The New River Conference of Free Will Baptist met with Welcome Home Church, Bel Air, Md., August 16, 1963, in the 27th Annual Session. The Pastor, Rev. W.C. Childers, spoke a few words of welcome to the Conference.

The Conference was opened with Scripture reading, Job 25, by Rev. Th. C. Childers and prayer by the Christians kneeling at the Alter.

The Clerk declared the moderator's Chair vacant, and Rev. Lester Harton was elected Moderator, and Rev. Th. C. Childers was appointed his assitant.

The letters from the churches was called for. The following churches presented letters, Calvary, New Home, Welcome Home, Harmony, and Fairwood. The letters were read before the Conference and accepted.

Ministers that reported at this time were, Herman Delinger, Frank Hicks, and Robert Dowell, Hem Sutt, ^{and} Rev. Th. C. Childs, ^{and} Rev. William Steele was elected to the Council for a period of 3 years.

A discussion for the purpose of building up the Conf. treasure was held. The plan, for the churches to tithe to the Conf. treasure was defeated on vote. It was then moved & carried that each church take a quarterly offering for the Conference treasure. This money to be paid out by the order of the Conference.

Moved & Carried: that the request of the
Fairwood and Chestnut Hill Churches, to ordain
some deacons, be granted.

Moved & Carried: That the request of the
Harmony Church, to examine Bro. Johnny Johnson
for the ministry, be granted.

Moved and Carried, that the money
with the church letters be divided between
the moderator and conf. treasurer, and
the money with Rev. Mosley's letter be
returned to him. \$59.14

An offering for the Harmony Church
building fund was taken.

Moved & Carried that Rev. Olate Kilby
elected to the Council to replace Rev.

James K. Childers, who got his letter
and joined Anoche Conf.

it was read before the Conf. and accepted

Moved & Carried, That the request of
the Yorkshire Church be granted, to examine
two deacons and one for the ministry -

hoff, Ray Contrell, Curtis Stallard, and
James Eddington, were called before the Council
and examined by Rev. H. C. Childers. The
Council voted to ordain them. The prayer
of ordination was by Rev. William Steele.

Moved & Carried that the Conference
Adjoin until after lunch.
