

5th 62' Session

The 5th session of the northeast mission association of Free will Baptists met July 22, 1971 with the Hazel Creek church. Services were opened by Rev. Archie Cosper. After congregational singing "Let the work" + "Revive us again" Rev. Kermit Crooks led in prayer. An offering was taken for our Home Mission work in the Jefferson City area amounting to \$29.56. The congregation joined in Mayzie Scott's in the chorus "Happiness Is the Lord" after which Gladys Riley + Mayzie Scott gave a special number in song "Christ The Redeemer Is Coming Again". Rev. Frank Giusto of Jefferson City was introduced as our speaker for this association. He gave a report of our Home mission church in Jefferson City, then led in prayer before his message. Business committee report read & accepted. The monies for Jefferson City mission is to be designated to payw on the building fund. This to be sent to the designated places twice

a year. Motion properly moved & second we give the moderator power to select delegates for the state association from those that attend the state association - carried. Offering for club lapses amounting to \$5.25. Location committee report read & accepted. Nominating committee report read & accepted. Minutes read and accepted were dismissed by moderator.

Sat. evening services opened by singing "Lam Lifted me" prayer by Roger Dale Crossgroun. Guentz took the stand and told of the work in Jefferson City. He took a text from 1 Kings 18: 41-46 with the subject "the Little we Give". Dismissed by Bro. Harry Beatty.

Executive Board Report.

The executive board met at the new Harmony church Sat. night Jan 16, 1971, with members Archie Cooper, Milo James & Brie Riley present, along with one youth camp committee member, Wendell Lewis.
