1st No one person shall be
 moderator of this conference
 more than twice in succession.

2nd Any one coming up for
 ordination as a minister
 be required to pass a public
 examination by the ordaining
 council, and to preach before the
 conference.

3rd That five members or a
 majority of the resident members
 constitute a quorum in
 church conference.

4th That each church be required
 to send to the conference one
 dollar with the church letter.

and that the money so sent be placed in the hands of the treasurer to be disposed of at the order of the conference.

Moved & carried that conference authorize, Rev J. B. Wheeler & Rev J. S. Sexton, to represent this conference, in the Mines Co. conference, and that Rev A. H. Longdon represent us in the Logan Co. conference.

On motion it was carried that when a question of vital importance to the churches comes up before this conference, that it not be voted on til the next conference meeting, in order to give the different churches a chance to study the question and instruct their delegates, if they wish to do so.

The finance committee reported with \$1.25 for the purpose of buying a minute book for the conference, and the Clerk was instructed to buy one.

Moved & carried that the ministers make a report of their work to the conference, once each year.

Committee on obituaries report no deaths.

Business committee reports that the next conference meeting will be held with Roberson's Chapel Church, beginning on Friday night before the 5th Sunday in May.
