the demand upon us. Adjourned to One Thirty P. M.

Met at One Thirty P. M. as per adjournment.
Prayer by Rev. H. M. Ford. All members present as before.

Noted that, we as a Board will, at once proceed to make the apportionment to the Churches of this Y. M.

Noted that, the Clerk and Treasurer, be a Com. to fix the apportionment to the several Churches; and that, the Pastors or Church officers be notified at once.

Bro. Ford here gave an explanation as to the Four General Mission days collection.

Noted that, we pledge ourselves faithfully attempt to carry out the plan of Genl. Conference!

Noted that, we approve of and recommend that, the Churches all adopt and as far as possible, the Card System for raising money for Mission work.

Noted that, The Executive Committee of this Y. M. Respectfully recommend Rev. J. H. Reeve for district Agent Neb. & Kansas Yearly Meetings should one be appointed; and that we recommend him to our Kansas brethren.

No further business appearing; Voted to adjourn.
