A. S. Southern, J. H. Shoaf, H. C. Robbins, J. F. Duckworth, Chas. Phillips, Jessie Fowler, James Vestal, Johnny Pier and W. D. McFarland. S. E. Capps resigned from Ex. Board. J. D. Fowler elected instead.

The following resolutions were adopted.

- (1) That all ministers make full report of all money received by them from each church.
- (2) That we agree to support Beemish College in any way that we can.
- (3) That we withdraw from the Mo. State Association (see foot note).
- (4) That we extend vote of thanks to the people of jewel church for their hospitality.

Preaching at different hours by C. E. Mann, J. F. Duckworth, J. H. Shoaf and W. D. McFarland then Prior L. Price preached closing sermon on the subject Social Evils next session to be held at Connellsville.
