3. That we still adhere to our last year's recommendation with reference to preparing pamphlets with Kansas on the following subjects "The needs in Kansas & Neb." "The Open doors in the West" "Obligations to State Board, Yearly Meeting and General Conference, and "A birdseye view of Kansas & Nebraska" covering names of Churches and short history, values of church property - Pastors etc.

- 4th That on State Day and special occasions we flood our churches with this printed matter.
- 5th That we give time and place during the year to definite Biblical work.
- 6th That the Yearly meeting clerks procure a letter file and that all papers, reports etc. be kept for future reference.
- 7th That as far as possible we aid financially all weaker interests, and especially by our prayers and personal interest.
- 8th That we appropriate \$200 towards supporting a pastor at Lincoln.
- 9th That a sum equal to 25¢ per resident member be raised in each church to aid in State work and that this be raised early in the year, each church taking its own method in collecting same.
- 10th. That we solicit pledges to carry on work in our State.
- Here it was voted that the matter of pledge be left in Gen. Chairmans hands.
- Voted also to give him the present time to raise solicit same.
- One hundred & fifteen Dollars raised.
- 11th Since Gen. Board has made an appropriation of \$250.00 for Evangelistic work for Kansas and Nebraska, we are still desirous of uniting with Kansas under a cooperative evangelistic plan or what ever plan may be settled upon at a joint session of the three yearly meeting Boards or their representatives; And to put a man into the field and for this purpose we pledge to raise our share of his support not to exceed \$150.00.
