Elected speaker, Rev. E. J. Ramey read Mark 16th chapter, 15th verse. Text was, GO YE. Invitation songled by Bro. Harold.

Floor turned over to our moderator, and the Bartley Trio sang again.

Floor turned over to Rev. S. J. Bates. Rev. Lester Coffman asked the blessing on the noon meal.

RESOLUTIONS OF THE NEW HOPE ASSOCIATION

- No church shall be admitted to this Association until it has been thoroughly investigated by two-thirds majority of the Presbytery Board and recommended to be received in the Association by the elected Board.
- 2. All ministers wishing to take membership with this Association will meet with this Presbytery Board. They will submit their credentials for their examination. Those ministers coming from other denominations other than Free Will Baptist will be placed under a six month proving period, and at the expiration of the six months they will be granted credentials identifying themselves with Free Will Baptists.
- 3. This Association will not ordain any person that has two living wives and will not ordain women for the Ministry.
- 4. This Association will not recognize any accusation about their brother or about their sister in the setting of any Conference unless charges are properly submitted to the Presbytery Board and to the Moderator in written form and investigation is made by the Presbytery Board.
- 5. All newly called Ministers wishing to secure license from this Association must be recommended by the local church. He is to serve one year of proving period and is to be examined by the Presbytery Board on the disciplinant of Faith of the Free Will Baptists. After having served one year, their license will be recommended by the church that he is affiliated with for ordination.
- 6. This Association shall not recognize any group of people having left their church out of fellowship until they have reconciled themselves with the said church that they separated themselves from, and report has been made to this Association from the church which they left. This report is to be given by the ordained authority of said church.

(These six resolutions were all introduced by Rev. E. J. Ramey)

CONSTITUTION OF THE NEW HOPE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTIST OF MICHIGAN AND OHIO

- This quarterly meeting shall be called the NEW HOPE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTIST OF MICHIGAN AND OHIO and shall be composed of such consistent, well regulated FREE WILL BAPTIST CHURCHES as shall unite in this compact and agree to this Constitution.
- 2. The acting members of this conference of this quarterly meeting shall be such as are chosen by the several churches of which the quarterly meeting is composed, to represent them in quarterly meeting conference; every church being entitled to one delegate, every church containing fifty members to two delegates, and one additional delegate for every additional twenty-five members.
- The officers of this quarterly meeting shall be a moderator, who shall be elected at the close of the annual session, a clerk and a treasurer who shall be standing officers of the quarterly meeting; all of whom shall perform such duties as usually devolve upon such officers.
- 4. Any regular organized Free Will Baptist Church maintaining Gospel order, agreeing with the denomination in doctrines and practices, and in favor of the benevolent enterprises as Sunday Schools, Missions, temperance, and education may be received into this quarterly meeting on application by a vote of the conference. Subject to the examination by the Presbytery Board.
- 5. This quarterly meeting shall have power to discipline its churches for unchristian conduct, a want of conformity to Gospel order, of a violation of the conditions of this compact, and expel them in case of unsuccessful labor, to license and ordain ministers, such as give evidence of being qualified and called of God, by request of churches to which such persons belong, to settle such questions of discipline and doctrine as the churches may refer to it, and transact such other business as may be necessary for the benefit of religion, consistent with the liberty and independence of the churches according to the practices of the Free Will Baptist denomination, and not repugnant to the regulations of the Yearly Meeting or Association with which this Quarterly Meeting may be connected, and to make any by-laws necessary to its regulation, not repugnant to this Constitution. Said charges to be brought in writing to the Presbytery and majority of Board agree with said charges before brought before conference body.
- 6. This Constitution may be altered or amended by a vote of any session of the quarterly meeting, notice of such intended alterations having been given in writing to the Business Board at the last regular session of the conference.

STANDING RULES OF THE NEW HOPE ASSOCIATION OF FREE WILL BAPTIST OF MICHIGAN AND OHIO

1. Each meeting of this association shall be opened by reading a portion of the Bible and with prayer and shall be closed with prayer.

 Each session of the association shall be called into conference by the Moderator or Assistant Moderator, or in their absence the senior minister in years; and if a quorum is present the moderator shall seat the delegates and have a prayer of consecration.

Amendment:

If the oldest minister declines to act as Moderator in case of absence of both Moderator and Assistant Moderator, the next oldest minister would act as Moderator.

- 3. All meetings of these bodies shall convene with open doors except when resolved into committees of the whole.
- Any person not a member of these bodies may be allowed to take part in the discussions by obtaining permission from the Moderator.
- It shall be the duty of all members of these bodies to be present at the time appointed for each meeting and anyone wishing to retire shall first obtain permission of the Moderator.
- 6. The Moderator shall not allow discussions carried on in a spirit which is not christian or orderly.
- 7. No member shall be allowed to speak more than ten minutes or more than twice on the same subject, without permission of the Moderator.
- At sessions of the New Hope Association the Moderator shall seat delegates in a body in a designated section of the assembly room at the beginning of each session.
- 9. At any meeting of the Business Board a member may have his dissenting vote recorded in the minutes by his request.
- 10. These standing rules may be amended or altered at any regular session of the New Hope Association by a majority vote of the members present provided the amendment of alteration be presented in writing to the Business Board one setting in advance or three months in advance.
- 11. A quorum shall consist of two churches for a regular conference meeting.

The Moderator shall appoint at each session a pulpit Committee and a next session Committee for that one session only.

CHURCH COVENANT.

Having given ourselves to God, by faith in Christ, and adopted the Word of God as our rule of faith and practice, we now give ourselves to one another by the will of God in this solemn covenant.

We promise, by His grace, to love and obey Him in all things, to avoid all appearance of evil, to abstain from all sinful amusements and unholy conformity to the world, from all sanction of the use and sale of intoxicating beverages, and to "provide things honest in the sight of all men."

We agree faithfully to discharge our obligations in reference to the study of the Scriptures, secret prayer, family devotions, and social worship; and by self-denial, faith, and good works endeavor to "grow in grace and the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ."

We will not forsake the assembling of ourselves together for church conference, public worship, and the observance of the ordinances of the Gospel; nor fail to pay according to our ability for the support of the church, of its poor, and all its benevolent work.

We agree to accept Christian admonition and reproof with meekness, and to watch over one another in love, endeavoring to "keep the unity of the Spirit" in the bonds of peace. To be careful of one another's happiness and reputation, and seek to strengthen the weak, encourage the afflicted, admonish the erring, and as far as we are able, promote the success of the church and of the Gospel.

We will everywhere hold Christian principle sacred and Christian obligations and enterprises supreme; counting it our chief business in life to extend the influence of Christ in society, constantly praying and toiling that the Kingdom of God may come, and His will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

To this end we agree to labor for the promotion of educational and denominational enterprises, the support of missions, the success of Sunday schools, and evangelistic efforts for the salvation of the world. And may the God of peace sanctify us wholly, and preserve us blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
