 Rev W.C. Childers.

Treasurer reports cash on hand \$2.97  
 moved and carried that the clerk  
 order such blanks as he may  
 deem necessary, using money  
 from the treasury.

 be held with New Home Church,  
 beginning on Friday night. Sept 15<sup>th</sup>  
 1939.
