

Minutes of the All Missouri Association
of Free Will Baptists held with
Freeman Chapel, Stewartsville,
Missouri, beginning Friday evening,
July 26, 1968.

The meeting was called to order by

There was no report from the Executive Board.

A motion was made and seconded to retain Brother Jesse Perkins on the Executive Board. Motion carried.

The Pulpit Committee was discussed and
mussed to prepare their report.

The Pulpit Committee recommended
that Brother John McKown bring the
message.

The minister letters were read and
received.

A letter from Hickory Grove Church
was read and given to the Business
Committee.

A recess was called until the call of the
chair.

The meeting was started again by
singing "Wondrous Works of Life"
and "Up These We Built." Led in
prayer by Sister Georgia Schuster.

The Business Committee requests that
the Clerk mail the letter requested
by the Hickory Grove Church -
(requesting a letter of dismission from
the Association as they have no
pastor, nor Sunday School or services
of any kind for many years past.)

A motion was made and seconded that

we receive this letter as a partial report from the Business Committee. Motion carried.

The Credentials Committee's report read: "A motion made and seconded that we receive this report as read. Motion carried.

"We, the Credential Committee, report that the credentials of each minister has been examined and we find them satisfactory for the next year and recommend that they be given their credentials for another year.

The Publication, Education and Temperance Committee's report read A motion made and seconded that we receive the report as read. Motion carried

"The Publication, Education, and Temperance Committee urge that as many members as possible support the Sem, either with individual subscription or the Family Plan.

We suggest we use Free Will Baptist Sunday School literature, that we support the Free Will Baptist College, the Missouri Youth Camp and other fields of our denominational work.

We recommend that our members not use intoxicating beverages at any place that sell it.

We further recommend only wholesome entertainment for our selves and our children."

The Obituary Committee's report read.

Motion carried: that we receive the report as read. Prayer for the family of the deceased was given by Brother John McKaun.

"As there has been one removed from us amidst, Brother Charles Thomas, we, the committee recommend standing prayer for the loved ones and to instruct the Clerk to send a card of remembrance to the family left here on earth".

Services were turned over to Brother John McKaun. Lesson was taken from 19th Chapter of 1st Kings, beginning at 19th verse. After the reading of this portion of the Bible, we were led in prayer by Brother McKaun. After the message the congregation sang "His Way With Thee".

Scripture lesson, 9th Psalm, read by Brother John McKaun

carried.

Our Moderator told of writing to the Mission Board concerning a missionary. They are to send one our way as soon as one is available.

The Statistician's report was read and received.

The treasurer reported a balance of \$45.64

A motion made and seconded that we receive the Treasurer's report. Motion carried.

A motion made and seconded that we convene with the Mt. Zion Church in 1964. Motion carried.

A motion made that we give a standing vote of thanks to the Freeman Chapel Church for so graciously entertaining us. Motion carried.

It was decided that anyone from the Mt. Zion Church or the Freeman Chapel Church attended the State Association at Joplin, Missouri, that they be seated as delegates.

The Clerk is instructed to write a letter to the State association \$5.00 as to be sent

with it.

The Mt. Zion Church is to get the minister for the introductory sermon in 1969.

A motion made and seconded that we have the minutes printed by the Clerk for the same fee as last year (\$10.00). Motion carried.

The Business Committee was dissolved dismissed.

A motion was made and seconded that we adjourn to meet with the Mt. Zion Church in 1969. Motion carried.
