5th That we give time & place during Yearly Meeting to definite Bible work

6th That the S. M. Clerk procure a "letter file" and that all papers, Reports etc be preserved for future reference

7th That so far as possible we aid financially all weaker interests and especially by our prayers and personal interest

8th That we appropriate \$200.⁰⁰ Towards supporting a pastor at Lincoln.

9th That a sum equal to 25^c per resident member be raised in each church to aid in state work and that this be raised early in the year each ch. taking its own method for raising the same

10th That we solicit pledges to carry on our work in the state

11th That since General Conference Board has made an appropriation of \$250.⁰⁰ for evangelistic work in Kansas and
over

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Nebraska, we are still desirous of uniting with Kansas under a co-operative evangelistic plan or what ever plan may be settled upon at a joint session of the three Yearly Meeting Boards or their representatives for putting a man in the field. And for this purpose we pledge to raise our share of his support not to exceed \$150.00
