At the request of New Home and Robinson's Chapel Free Will Baptist Churches, and organizing Council from Tug River Conference of Free Will Baptist, met at New Home Church on Dec. 5, 1936, for the purpose of organizing a new Conference. This Council was composed of the following.

Rev. J. T. Weavoir, Moderator

Rev. J. B. Wheeler, Rev. A. H. Langdon

Rev. G. S. Sexton & Rev. J. M. Young.

D.B. Sturgill was elected Clerk for the council.

The delegates and reports of the Churches to be organized into a conference were then called for. New Home Church responded and reported 22 members including four ordained ministers and two deacons with Rev. W. B. Sturgill, Pastor. The ministers being Rev. W. B. Sturgill, Rev. B. H. Williams, Rev. W. C. Childers, and Rev. J. M. Young.

Robinson's Chapel responded and reported thirteen members including three deacons. Rev. W. C. Childers, Pastor.

It was then moved & carried that the council accept the churches and proceed with the organization, and the hand of fellowship was given the Pastors.

The prayer of consecration was made by Rev. A. H. Langdon J. B. Wheeler

The charge was delivered
by Rev J.M. Young.
The Bible was presented
by Rev A.H. Ladd doz.
The moderator then declared
the new Conference duly organized.
Rev J.M. Young was then
elected moderator of the new
conference, Bro D.B. Sturgill
was elected clerk and Rev.
W.B. Sturgill was elected treasurer.
An executive board was
elected as follows, Rev W.C. Childers
Chm. for 3 years, Rev B.H. Williamson
for 2 years, and Bro Green Billings
(Cocow) for 1 year.
It was then decided that this
conference should be called the
New River Conference of Free
Will Baptist.
The Constitution and By law
were then adopted.
The meeting time was set to
begin on Friday night before
each 5th Sunday.
The next conference to be
held with New Home Church.
Rev W.C. Childers to preach
the introductory sermon.
On move conference adjourned
with song & prayer and hand shake
Rev J.M. Young, Moderator

By Laws of the New River Conference
of Free Will Baptist

(Art. 1)

The Clerk or his assistant, and in his absence the oldest Minister present (8), shall call the Conference to order, and call for the election of a Moderator, who when elected shall take charge

(2)

all ministers and deacons and duly elected delegates, are hereby constituted members of this Conference, and may act according to the provisions of the By Laws and Constitution under which this Conference is organized.

(3)

Each Church is allowed three delegates to this Conference.

(4)

Each Church shall be represented by delegates and letter. The letter shall be accompanied by one dollar and shall give the condition and statistics of the Church.

(5)

Each meeting of this Conference shall be opened by Scripture reading and prayer and closed by prayer.

(6.)

By a two-thirds vote of all members present a ruling of the moderator may be overruled.

(7)

No person may be Moderator of this Conference more than twice in succession.

(8)

The Moderator shall have the same privilege of speaking as any other person, provided the Chair is filled.

(9)

This Conference may correspond by letter or otherwise with other religious bodies.

(10)

Any one wishing to address the Conference shall first rise to his feet and address the moderator by the appellation of Brother Moderator, but shall not speak further until recognized by the moderator.

(11)

No one shall speak more than twice or more than ten minutes on the same subject and shall adhere to the subject under discussion.

(12.)

Any Candidate for ordination as a minister, shall be required to pass a public examination by the Ordaining Council and shall be required to preach before the Conference.

(13)

Five members or a majority of the resident members shall constitute a quorum in Conference.

(14.)

23 Each minister shall make a report of his work to the Conference once each year.

(15.)

Any question of vital importance to the Churches, coming up before this Conference, shall be carried over till the next regular meeting before being voted on.

(16)

a majority shall rule.

(17)

No member shall interrupt another while speaking.

(18)

It shall be the duty of all members to be present at each meeting and not retire without permission of the moderator.

(19)

The moderator shall not allow discussion when not carried on in a Christian spirit or when he thinks it will cause discord or division.

(20)

This Conference shall have the power to discipline the Churches composing it for unchristian practices or unsound doctrine.

- (21) No person shall be ordained
as a minister, until he has
served one year as a licentiate
of a Free Will Baptist Church.
- (22) These By Laws may be amended
by any regular or adhored session
of the Conference by a two thirds
vote of the members present.
- (23) All ministers are to make a report
to the Clerk once each year, and
the Clerk shall read the reports
before the Conference. Any minister
not reporting for 2 years the minister's
good standing certificate shall be withheld.
- (24) All licentiates, must be elected
a pasture or go into full time evangelistic
work before ordination, or other work
requiring ordination.
