9th Moved & Carried that resolution of thanks from the Lincoln Church for appropriation of \$200.⁰⁰ to clear the church's debt be entered on the books, as follows:-

Greeting:-

Whereas, the Lincoln Church having been greatly embarrassed for several years on account of the remaining indebtedness incurred at the time their church building was enlarged and repaired, and long since due, and

Whereas, Your Board having recently come to the financial aid of the said Lincoln church, by very generously appropriating the necessary amount of funds to relieve it of its long standing and pressing liabilities, therefore,

Resolved; By the said Lincoln church, now in session at its regular monthly covenant and business meeting, that the hearty thanks of this society be hereby extended to your honorable Board for your timely and liberal contribution, made so generously for the purpose of cancelling the mortgage on the church property and thereby relieving us from our pressing financial obligations, so long past due.

Resolved; That we also hereby express our hearty appreciation of the Christian spirit, and brotherly interest which has been manifested by your Board in this generous act, whereby the Lincoln church has been placed on a surer foundation; even that, let us trust, "of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone"; and also given new hopes, greater courage, and a promise of stability and constancy in the work of the Lord in this place.
