Aug. 13th 1898

The new Board (Ex. Com) met in Regular session at the Parsonage at Long Branch, at 2 O'clock P. M.

A request of J. S. Dinsmore to be made missionary of the Y. M. without pay was refused, by the Com.

Voted; that we place the matter of the Geneva Church debt in the hands of the Chairman of this Com. for investigation and that he be requested to convey to the Conference Board our desire for an extension of time as to the claim.

No assignments for workers was made, No plans for work were recommended. Nor system for raising funds were endorsed or recommended.
